LEGAL BASIS FOR PUBLIC SERVICE IN NEW JERSEY

AREA LIBRARY:

A headquarters library under contract with the State for specialized services to libraries within a given geographic area. There are 25 Area Libraries indicated in the tables by an asterisk (*) before the library name.

ASSOCIATION LIBRARY:

One established, governed and supported by an association of citizens. Such an association is incorporated, forms its own constitution, appoints or elects its own board and is responsible for operation of the library. It may receive tax support from the local governing body. There are 90 association libraries. Only those association libraries whose services are free to the use of the public are included in this publication. Some libraries formerly listed as association libraries are now branches or stations of their county library. Association libraries are identified under the column headed "Type" in the accompanying tables by an "A".

COUNTY LIBRARY:

One established by law following a county-wide referendum passed by a majority of voters. It is supported by taxes and governed by a board known as the county library commission composed of 5 members appointed by the Freeholders. There are 13 county libraries identified under column headed "Type" by a "C".

FEDERATION:

Any number of independently established libraries voluntarily united to develop cooperative free public library services. Each member library retains complete institutional independence but enters into contracts or service agreements with other members to achieve the joint services agreed upon by the governing bodies of the respective libraries. There are two federations of libraries in New Jersey whose members retain identity as municipal libraries.

JOINT LIBRARY:

One established by law following a referendum in two or more municipalities in which the majority of voters vote to establish such a library. It is governed by a board appointed by the mayors of the participating municipalities. There are five joint libraries identified under column headed "Type" by a "J".

MUNICIPAL LIBRARY:

One established by law following a referendum in which the majority of voters vote to establish such a library. It is supported by taxes and is governed by a 7 member board appointed by the mayor which must include the mayor and the superintendent of schools. There are 215 municipal libraries identified under column headed "Type" by an "M".

REGIONAL LIBRARY:

One established by law following resolution adopted by the boards of chosen freeholders of 2 or more counties. It is governed by a board of trustees appointed by the boards of freeholders of the participating counties. There are no regional libaries to date.

NOTES ON PUBLIC LIBARY STATISTICS

These statistics are compiled from reports submitted by individual libraries for calendar year 1976. Additional data and processing has been supplied as indicated below. Where a library is equitably supported by more than one municipality, figures shown represent combined municipalities. Salary tables are derived from reported salary of director or beginning professionals, where library expenditure for wages and salaries amounted to at least \$10,000 per year.

Column

Explanation

Library Name

Generally the municipality name identifies a public library. Where a library name differs from that of the municipality, the library name is inserted in parenthesis under the name of the municipality.

Estimated Population Served

Source: New Jersey Population Estimates — 1976 by the New Jersey Department of Labor and Industry. Office of Business Economics. Total population of New Jersey as of July, 1976 was estimated at 7,431,750. Population served by local libraries is somewhat less at 7,333,295. The remainder of the population, or 98,455 reside in unserved municipalities of counties without a county library. (Please note that State Library Aid is computed on basis of most recent U.S. Census Figures rather than the 1976 estimates).

Equalized Valuation

Source: Table of Equalized Valuation of New Jersey Department of the Treasury, Division of Taxation—1976 Conformed Copy. Figures are shown to the nearest Thousand. Equalized Valuation of unserved municipalities are not included in tables.

Local Tax Support

Tax support is shown as reported by individual libraries. Calculation of State Aid is made on basis of expended amounts in support of the library from municipal budgets.

State Aid And Total Income

Amounts shown as Per Capita State Aid represent amounts transferred in October, 1976 to municipalities and counties with libraries. County total represents the entire amount of Per Capita State Aid in return for local official support of Library Service. Some county totals are larger than the sum for the libraries listed. State Aid to Area Libraries, Research Libraries and Incentive Grants are not shown in this column, but are included as Total Income showing library operating income from all sources.

Expenditures

Total expenditure for 1976 as reported by libraries, represent current operations and exclude amounts spent for new buildings, repayment on loans, etc. Expenditures when divided by the estimated population served yields the column Per Capita Local Expenditures. For county member libraries, per capita expenditures including library dedicated tax is also shown, although the library services are provided through the county library.

Staff

Figures appearing under column Professional Certified represent individual librarians who hold New Jersey Certification. Under Employed Full Time, the number of individuals working on a full time basis for a minimum of 30 hours per week is reported (as of December 1976). Figures appearing under column headed Total in Full Time Equivalents represent the addition of part time help and the full time help averaged for the entire year. Minimum work week is assumed to be 30 hours.

Number of volunteers working on a non-paid basis are shown under column headed "Vol".

Volumes Owned

Figure represents books reported as owned at the end of 1976. Other materials which are prepared, cataloged and recorded in the same manner as books are also reported here. In the case of county member libraries books reported as supplied by the County Library on extended long term loan are included here.

Subscribed Periodicals

Figure shows reported number of titles under Subscription including newspapers and magazines other than annuals at the end of 1976.

Hours Open Per Week

The number of hours open shown represents time the main library was open for public service during the major part of 1976. Figures appearing under Totals represent averages for the county or State.

Per Capita Books In Library

Dervied from volumes reported in library divided by estimated population served.

Where information requested of a reporting library was not provided, N.R. is inserted in the column to indicate Not Reported. Libraries failing to submit a report are indicated by No Report Received.
