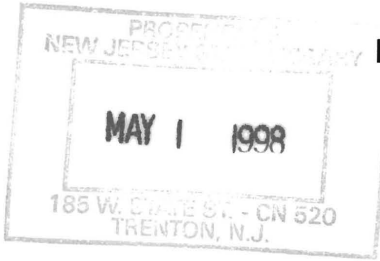

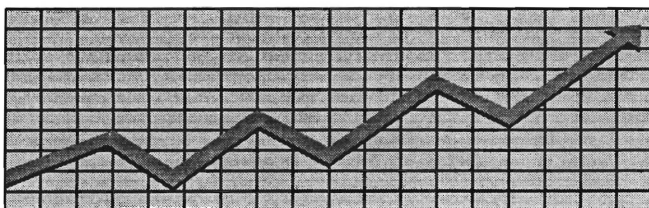

## Highlights of **CURRENT PROGRAM STATISTICS**

### **TANF**

(Tables 1 and 5, Graphs 1 and 4)

As of the end of February 1998, 80,149 eligible families in New Jersey were receiving TANF cash assistance:

- less than 77,000 single head of household families
- 3300 two-parent families.

In addition, there were nearly 6600 families receiving Medicaid Only assistance.

The largest number of TANF families receiving cash assistance, by county:

(55.4 percent of all TANF families)

- 22,146 Essex
- 12,924 Hudson
- 9,348 Camden

The number of TANF cash assistance families in other counties ranged from:

- 69 families in Hunterdon County to 5,800 in Passaic County,  
with seven below 1000 families

There were about 2800 fewer eligible TANF families receiving cash assistance in February 1998 than in January, with a decline close to 30,000, or 27 percent, over the number of AFDC families receiving cash assistance two years ago, in February 1996.

- **Single head families:** 2600 fewer were eligible in February 1998 than in January and close to 27,000 below two years ago.
- **Two parent families:** declined nearly 3000 from more than 6300 in February 1995.

### **FOOD STAMP PROGRAM**

(Tables 2 and 6, Graphs 2, 5, and 6)

At the end of February 1998, less than 178,000 households were participating in the Food Stamp Program.

- **TANF:** About 80,000 households with 255,000 persons.
- **Other low income:** nearly 98,000 households with 147,000 persons.
- **Total persons:** 402,000, including 190,000 adults and 212,000 children
- **By County:** 48.9 percent of the households were in:
 

<b>Essex</b>	<b>45,900</b>
<b>Hudson</b>	<b>24,000</b>
<b>Camden</b>	<b>17,100</b>

In the last two years, the number of Food Stamp households in New Jersey remained in the 220,000 to 223,000 range through June 1996, and declined substantially thereafter (from about 220,000 in June 1996 down to less than 178,000 in February 1998).

- The number of **AFDC/TANF** households has been less than the number of **Other Low Income** households for the past two years. **Other Low Income** households peaked close to **115,000** in May 1996 and declined to about **100,000** or less in August 1997 through February 1998. **TANF(FS)** households steadily declined from about **110,000** in February 1996 to about **80,000** two years later.
- **Total FS Recipients:** in the last two years, peaked at almost **516,000** in March 1996, and declined to **402,000** by February 1998, a drop of nearly **114,000**, or **22 percent**.
- **Adult FS Recipients:** peaked at close to **248,000** in March 1996, and were down by close to **58,000 (23.3 percent)** at **190,000** in February 1998.
- **Recipient FS Children:** declined by about **56,000 (20.9 percent)**, from about **268,000** in February 1996 to **212,000** in February 1998.

## **EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE**

(Tables 3, 7 and 9, Graphs 3, 7 and 9)

In February 1998 Emergency Assistance (EA) payments were made for 2378 eligible TANF families and 145 SSI recipients in New Jersey. For TANF families this included payments for:

- **Temporary Rental Assistance (TRA)** for 826 families
- **Motel** placements for 140 families and **emergency shelter** placements for 259 families
- **All other TANF-EA** for 1153 families (including back rent, back utilities, security deposits, furnishings, clothing and food allowance, or transitional housing)
- **825** families in **Essex** County, **237** in **Passaic** County, **227** in **Bergen** County, and for **less than 200** TANF families in each of the other counties.

In the past two years, the average number of EA payments for TANF/AFDC families was 4800 in 1996, and less than 3600 for 1997. Payments for February 1998 were 2000 below February 1996.

- **TRA** payments declined by more than **50 percent** from **1,800** per month in February 1996 to about **800** in February 1998.
- Families receiving **Emergency Shelter** payments averaged **345** per month in 1996, and **293** in 1997.
- **Motel** payments were made for an average of **320** families per month in 1996, and **240** in 1997; and declined from **305** payments in February 1996 to **140** in February 1998.
- Families receiving **Other EA** payments averaged **2388** per month in 1996 and **1762** in 1997. Payments for February 1998 were **900** below February 1996.

For 1995 there were an average of 7400 GA EA recipients, and 6800 for 1996. Of those, GA TRA payments were made to an average of 4400 recipients in 1995, and 4100 in 1996. For the first eleven months of 1997 there were an average of less than 6800 GA EA payments and slightly over 4000 GA TRA payments.

## TANF PARTICIPATION RATES

(Table 8, Graph 8)

In February 1998 the Statewide TANF participation rate was 51.1 percent. This is an increase of almost 3 percentage points over January, and more than *three times* the rate of May 1997. These rates are based on the new formulation mandated by the 1996 federal welfare reform legislation establishing Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF), which went into effect with the implementation of Work First New Jersey welfare reform.

- County rates were distributed as follows:
  - 20.0 to 29.9 percent -- Essex
  - 40.0 to 49.9 percent -- Hudson, Mercer
  - 50.0 to 59.9 percent -- Passaic, Union
  - 60.0 to 69.9 percent -- Bergen, Camden, Monmouth
  - 70.0 to 79.9 percent -- Ocean, Warren
  - 80.0 to 89.9 percent -- Cumberland, Gloucester
  - 90.0 to 99.9 percent -- Atlantic, Cape May, Salem
  - 100 percent -- Burlington, Hunterdon, Middlesex,  
Morris, Somerset, Sussex

## GENERAL ASSISTANCE

(Table 9, Graph 9)

There were about 27,000 GA recipients in November 1997, about 800 less than in October, and the lowest level in the past two years. Most of the decline has been among employable GA recipients. The GA total was 3500 below November 1996 and 5300 below November 1995.

- **Employable GA** recipients reached a peak in March 1996 of more than **23,500**. They remained around **20,000** from June 1996 through April 1997, and less than **18,000** since July 1997. November 1997 was the first month under **17,000**.
- **Unemployable GA** recipients remained in the **10,000 to 11,000** range over the past two years.

## CHILD SUPPORT AND PATERNITY

(Table 10)

In the first quarter of FFY 1998 (October 1997 - December 1997), the total distribution of collections of the Child Support and Paternity Program increased to \$145.8 million, compared to \$136.4 million in the same quarter in FFY 1997 (October 1996 - December 1996).

