

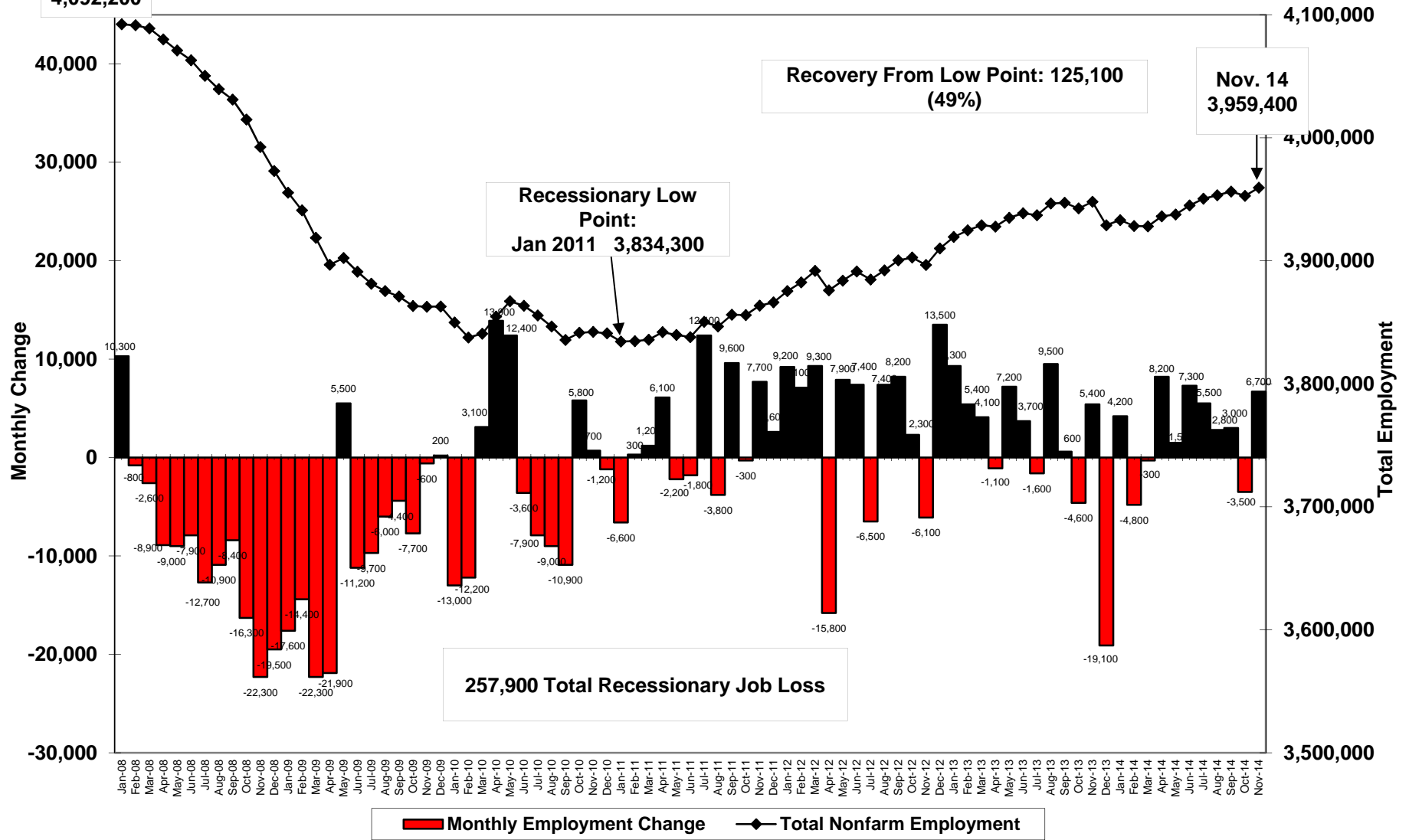

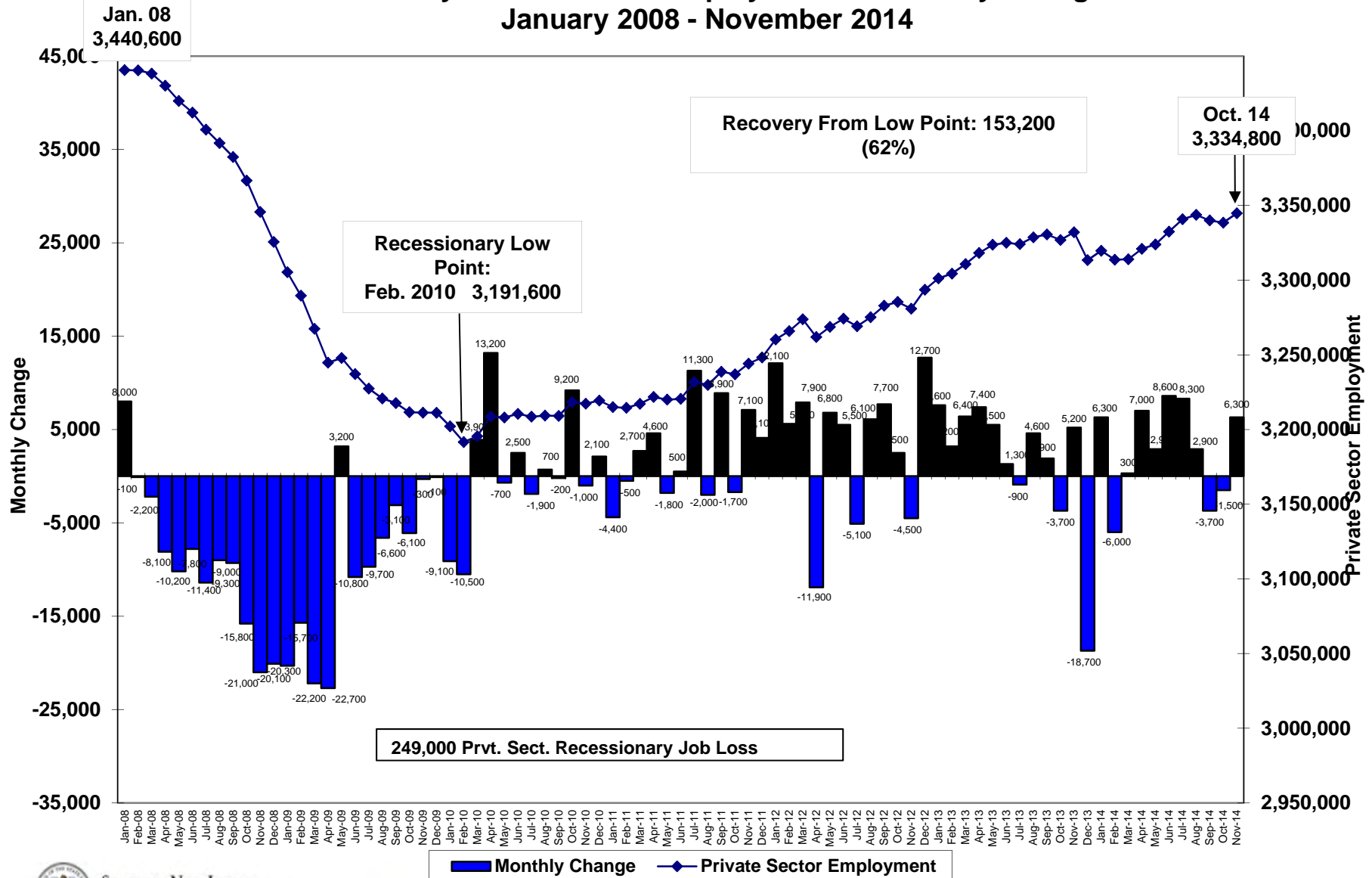

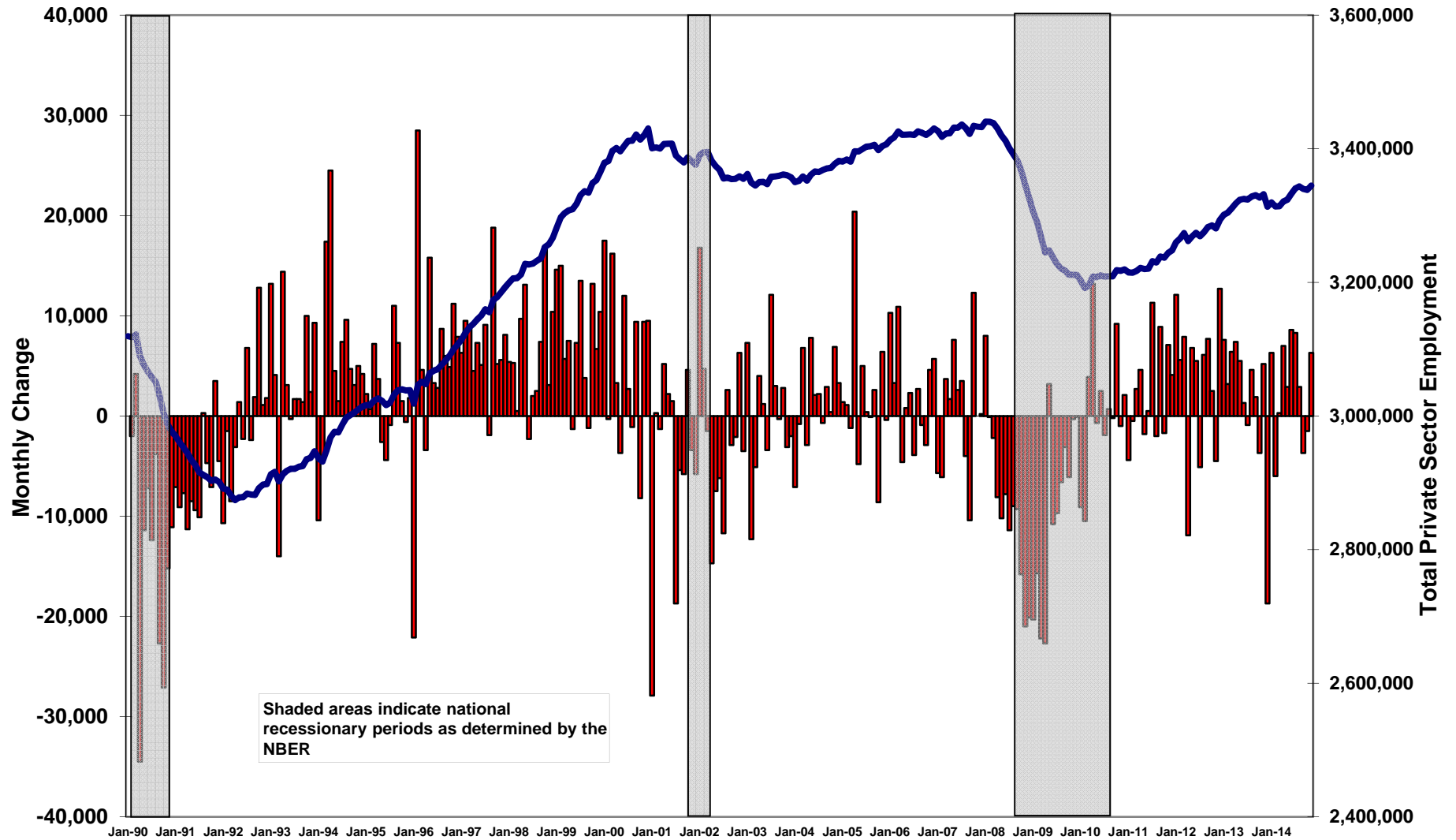
New Jersey Total Nonfarm Employment vs. Monthly Change January 2008 - November 2014

New Jersey Private Sector Employment vs. Monthly Change January 1990 - November 2014



