Hyundai/Kia Multistate Immobilizer Settlement

Important Dates

March 31, 2027

Claim Deadline

Funds are limited and will be disbursed on a rolling basis until the limited fund is exhausted. Once the funds are exhausted, no further claims will be paid, so please do not wait to submit your claim.

The Multistate Immobilizer Settlement offers eligible Hyundai and Kia customers the following benefits:

1. If your eligible Hyundai or Kia vehicle experienced a **Qualifying Theft** or **Qualifying Theft Attempt**, you may receive financial compensation. You may receive up to \$4,500 for a total loss or up to \$2,250 for partial loss. For a qualifying theft attempt you may be eligible for up to \$375 for reasonable expenses related to the attempt. To qualify:
 - At the time of the qualifying theft or theft attempt, your vehicle either had the Software Upgrade installed or you had an appointment scheduled for the upgrade.
 - The qualifying theft or theft attempt occurred **on or after April 29, 2025**, but before your vehicle received the free zinc sleeve installation or by March 31, 2027.
2. A zinc-reinforced ignition cylinder protector (zinc sleeve) can be installed at no cost at any authorized Hyundai or Kia dealership. This hardware upgrade provides extra protection against theft methods popularized on social media.

Note: This is different from the free Software Upgrade, which also helps prevent theft.

Your Legal Rights and Options:

Do Nothing	If you chose not to do anything, you will not receive any benefits available to eligible consumers as a result of the Multistate Immobilizer Settlement.
Submit a Claim	You are eligible to submit a claim if you own or lease an Eligible Vehicle and you either already had the Software Upgrade installed or you can provide documentation to demonstrate that you had an appointment scheduled to receive the Software Upgrade at the time of the Qualifying Theft or Qualifying Theft Attempt. In addition, the Qualifying Theft or Qualifying Theft Attempt must have occurred on or after April 29, 2025, but before the earliest of the date (1) your vehicle received the free zinc sleeve installation on your Eligible Vehicle or (2) March 31, 2027.

Your Legal Rights and Options:

Eligible Consumers who experienced a Qualifying Theft are eligible to request reimbursement up to \$4,500 for the Total Loss of a Vehicle or reimbursement up to \$2,250 for the Partial Loss of a Vehicle.

Eligible Consumers who experienced a Qualifying Theft Attempt are eligible to request reimbursement of up to \$375 for Reasonable Attempted Theft Expenses.

The deadline to submit a claim is March 31, 2027. Funds are limited and will be disbursed on a rolling basis until the limited fund is exhausted. Once the funds are exhausted, no further claims will be paid, so please do not wait to submit your claim.