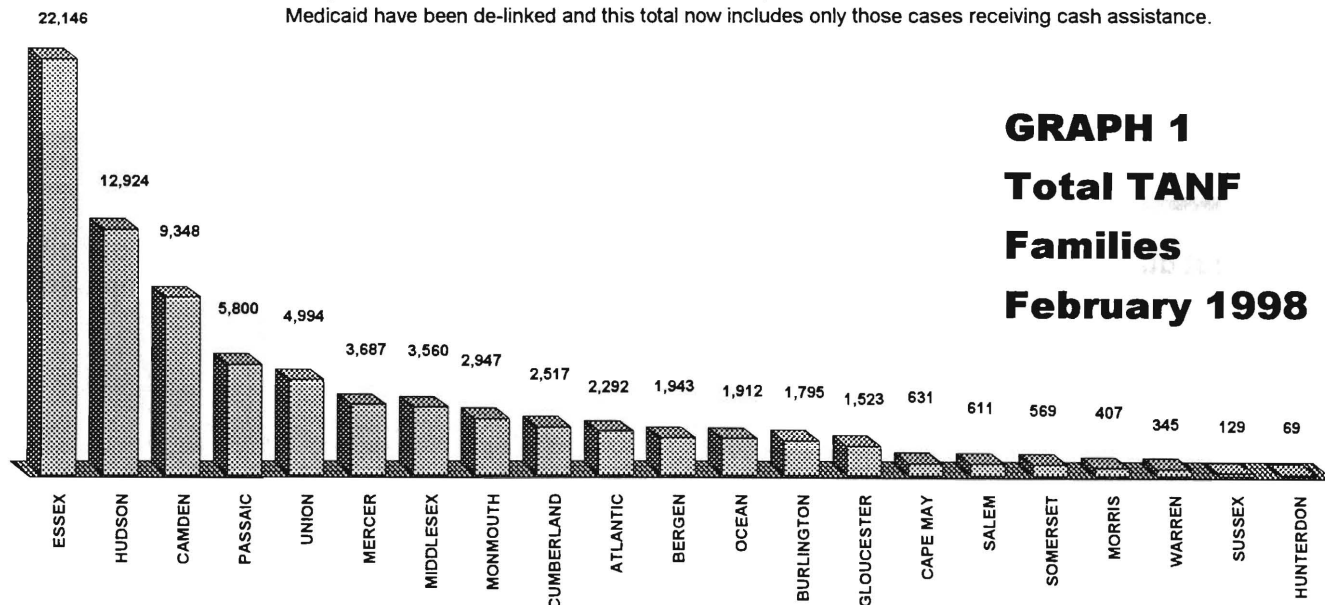

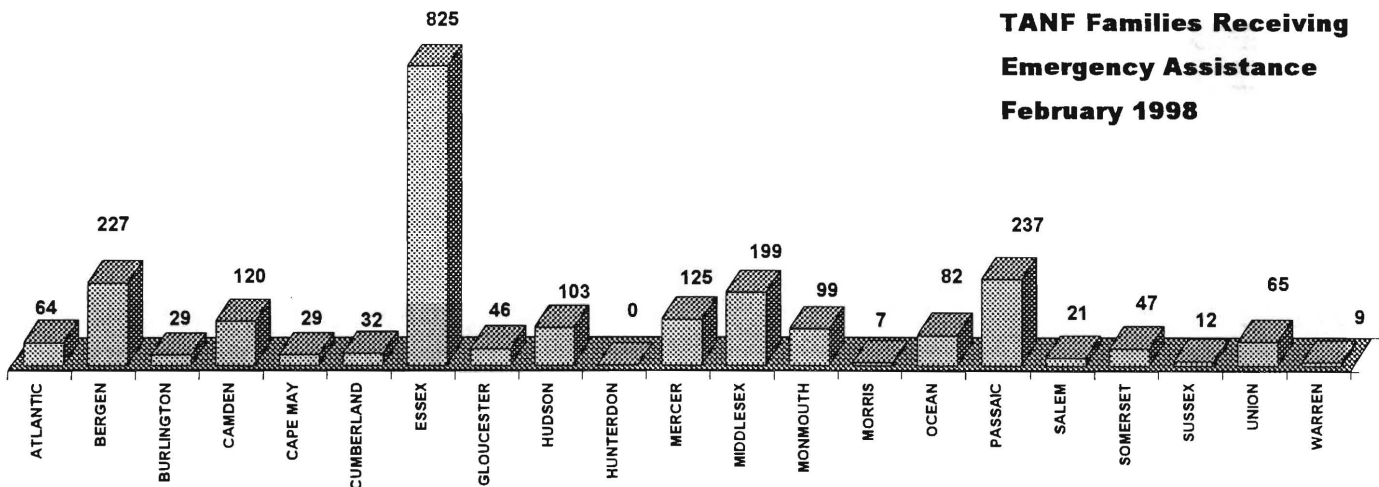

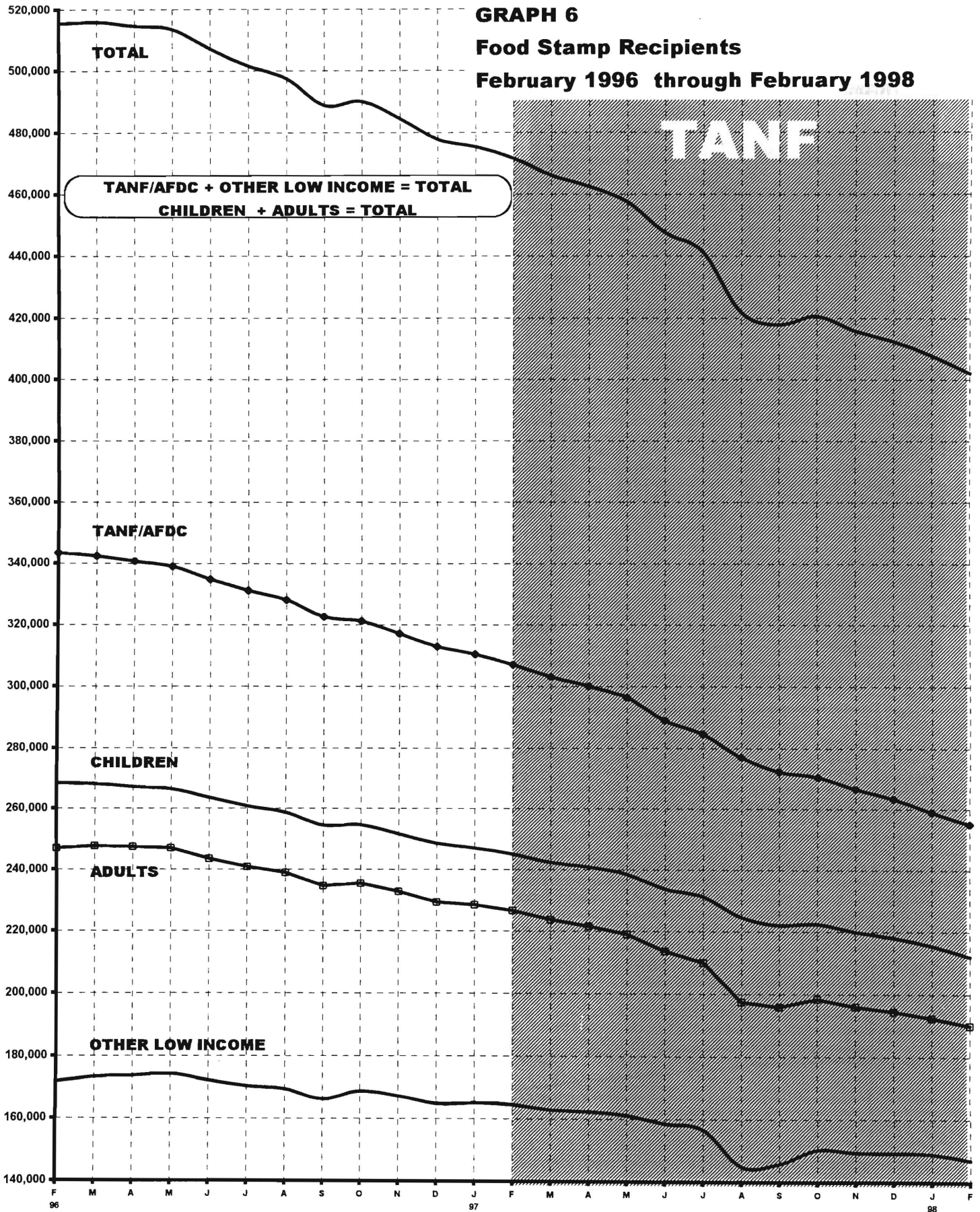

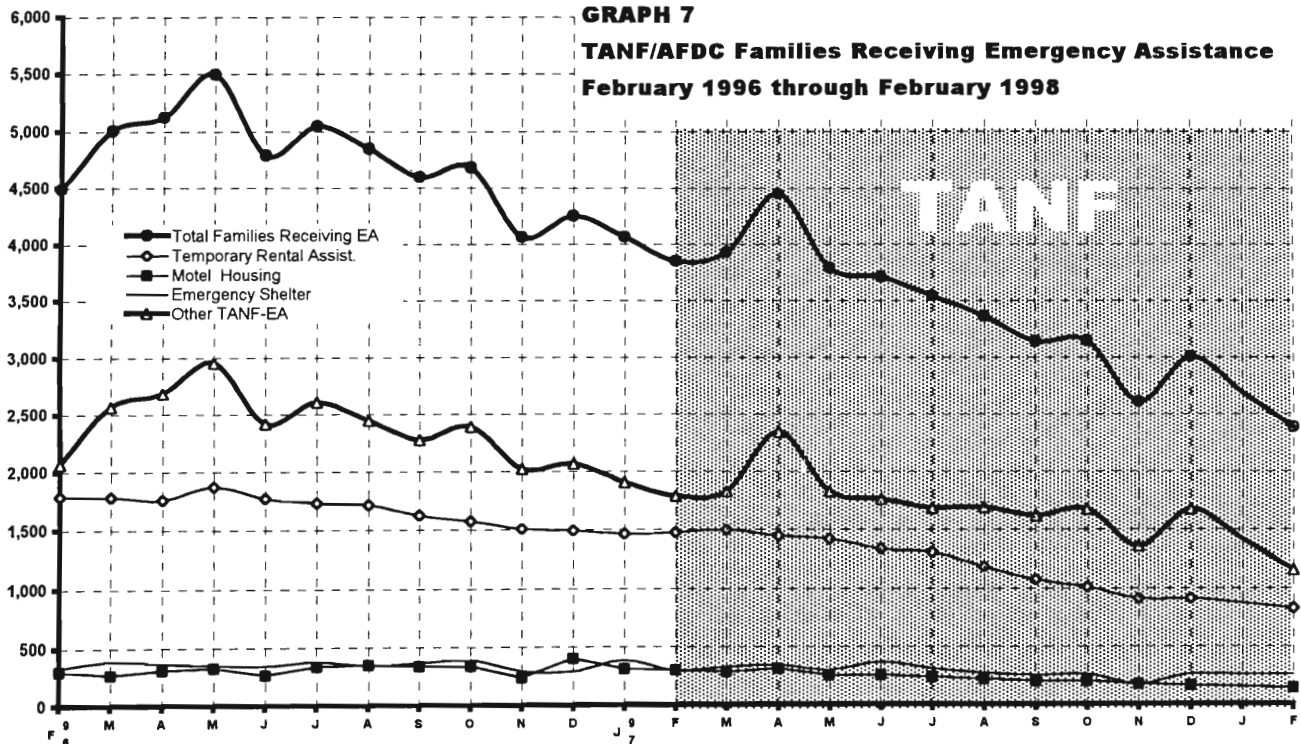

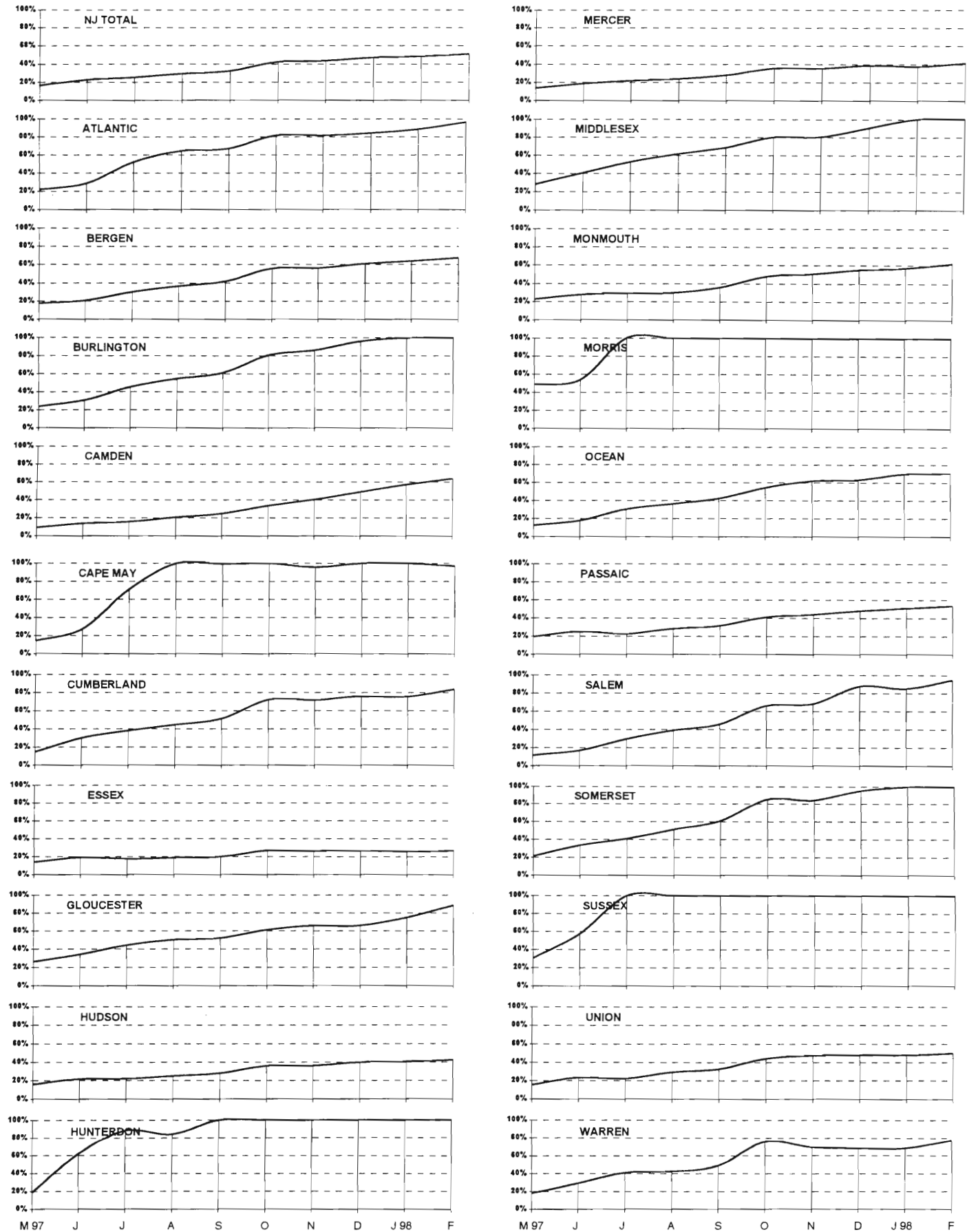

May 1997 - February 1998

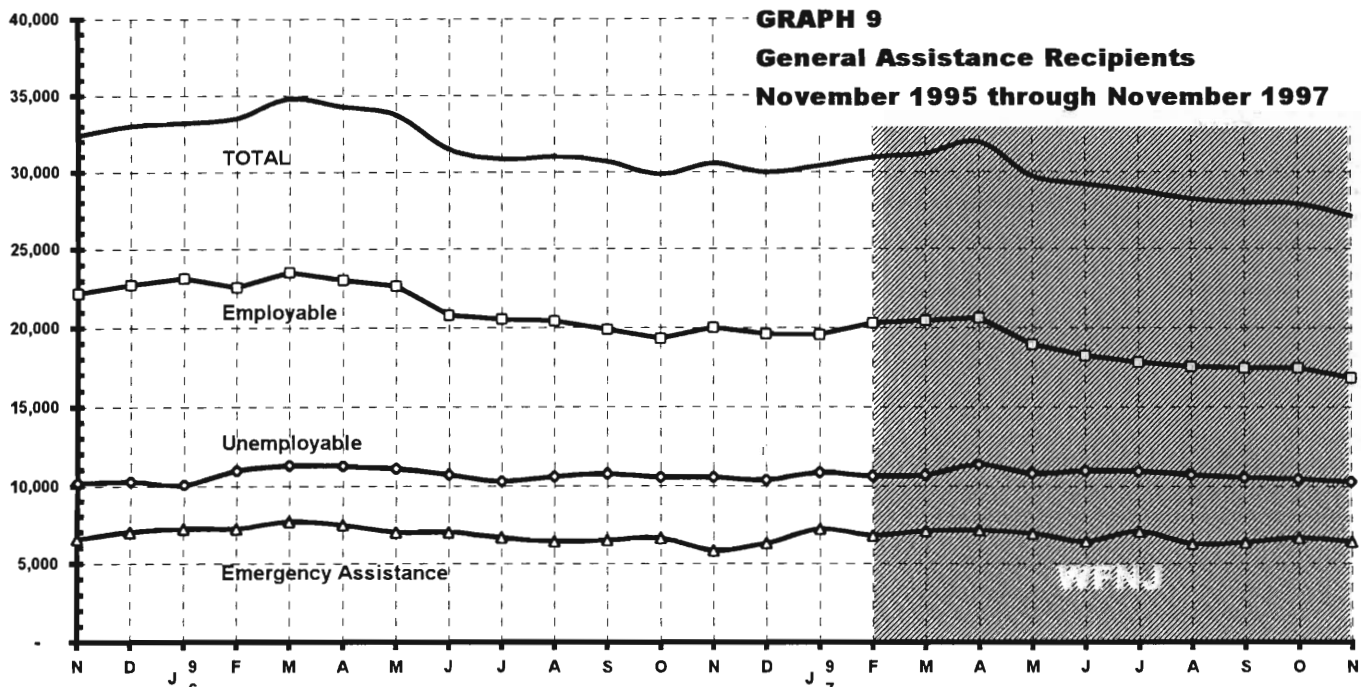

## **Explanatory Notes**

The Department of Human Services Division of Family Development provides basic income and an opportunity to achieve self-sufficiency for individuals and families served by the Division's programs. The Division provides leadership, direction and supervision to those public agencies responsible for administering those programs and plans for and develops policies to promote self-sufficiency.

**WORK FIRST NEW JERSEY (WFNJ)** - Fully implemented July 1, 1997, this is New Jersey's welfare reform program which responds to the requirements of the Federal Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act (PRWORA) of 1996. PRWORA establishes Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (**TANF**) as