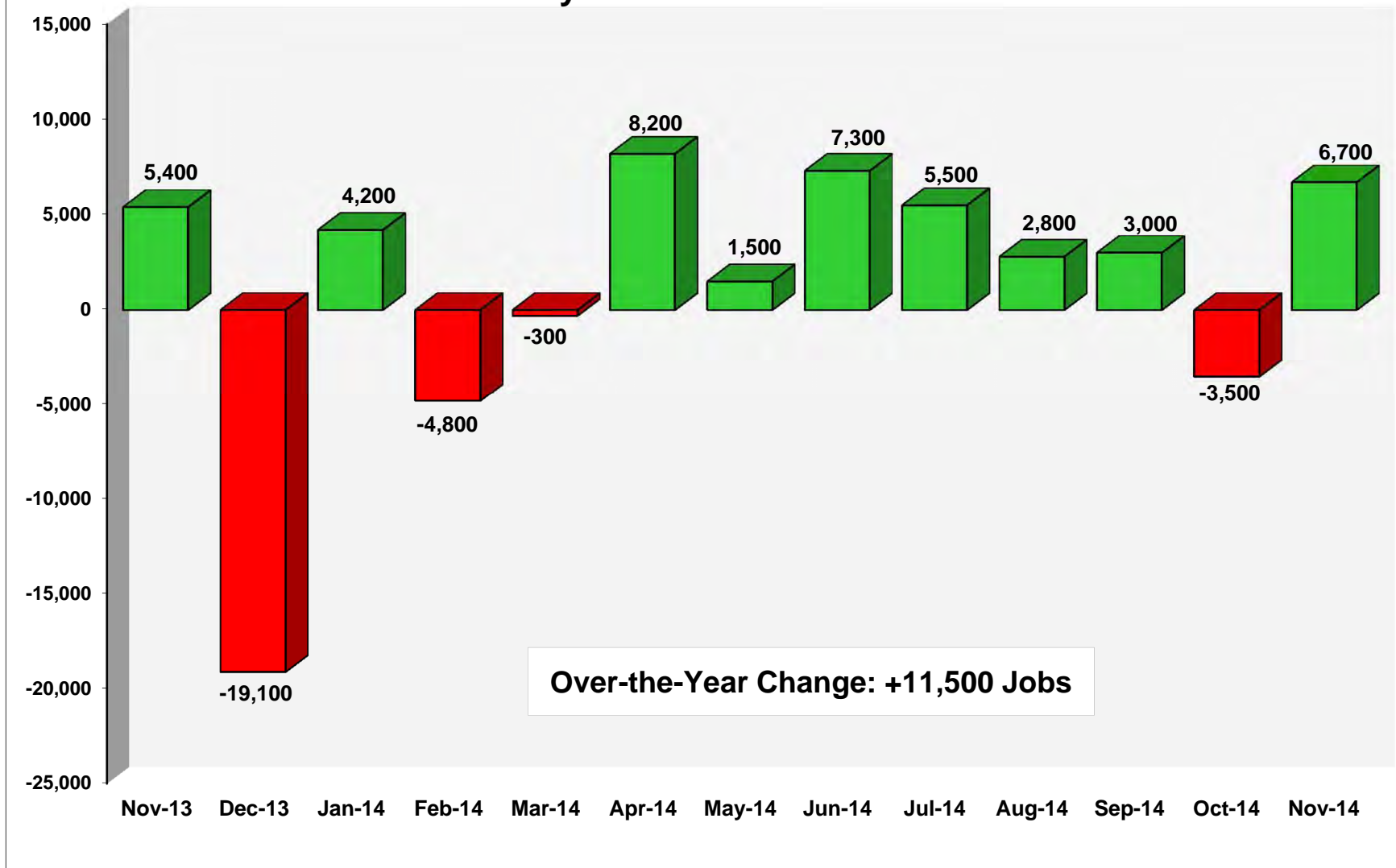

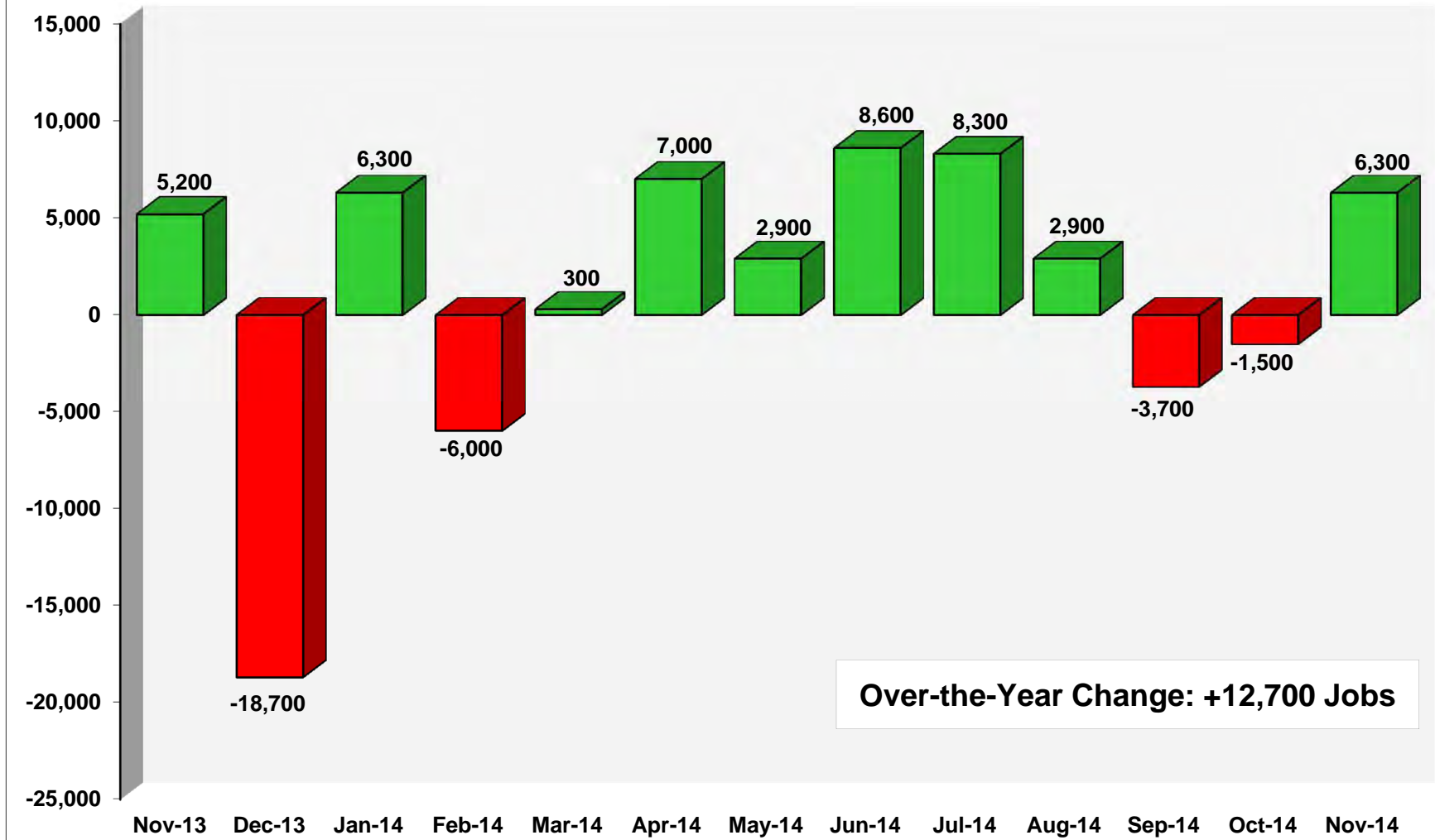

