#### **Media Advisory Governor's Schedule**

Gov. Christie Whitman will attend several fundraisers for GOP candidates in Connecticut this weekend.

On Monday, the Governor will be joined by Senator Richard Codey (D-Essex), to discuss tuition at the state's colleges and universities with the President's Council on Higher Education.

Later in the day, Gov. Whitman will highlight the need to preserve open space, when she breaks ground for the Castle Point section of the Hudson River walkway in Hoboken. The project is a cooperative venture between the state Department of Environmental Protection, the City of Hoboken, and Stevens Institute of Technology.

When completed, the Hudson River walkway will link nine communities along the Hudson River, from the George Washington Bridge to the Bayonne Bridge. The 40-foot wide Castle Point section of the walkway will include a fishing pier to extend 165 into the river, with a 75-foot "T" at the end. Joining the Governor at the groundbreaking will be Hoboken Mayor Anthony Russo and Stevens Institute President Harold Raveche.