the replacement for AFDC cash assistance. WFNJ includes two segments, WFNJ/TANF for families with children, and WFNJ/GA (General Assistance) for single adults and couples without dependent children. The emphasis is on achieving self-sufficiency and limits lifetime receipt of financial assistance to a total of five years.

**Total Non-Exempt Recipients** - Calculation of the number of mandatory individuals (FAMIS report # FB304).

**Employment Directed Activities (EDA)** - From Activities Summary Report (OMEGA report # RM064). Unduplicated count of persons participating in Community Work Experience Program (**CWEP**), **All Other Training, or Job Search**.

**Number of Persons Employed This Month, Still Receiving TANF** - From Activities Summary Report (OMEGA report # RM064).

**Participants Receiving Child Care Services** - From Issuance Disbursement Summary (OMEGA report # RM703). Total number of active participants who show receipt of **Child Care**.

**Number of Persons Closed on FAMIS Due to Employment-** From FAMIS report # FM463.

**Post TANF and Receiving Child Care** - Persons no longer in receipt of TANF but still receiving child care. From Issuance Disbursement Summary (OMEGA report # RM703).

**AID TO FAMILIES WITH DEPENDENT CHILDREN (AFDC)** - Replaced by WFNJ/TANF July 1, 1997, AFDC provided financial assistance for dependent children and their natural or adoptive parents, or certain other relatives recognized as taking the place of a parent.

**Regular AFDC (C Segment)** - assistance when only one parent is in the home due to death or absence, or both parents are in the home but at least one is incapacitated.

**Unemployed Parents (F Segment)** - assistance when both parents are in the home, neither is incapacitated and the primary wage earner meets the federally defined criteria for unemployment.

**State AFDC (N Segment)** - assistance when both parents are in the home, neither is incapacitated, and the primary wage earner does not meet the federal definition of unemployment.