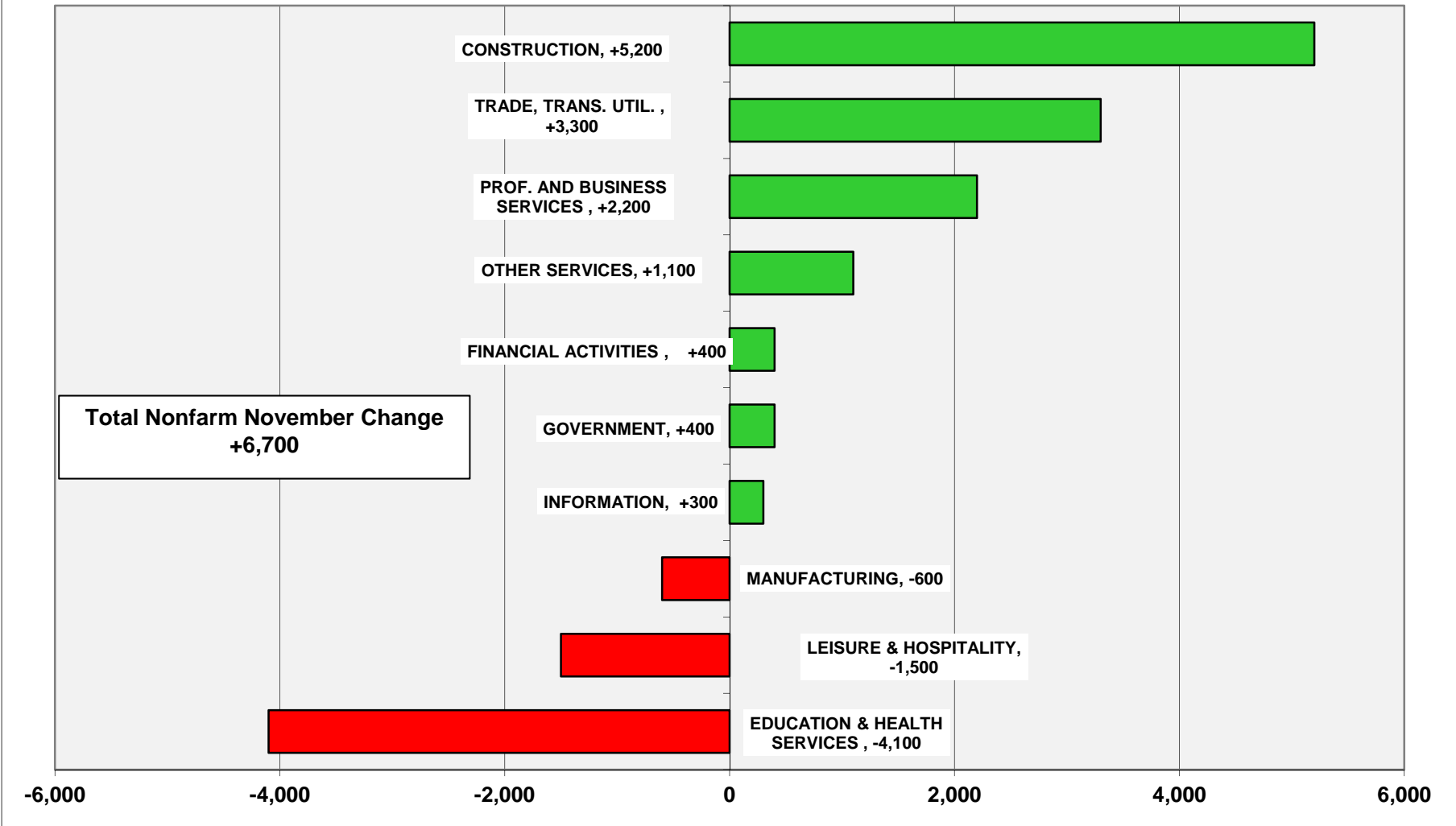
Monthly Total Employment Change New Jersey: November 2013 - November 2014



