#### **GOVERNOR TO VISIT BURLINGTON COUNTY; TEACH FOURTH GRADE CLASS; VISIT FARM TO BE PRESERVED AS FARMLAND**

Gov. Christie Whitman tomorrow will teach a fourth grade class at the Clara Barton Elementary School in Bordentown about the USS New Jersey. The Governor visited the Panama Canal last weekend to observe the battleship's journey to New Jersey where it will be retired.

The Governor also will visit the Eni Family Farm in Medford. Local and county officials are working together to preserve the 300-plus acre farm.

In addition, the Governor will plant a tree in honor of the late Burlington County Senator William Haines at a dedication ceremony for the Haines Industrial Center in Burlington Township. The center is named in honor of the late senator.

Later, the Governor will attend a Cumberland County GOP fundraiser in Buena.