**[Medicaid Only families, who had no longer received AFDC financial assistance but remained eligible for Medicaid under applicable provisions which extended coverage beyond the period of AFDC assistance, are no longer shown in these tables because cash assistance and Medicaid have been de-linked.]**

**FOOD STAMP PROGRAM (FS)** - Authorized by Congress as a nutritional supplement program to provide low income households with more food of greater variety and better nutrition. Program eligibility is based on household income, resources, and expenses for medical, shelter, and dependent care. CWA staff refer certain recipients to the New Jersey Department of Labor for participation in the Food Stamp Employment and Training Program.

**EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE (EA)** - Payments to those eligible for WFNJ/TANF or WFNJ/GA, authorized during the 30 consecutive days immediately following the emergency (defined as a substantial loss of shelter, food, clothing, or household furnishings by fire, flood or other similar disaster) or if the eligible individual or family is in an imminent or actual state of homelessness.

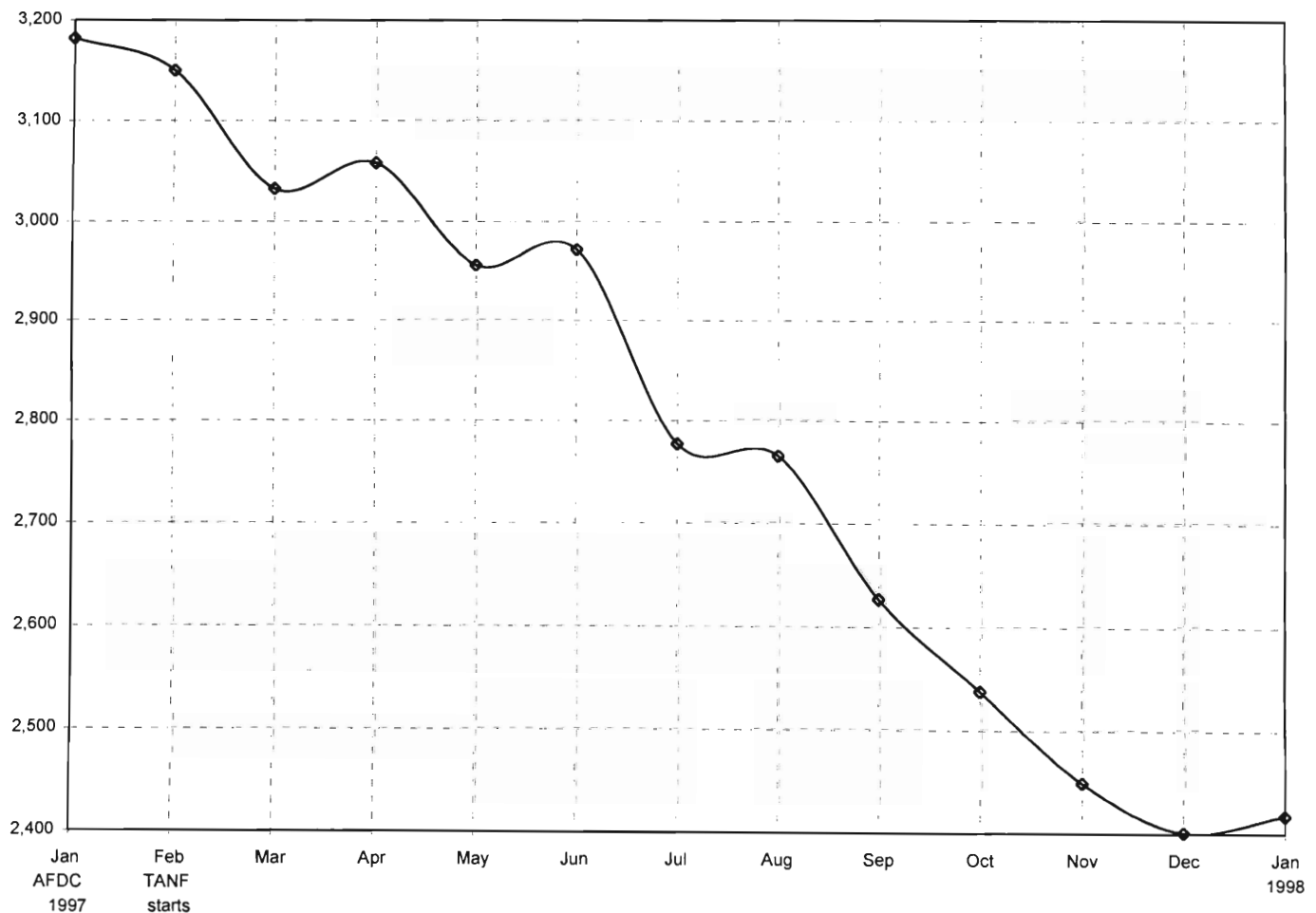

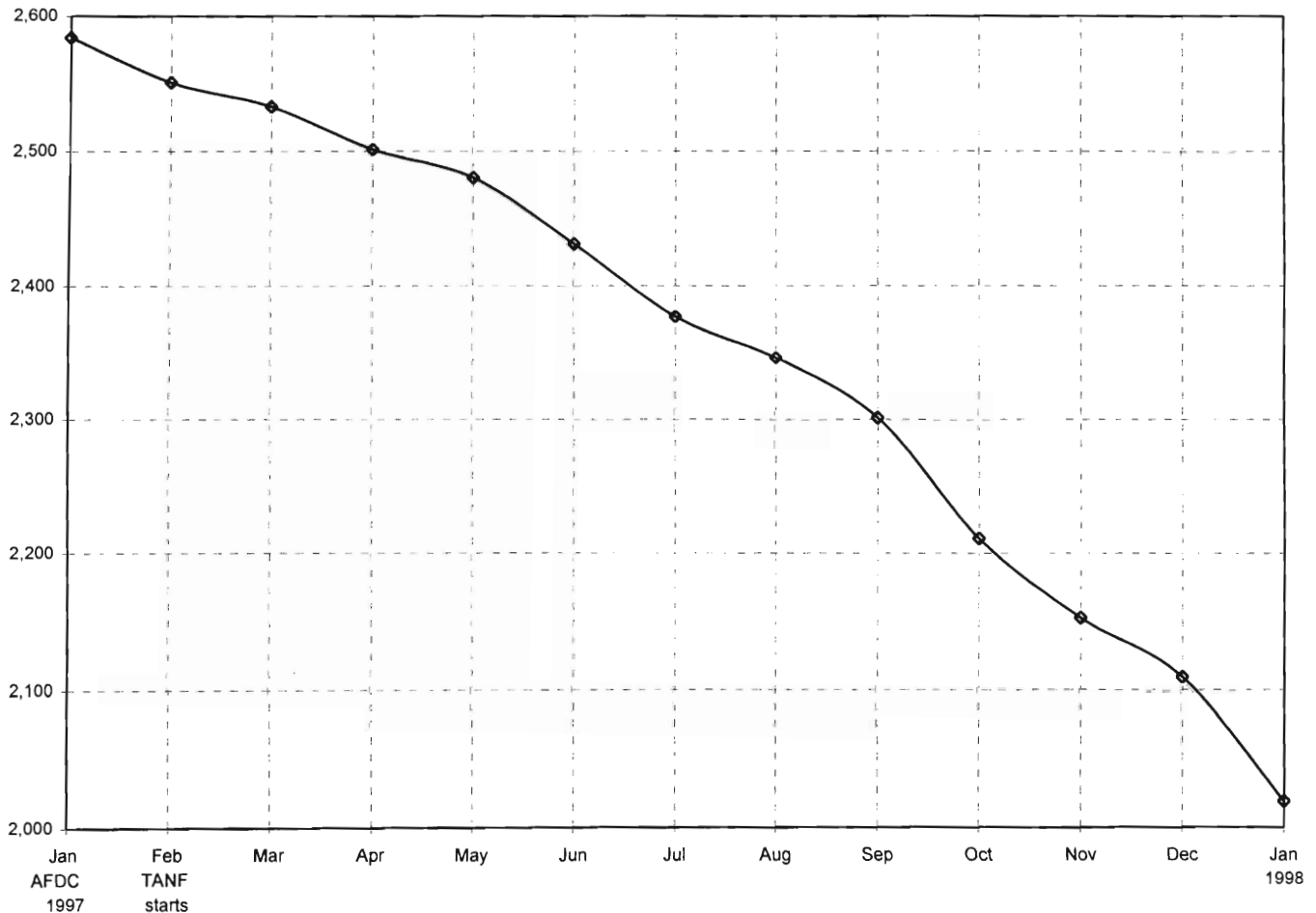

**TOTAL TANF/AFDC FAMILIES RECEIVING ASSISTANCE AT END OF REPORT MONTH**



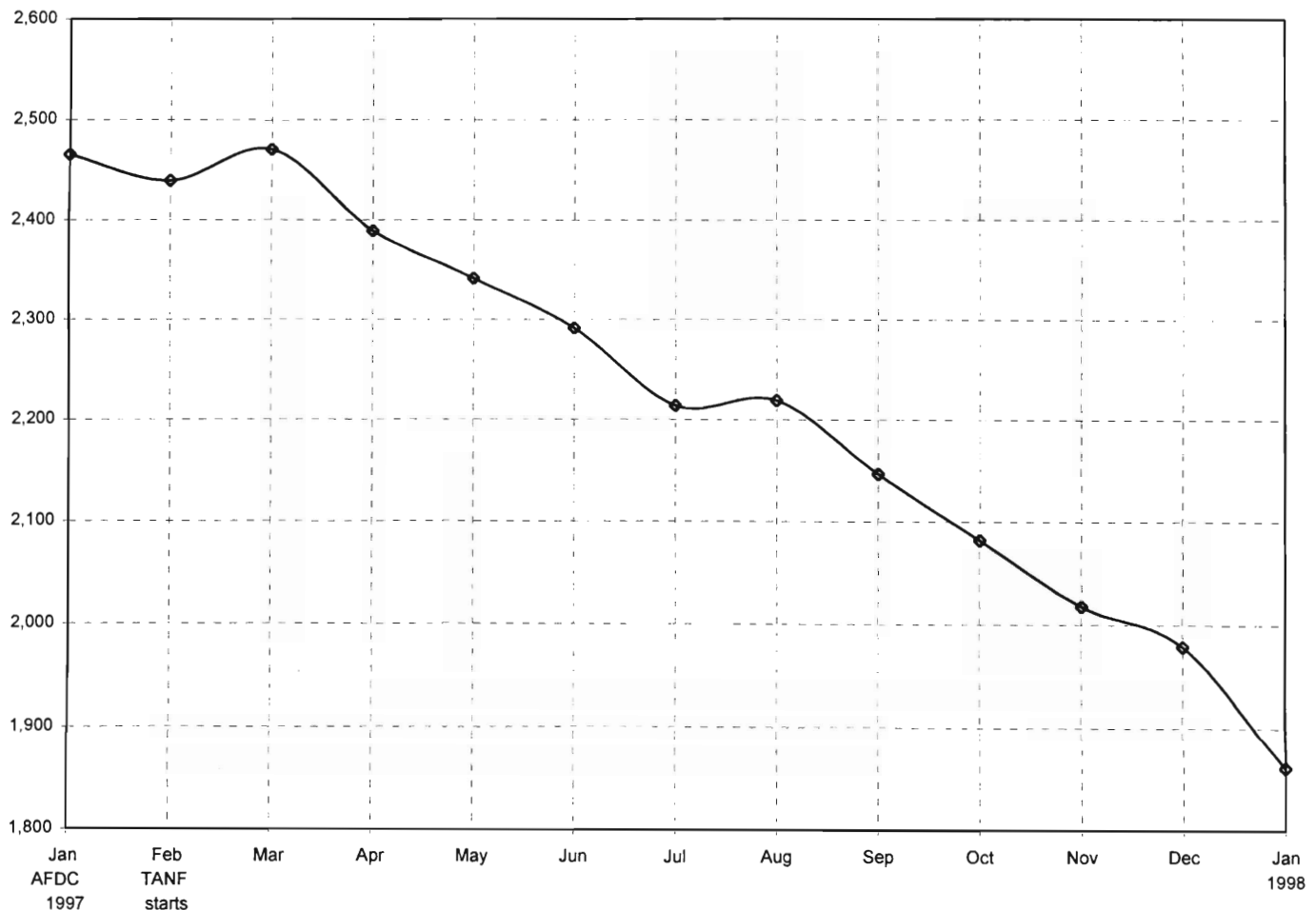