Monthly Private Sector Employment Change November 2013 - November 2014



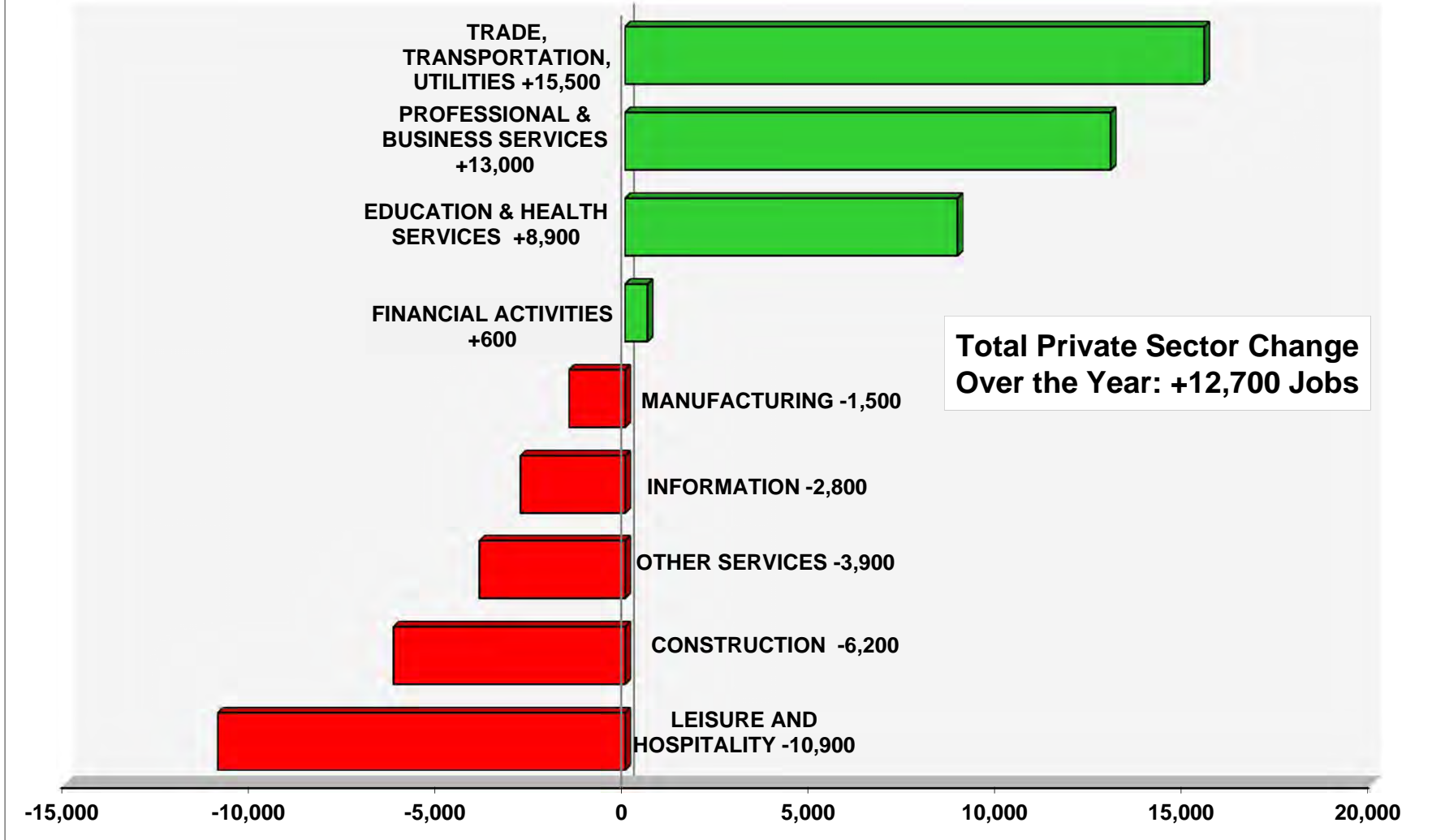

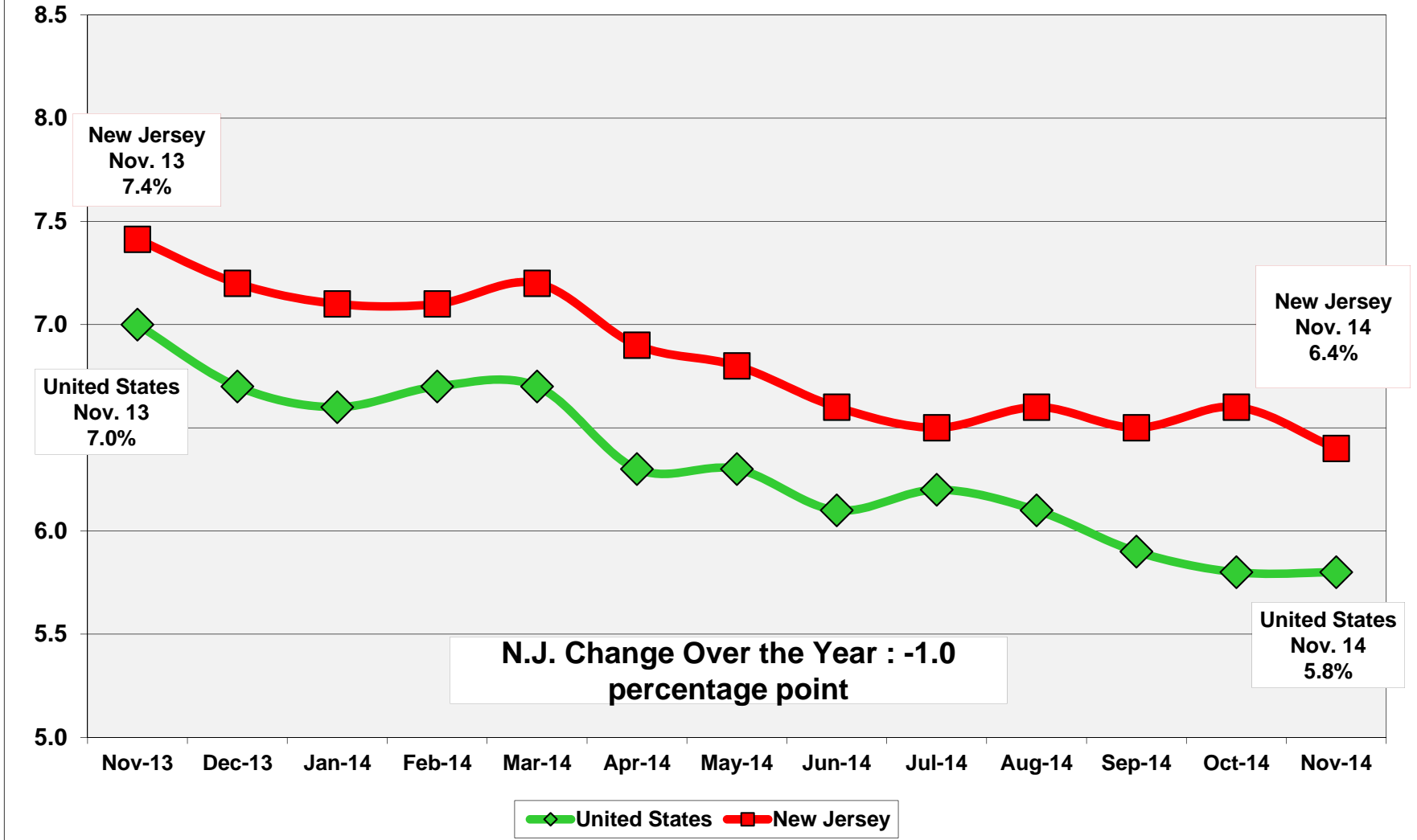

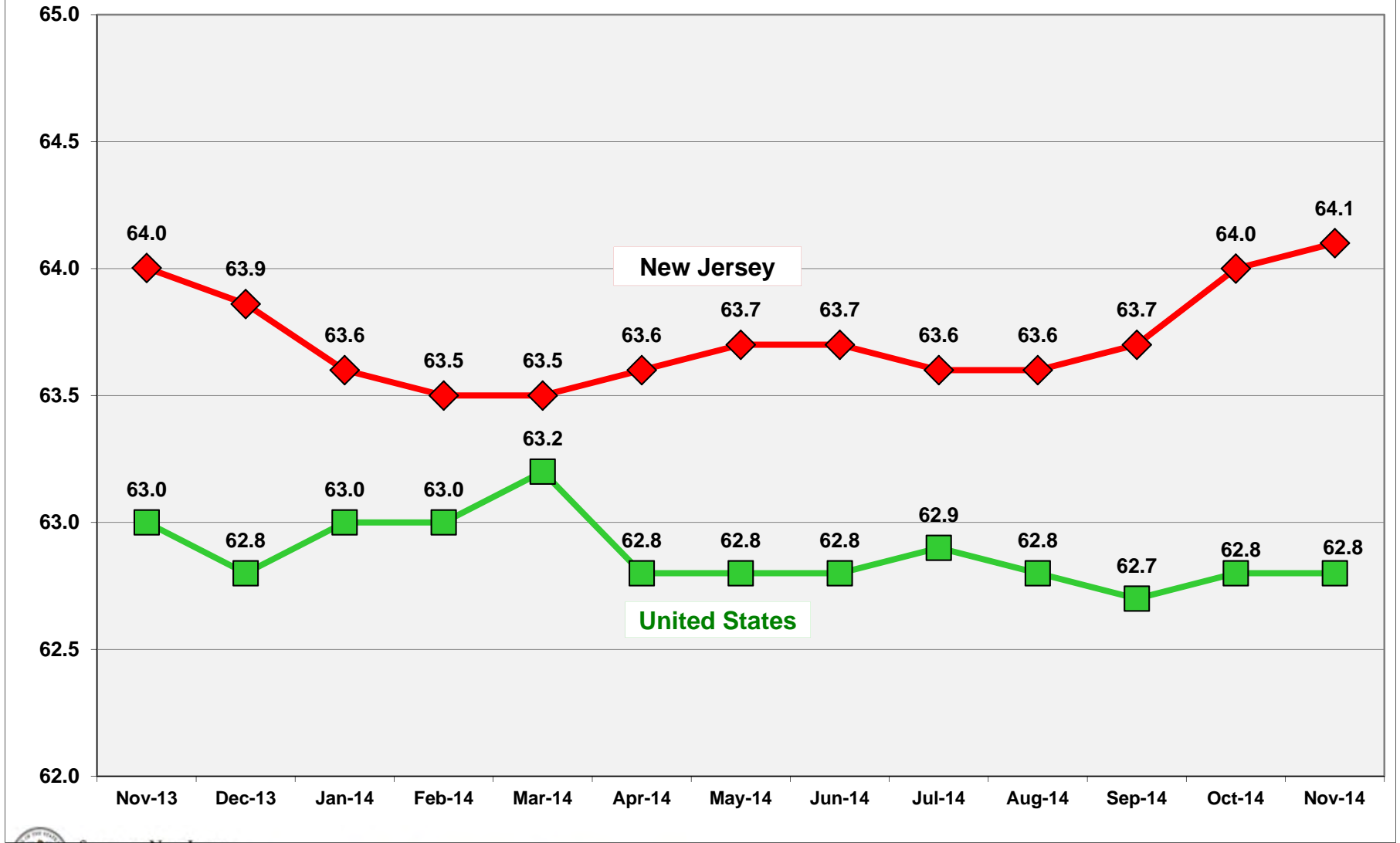
New Jersey Private Sector Employment Change by Industry November 2013 - November 2014



