New Jersey's Transportation, Logistics, and Distribution (TLD) industry provides more than one in 10 jobs in the state. A primary goal of the TLD Talent Network is to connect skilled jobseekers with the employers who need them.

This industry employed over 358,000 workers in New Jersey in 2012 at an average wage of nearly \$68,000 — \$10,000 above the average for all other industries in the state. Throughout 2010 and 2012, the TLD industry hired over 3,400 workers to fill new and replacement jobs.
