GOVERNOR NOMINATES ROBERT BERNARDI AS BURLINGTON COUNTY PROSECUTOR

Gov. Christie Whitman has filed with the State Senate the nomination of Robert D. Bernardi, of Mount Laurel, as Burlington County prosecutor.

"Mr. Bernardi has earned a well-deserved reputation for his skill and experience in the practice of law as well as for his unfailing integrity and his strong commitment to fairness," the Governor said. "I am confident that he will be an efficient and effective prosecutor and an asset to Burlington County and its citizens."

Prior to his nomination as Burlington County prosecutor, Bernardi was a shareholder with the law firm of Parker, McCay & Criscuolo in Marlton. His area of practice included medical malpractice defense, commercial and construction claims, and the handling of environmental matters. He previously served as an assistant Camden County prosecutor and from 1974-1975 served a judicial clerkship for Superior Court Judge Leon A. Wingate.

Bernardi received his B. A. degree from the University of Massachusetts and his law degree from the Chicago-Kent College of Law.