Unemployment Rates, New Jersey vs. United States: November 2013 - November 2014



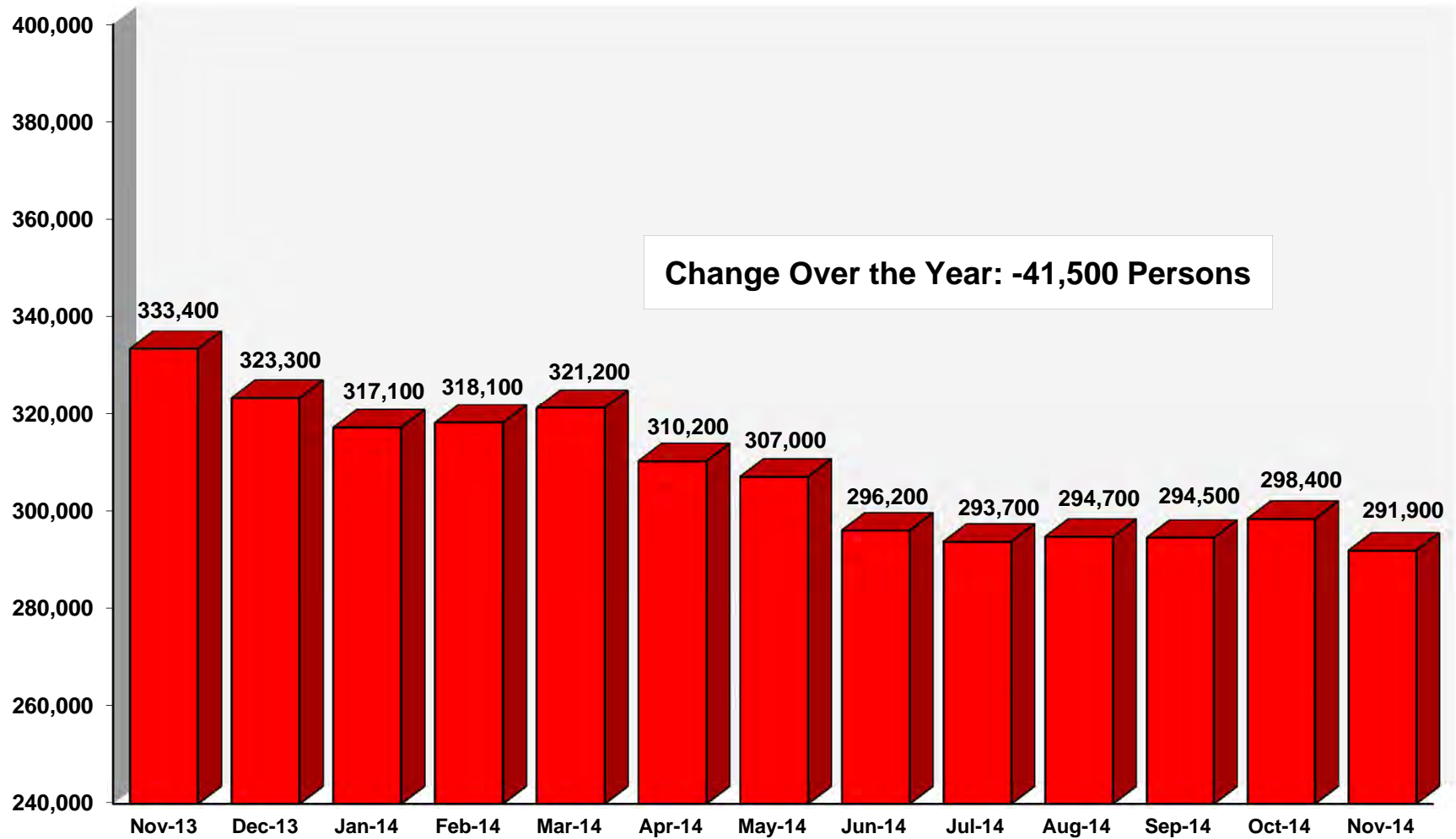
New Jersey vs. United States, Labor Force Participation Rate: November 2013 - November 2014



