PUBLIC LIBRARY VIDEOTAPE COLLECTION PROGRAM

Library Development Aid

December 1992

This grant program will help public libraries establish a videotape collection or expand a collection of less than 300 videotapes. Video titles purchased must be educational, informational and non-theatrical. Whenever possible, the public library is to purchase closed-captioned titles. The maximum grant was \$ 5,000. MAINTENANCE OF LIBRARY COLLECTIONS GRANT PROGRAM FY 1993 Awards

The purpose of this program is to assist libraries in the preservation and conservation of collections of Jerseyana or New Jersey subject matter; New Jersey imprints; or unique collections and materials regardless of subjects, in ways consistent with existing preservation and conservation standards. Grant funds may also be used to initiate planning which may include surveys and examinations of a collection of materials in order to identify preservation needs.
