Permit Descriptions

CAFRA - A Coastal Area Facility Act permit is required to construct residential, commercial, public, transportation, utility and energy-related facilities in the coastal area as defined by the Act.

Federal Consistency Activity: Certain federal permits, not limited to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Dredge and Fill Permits, require certification by the DEP prior to the issuance of the permit by the federal agency.

Freshwater Wetlands: A Permit (Letters of Exemption, Letters of Interpretation, Statewide General Permit, Open Water Fill, Individual, Transition Area Waiver, Water Quality Certificate) is needed prior to engaging in a regulated activity in or around freshwater wetlands and associated transition areas. A Stream Encroachment Permit, a U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Dredge and Fill Permit, and a Water Quality Certification may also be required.

General Groundwater Petroleum Products Cleanup: This general permit authorizes the surface water discharge of treated groundwater previously contaminated with petroleum products.

NJPDES permits: A permit is required for the discharge of pollutants to surface and groundwaters, a discharge from an indirect user or the land application of municipal and/or industrial residuals. (A more comprehensive definition of activities which require a permit may be found at N.J.A.C. 7:14A-2.4)

Solid Waste Facility: A permit is required to conduct or operate any solid waste facility as defined under the Solid Waste Management Act, N.J.S.A. 13:1E-1 et seq., and N.J.A.C. 7:26-1 et seq.

Stream Encroachment: Under the Flood Control Act DEP is empowered to require a permit to control construction within and proximate to flood hazard areas to reduce flood damage to and from new development and to protect the flood storage capacity and ecology of flood plains.

Tidal Wetlands: A Coastal Wetlands Permit is needed to excavate, dredge, fill or erect structures on coastal wetlands.

Treatment Works Approval: A TWA permit is required for the construction, modification or operation of a treatment works, including sanitary/industrial sewage pretreatment or treatment systems, sewage conveyance systems, sewer extensions and subsurface sewage disposal systems.

Waterfront Development: A permit is required for any project involving the development of waterfront near or upon any tidal or navigable waterway in the State.

General Information

The DEP Bulletin is an information service provided by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection. In compliance with the Rules and Regulations Governing 90 Day Construction Permits (NJAC 7:1C-1.1 et seq.) this semi-monthly publication contains a list of construction permit applications recently filed or acted upon by the DEP. Using the Application Milestone Codes located on the inside front cover, interested persons can determine the status of Coastal Area Facility Review Act (CAFRA) permits, Federal Consistency Activity permits, Freshwater Wetlands Individual and Statewide General permits, General Groundwater Petroleum Products Cleanup permits, Open Water Fill permits, Solid Waste Facility permits (SWF), Stream Encroachment (SE) permits, Tidal Wetlands permits, Waterfront Development permits and Treatment Works Approvals (TWA).

In addition, a calendar of Events of Interest and a Schedule of Public Hearings is provided. The public hearings listed do not, however, constitute an official notice. Environmental Impact Statements acted upon during the period are also shown. Additional information concerning the permit applications can be obtained by calling the project manager at the appropriate office listed on the inside back cover.

Public Hearings are held for the purpose of obtaining input and reaction to a proposed rule, regulation, or new program. Some hearings may be mandated by law. Generally their scope of impact is statewide or of broad general interest and open to the public.

Contested Case Hearings are held between the State and a particular party involving an application, enforcement violation or an appeal. Interest in these hearings is generally limited to those directly involved.

DEP Events of Public Interest include public hearings, council meetings, workshops, public information meetings, and exams.

Proposed New Rules: N.J.A.C. 7:1M-2
Proposed Amendment: N.J.A.C. 7:27-8 & 22

Take notice that the NJ Department of Environmental Protection is proposing regulations for participation in the Gold Track tier of the Silver and Gold Track Program for Environmental Performance and amendments to N.J.A.C. 7:27-8, Permits and Certificates for Minor Facilities (and Major Facilities Without an Operating Permit) and N.J.A.C. 7:27-22, Operating Permits. A statement of the substance of the proposal follows: The proposed rules establish the requirements and procedures for participation in the Gold Track tier of the Silver and Gold Track Program for Environmental Performance. This Program is based on achieving environmental excellence through commitments and accountability beyond standard regulatory requirements. The Silver and Gold Track Program consists of three tiers: Silver Track, Silver Track II, and Gold Track. The goal of Gold Track is to foster the continued development and implementation of creative approaches to achieving more efficient and effective environmental performance. Gold Track, once implemented, would be the top performance tier of NJDEP's Silver and Gold Track Program for Environmental Performance. New Jersey's goal in creating this tiered system is to encourage environmentally progressive companies to commit to further reductions in emissions and to adopt environmentally sustainable practices beyond those currently required by federal or State law. In initiating the Gold Track program, NJDEP is pursuing environmental improvements, including but not limited to: reductions of releases of criteria and hazardous air pollutants, carbon dioxide and other greenhouse gases; promoting enhanced management of hazardous wastes; utilization of environmental management systems; water conservation, stormwater management, and an increase in a facility's accountability and communication with the general public and local communities. In return for meeting the stringent entry requirements and environmental commitments of Gold Track, participating facilities would receive certain air pollution control, hazardous waste and water regulatory flexibilities. The Gold Track Program will be limited to no more than nine participants.