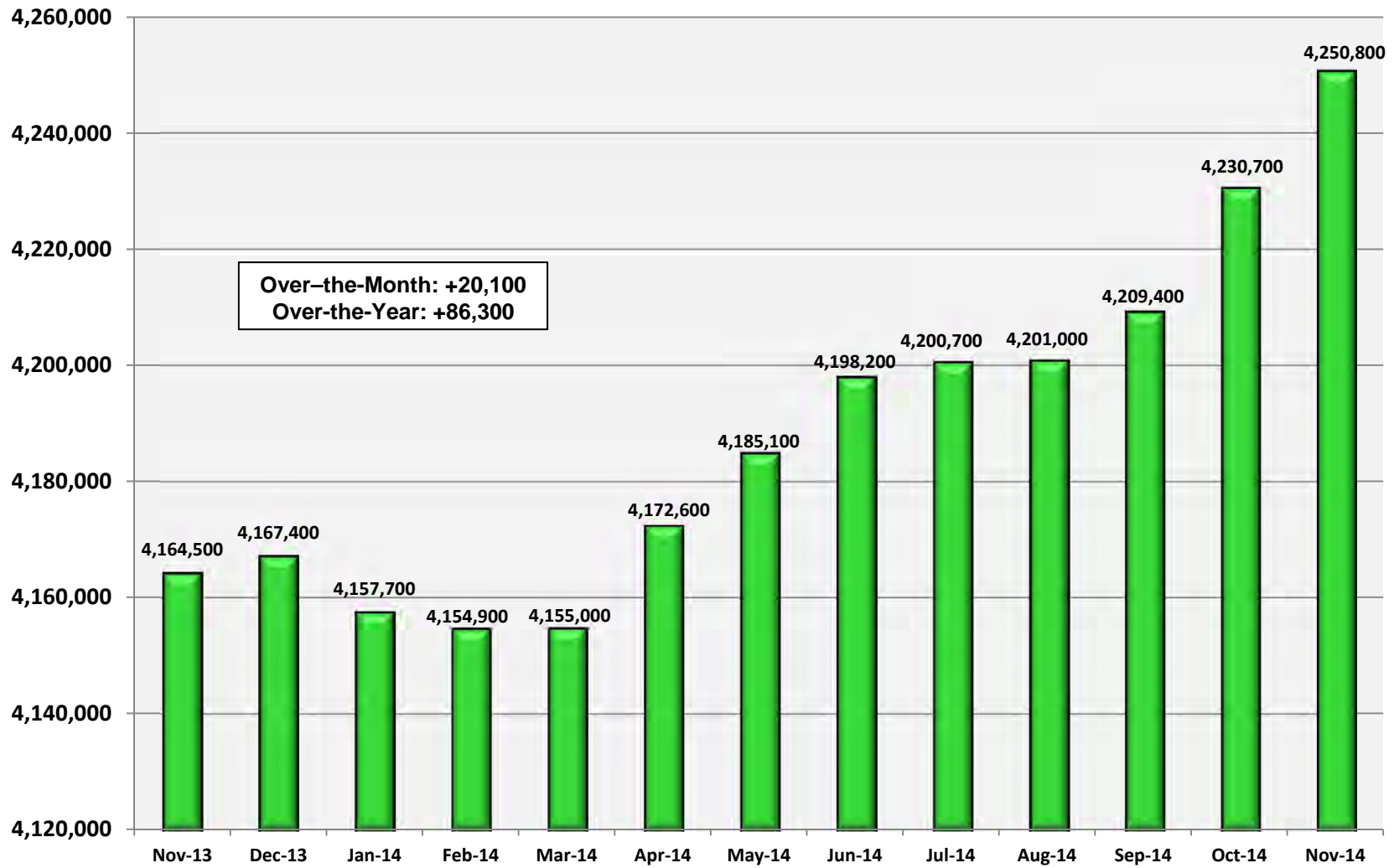

Unemployed New Jersey Residents November 2013 - November 2014



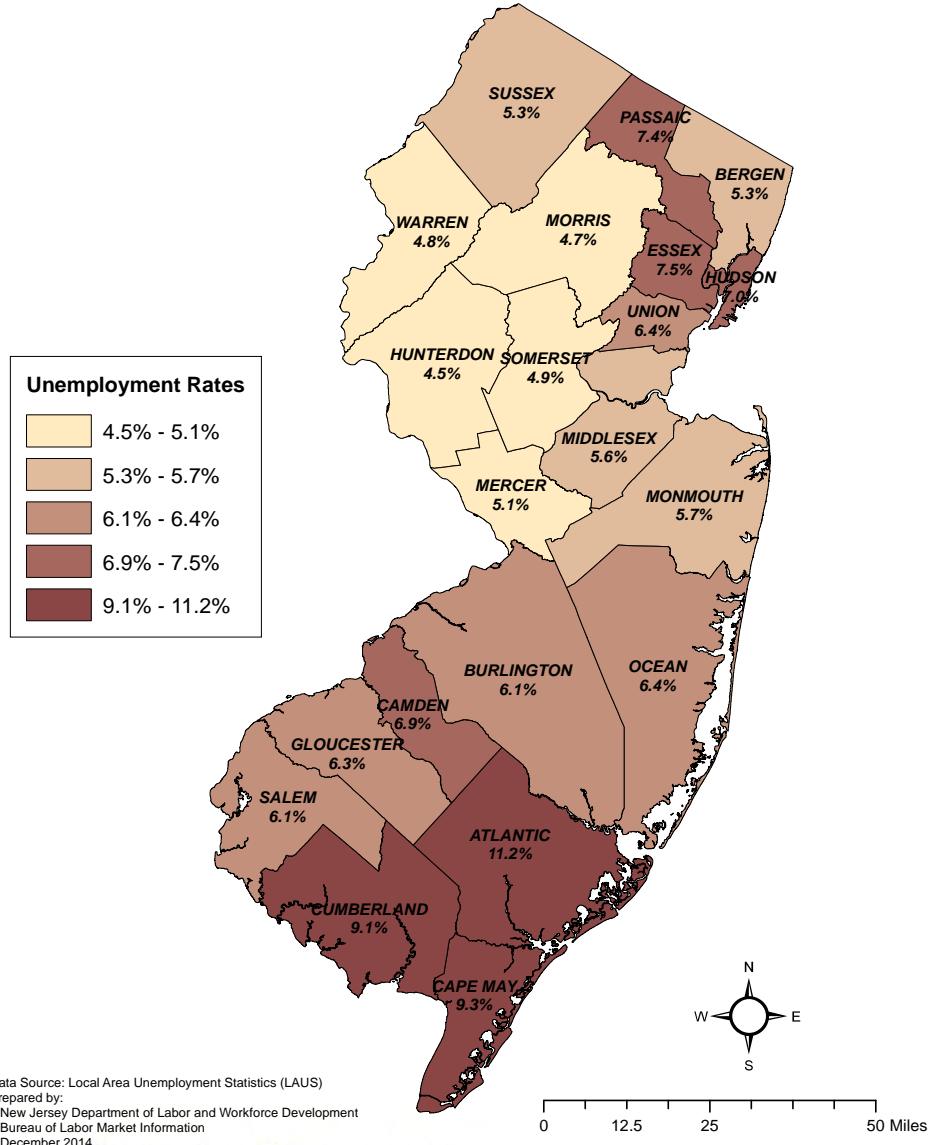
New Jersey Employed Residents: November 2013 - November 2014



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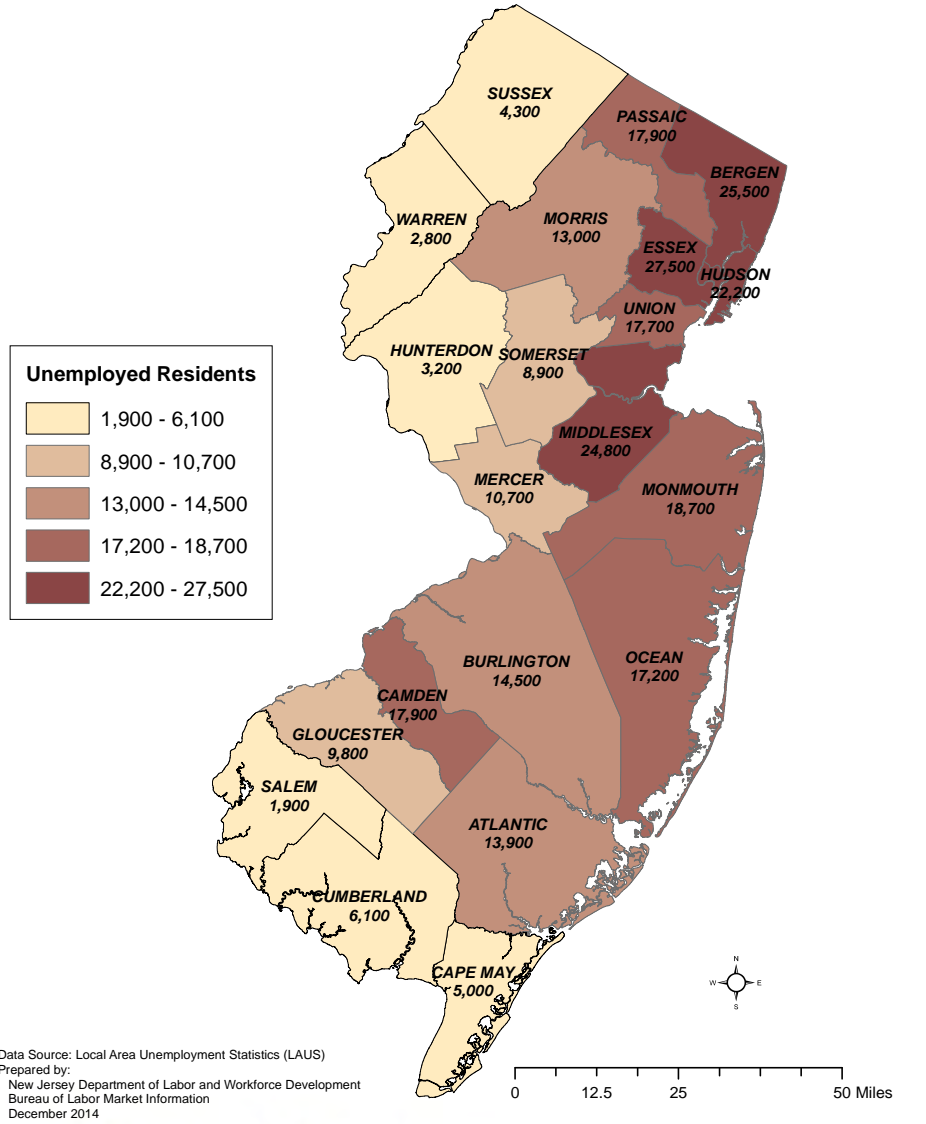
New Jersey Counties Unemployment Rates - October 2014 (Preliminary, Not Seasonally Adjusted)