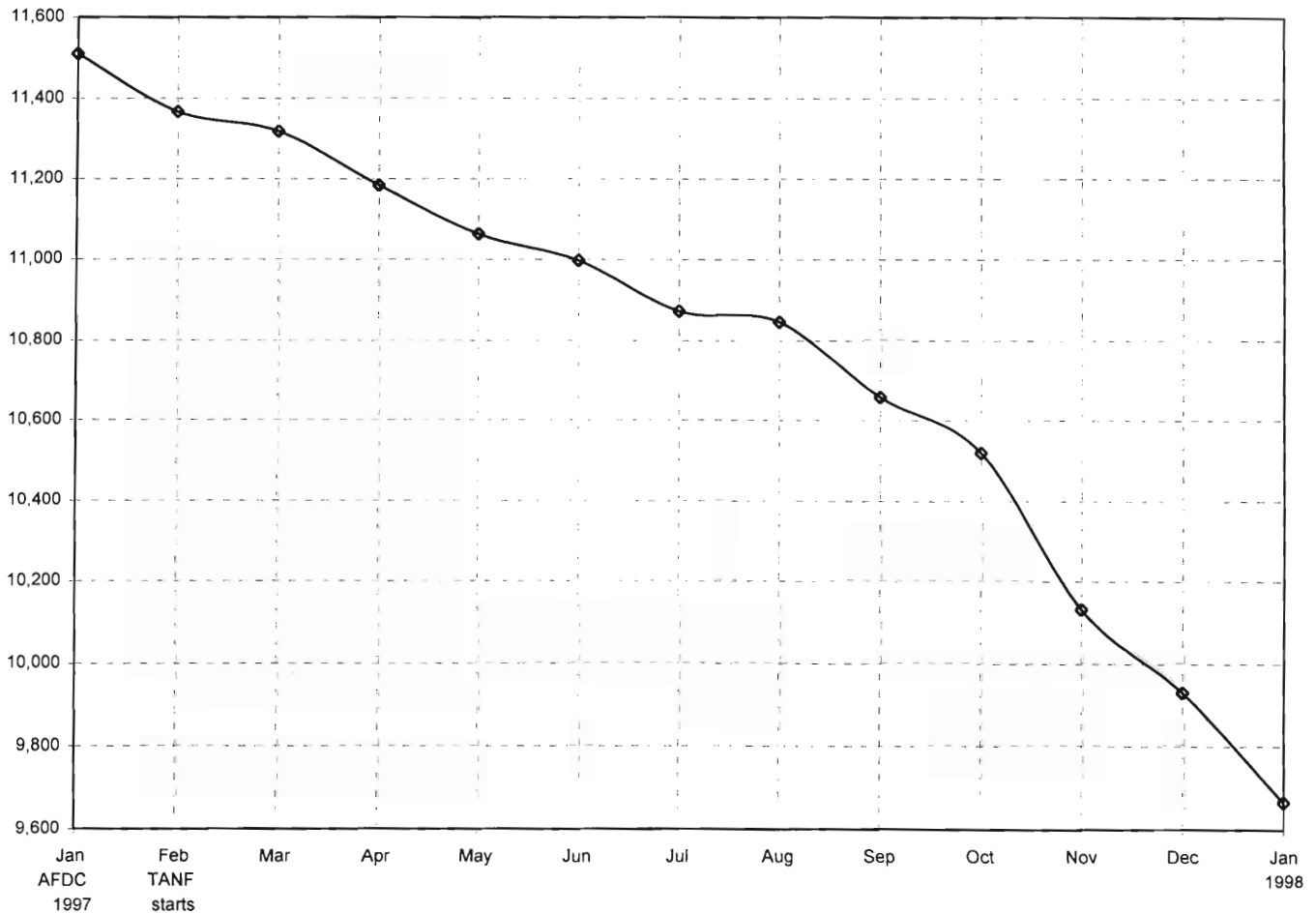

**TOTAL TANF/AFDC FAMILIES RECEIVING ASSISTANCE AT END OF REPORT MONTH**



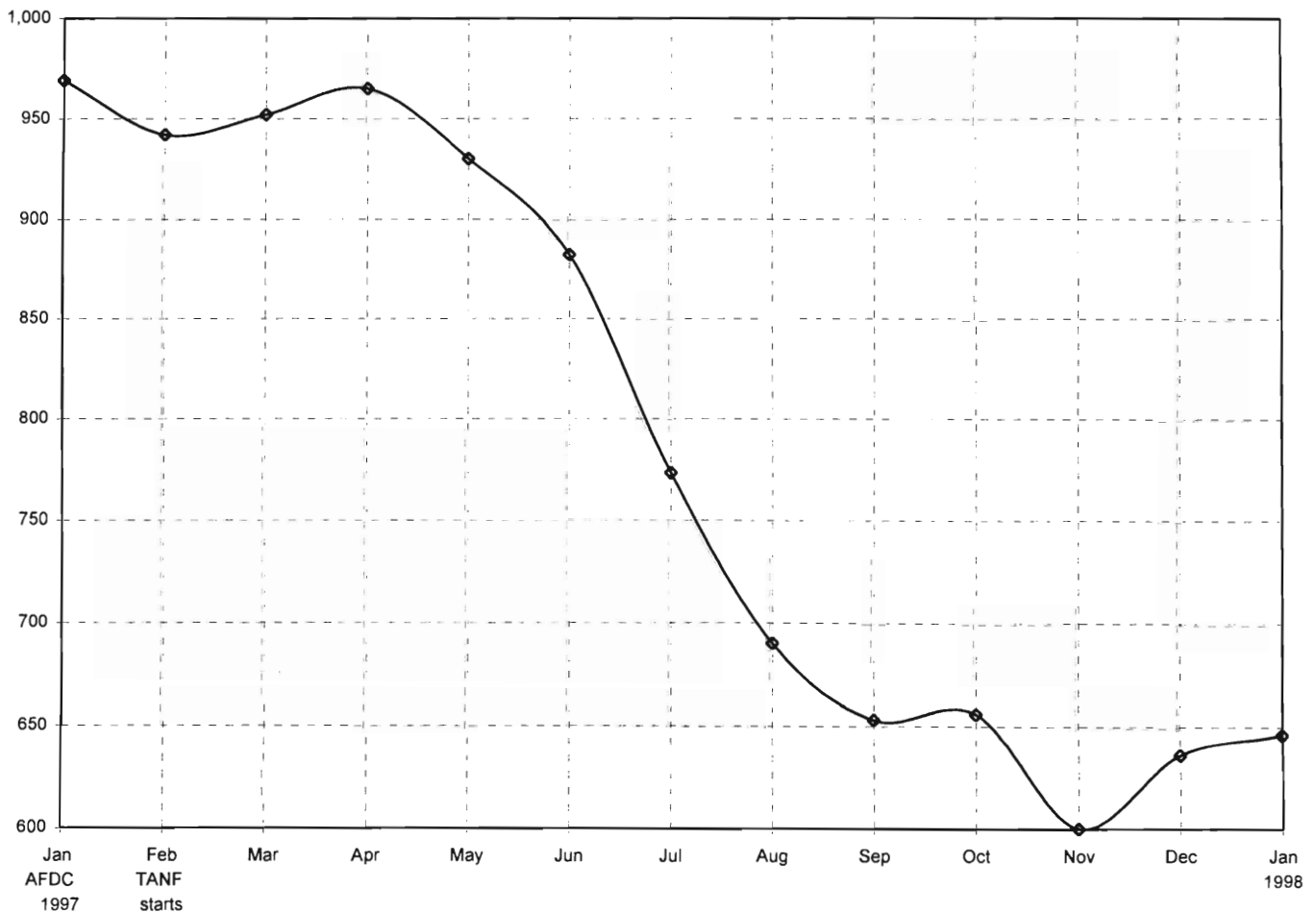

**TOTAL TANF/AFDC FAMILIES RECEIVING ASSISTANCE AT END OF REPORT MONTH**



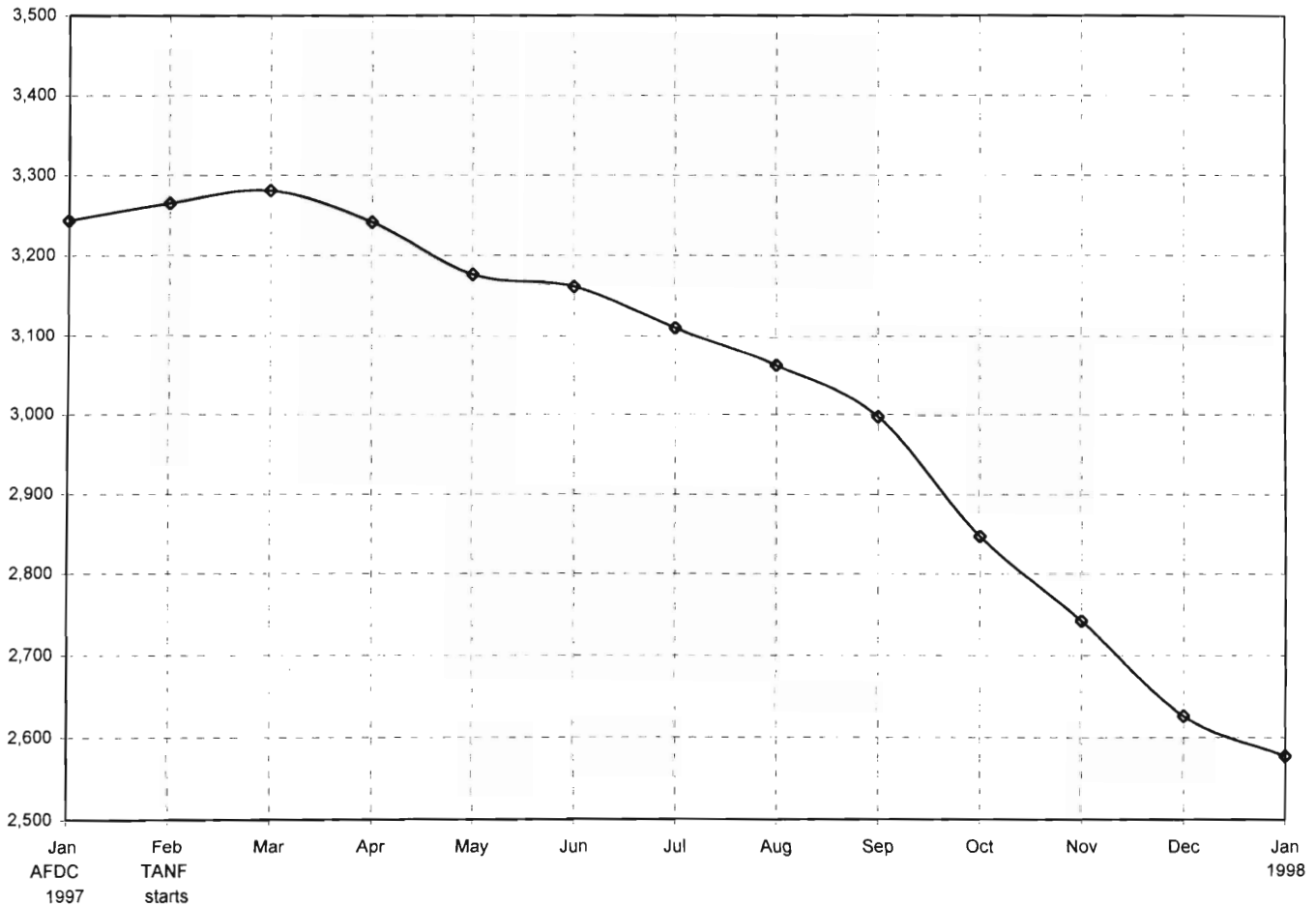

**TOTAL TANF/AFDC FAMILIES RECEIVING ASSISTANCE AT END OF REPORT MONTH**



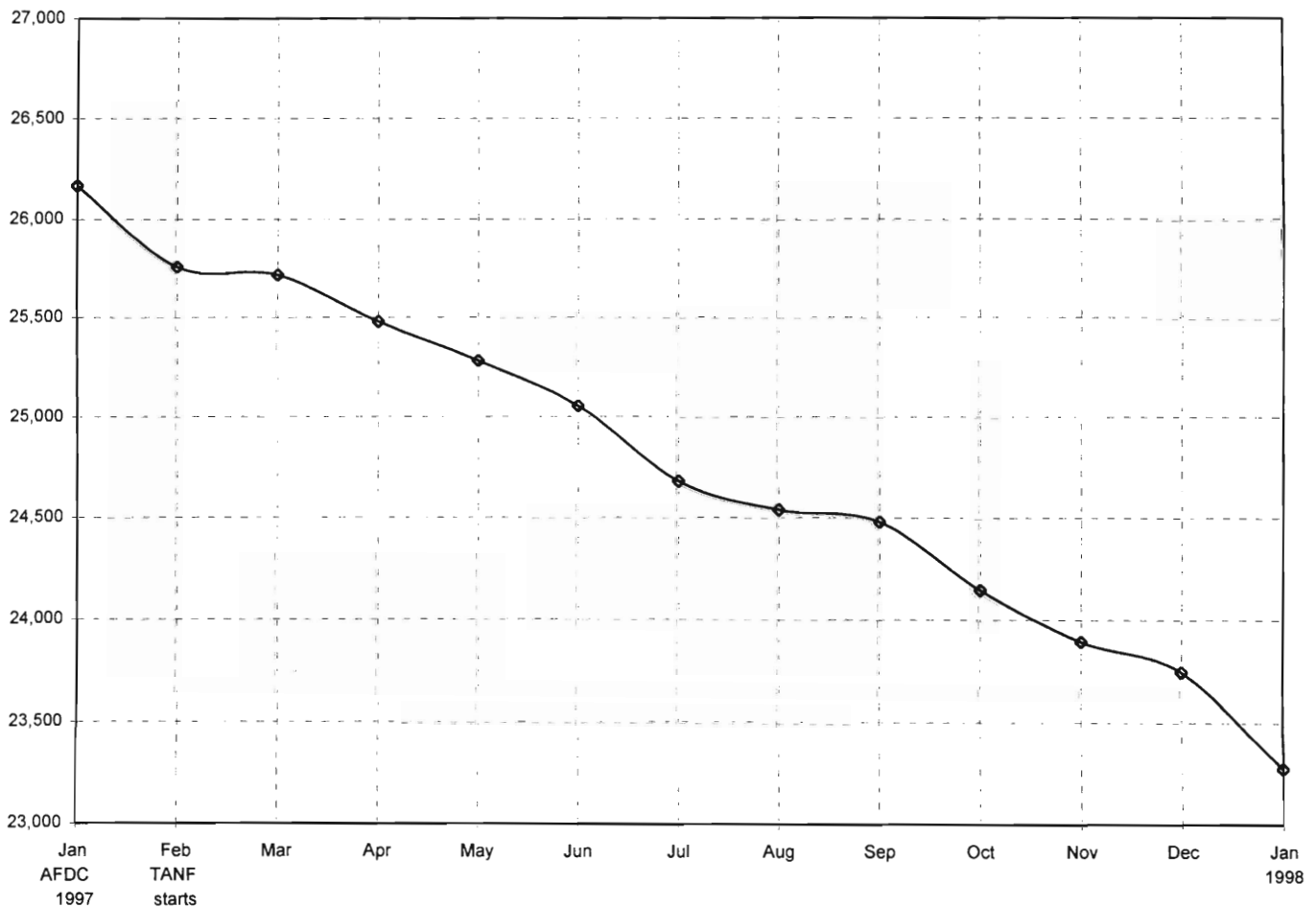
