

CHAPTER 4

**MEAT AND POULTRY INSPECTION INSPECTION
OF RED MEAT AND RED MEAT PRODUCTS
AND INSPECTION OF POULTRY AND POULTRY
PRODUCTS**

The State Board of Agriculture, at its meeting on August 24, 1971, adopted by reference all of the rules and regulations of the United States Department of Agriculture Consumer and Marketing Service as published in the Federal Register, volume 35, number 193, dated Saturday, October 3, 1970, part II, wherever applicable to the State of New Jersey.

These rules and regulations, having been properly promulgated in the Federal Register, are deemed to be those rules and regulations of the New Jersey State Board of Agriculture as authorized in N.J.S.A. 24:16B-5 and shall have the full force and effect of law.

Any future changes in these Federal rules and regulations, after proper promulgation in the Federal Register, shall also

be deemed to be the rules and regulations of the New Jersey State Board of Agriculture.¹

The Federal rules and regulations cited above are adopted in lieu of and supersede the rules concerning meat and poultry inspection and inspection of red meat and red meat products initially cited as N.J.A.C. 2:4-1.1 through 2:4-22.9, which were to appear herein on pages 33 through 216, serial numbers 0483 through 0666, and the rules concerning inspection of poultry and poultry products initially cited as N.J.A.C. 2:5-1.1 through 2:5-23.9, which were to appear on pages 217 through 295, serial numbers 0667 through 0745.