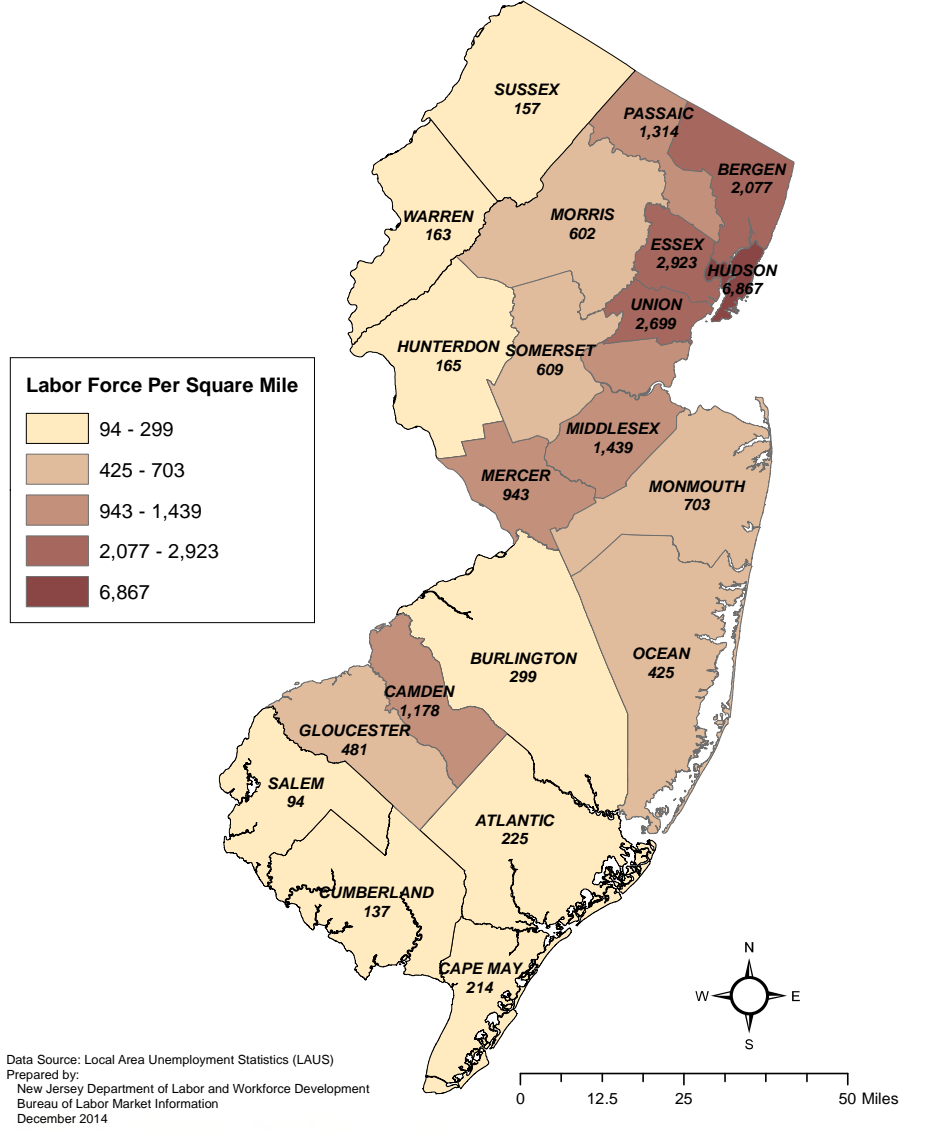
New Jersey Counties Unemployed Residents - October 2014 (Preliminary, Not Seasonally Adjusted)



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New Jersey Counties Labor Force Per Square Mile - October 2014 (Preliminary, Not Seasonally Adjusted)



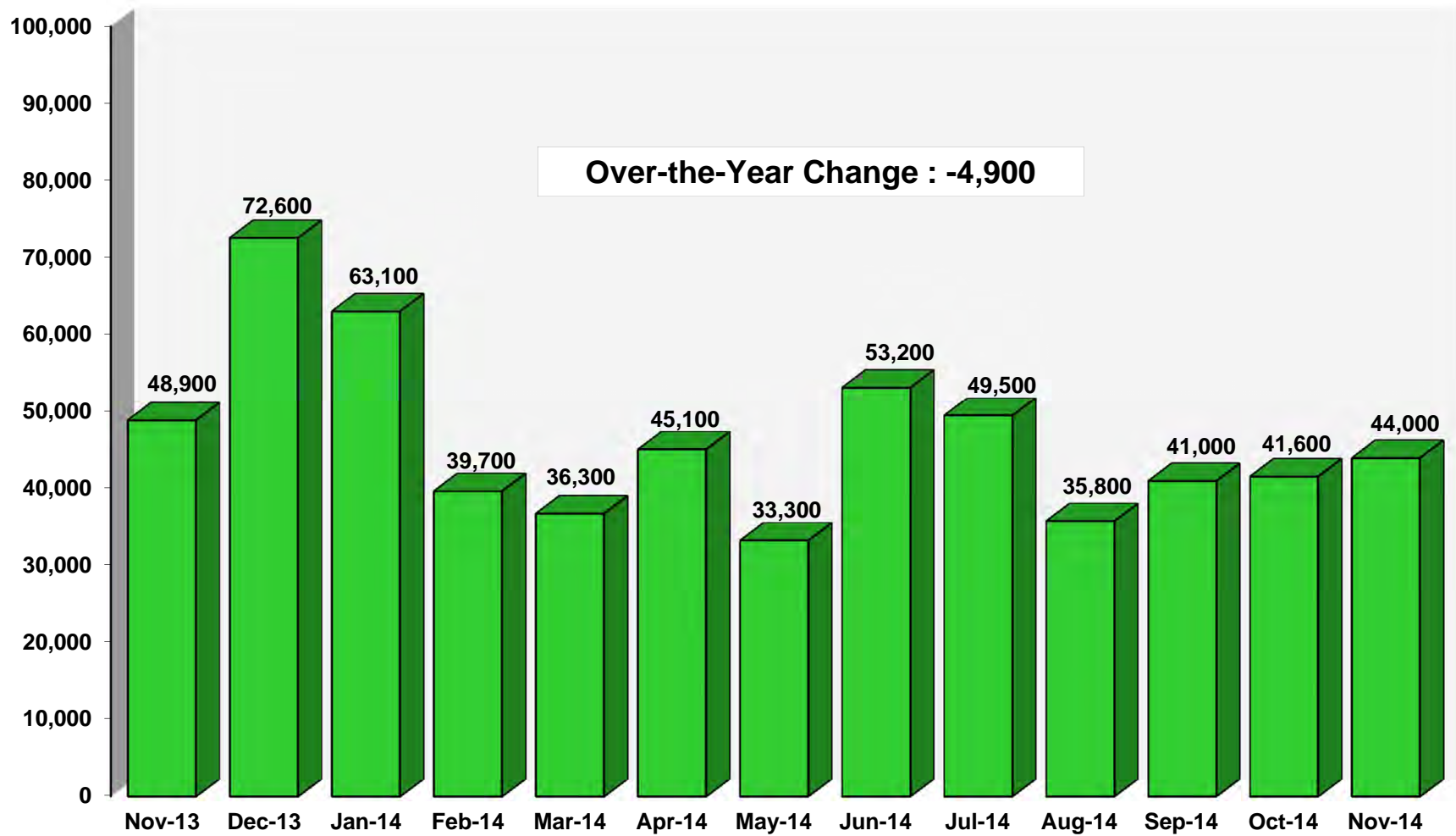