The proposal is scheduled to be published in the New Jersey Register dated February 4, 2002. Emission Statements, N.J.A.C. 7:27-21, and the New Jersey State Implementation Plans for Carbon Monoxide and Ozone

PUBLIC NOTICE

Take notice that the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection is proposing new rules and amendments at N.J.A.C. 7:27-21, Emission Statements. These amendments address a "Clean Air" commitment in New Jersey's Environmental Performance Partnership Agreement (Fiscal Years 2002-2004) with USEPA to expand the Department's air emission inventories and revise the State Implementation Plan for Carbon Monoxide and Ozone. Proposed rule amendments to sections 7:27-21.5 (e) and (f) address ozone related emissions and are proposed to be incorporated in the State's Ozone SIP. Sections 7:27-21.5 (e) and (f) address carbon monoxide related emissions and are proposed to be incorporated in the State's Carbon Monoxide SIP.

The emission reporting requirements at N.J.A.C. 7:27-21, Emission Statements, would be expanded to phase in emissions reporting of 36 toxic air contaminants as well as the greenhouse gases carbon dioxide and methane; add Federal reporting requirements for fine particulates and ammonia; and would make the rule consistent with the Department's 1999 Emission Statement Guidance Document and any revisions thereto. The proposed amendments also would revise terms and definitions to make them consistent with the same terms and definitions found in the Air Pollution Control Code, N.J.A.C. 7:27, and the New Jersey Air Pollution Control Act, N.J.S.A. 26:2C-1 et seq.

The Department is seeking comment from the public on the content of the proposal and the proposed SIP Revisions. Written and/or oral testimony will be received at the public hearing which will be held on:

This facility is located on the Merck & Co., Inc. "Rahway Campus". The Rahway Campus encompasses land located in both the City of Rahway and the City of Linden. The street address of the Rahway Campus is 126 E. Lincoln Avenue, Rahway, New Jersey 07065. The facility is located on Block 470, Lot 67 in the City of Linden, New Jersey. This incinerator has an approved capacity of 799 pounds per hour of solid waste and 751 pounds per hour for injected liquid waste. The tentative approval authorizes the processing of the following waste types generated by the Merck & Co., Inc. Rahway Campus: Dry Industrial Waste; Bulk Liquid and Semiliquids; and, Regulated Medical Waste (RMW) Classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7, that include liquids and semi-liquids used in research and development activities conducted at the Rahway Campus, that have been in contact with Regulated Medical Waste materials. Incineration of RMW that is also low-level radioactive waste-containing byproduct material shall be conducted in accordance with the permittee's U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Materials License No. 29-00117-06, 10 CFR Part 20 and 40 CFR Part 61, Subpart I, as applicable.

The public comment period on this tentative approval begins on the date of the publication of this notice and will close thirty (30) days, or by 15, March 2002 after the publication date. All supporting materials shall be included in full and may not be incorporated by reference, unless they are already part of the administrative record in the same proceeding, or consist of State or Federal statutes and regulations or other generally available reference materials.

Any interested person who reasonably requires additional time within which to supplement the administrative record should request, in writing, an extension of the public comment period, and the Department will exercise reasonable discretion in setting the closing date for public comment. The Department will publish subsequent notice of any decision to extend the period for public comment. IMPLEMENTATION PLAN (SIP) REVISION**

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (the Department) recently filed a proposal that would modify the State's enhanced I/M program. The program modifications include changing the start date for mandatory on-board diagnostic (OBD) inspections from January 1, 2001, to January 1, 2003 and establishing the framework for a "phase-in" of these inspections. Other proposed changes include continuation of the initial emission standards beyond their current end date of December 31, 2001 and the addition of a number of "interim" standards, effective January 1, 2003, in place of the current "final" standards. The proposal would also eliminate references to the evaporative pressure and purge tests and would add new OBD inspection procedures. Finally, consistent with rulemaking by the New Jersey Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV), the proposal would change the test to be used for certain vehicles registered as school buses and inspected by the DMV's school bus inspection unit. Those school buses that would have been tested biennially (every other year) with the dynamometer-based ASM5015 test would instead be tested twice a year with a 2500 rpm test. This proposal is reflected in a proposed revision to the State's Enhanced I/M Program SIP that was forwarded to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) on December 31, 2001. The proposed SIP revision also reflects that portion of the DMV's proposed school bus rulemaking relating to the emissions inspection of school buses otherwise subject to the enhanced I/M program requirements.

The Department's proposal will appear in the January 22, 2002 New Jersey Register; the DMV's proposal is scheduled for publication in February, 2002. These proposals and the proposed SIP revisions are now available for inspection, as described more fully below.
