SUBJECT: Increased Earned Income Disregards for AFDC-Related New Jersey Care...Special Medicaid Programs

Effective October 1, 1989, the earned income disregards applicable in the AFDC program are to be modified. Because, with the exception of the \$30.00 and one-third disregard, the AFDC disregards are also used in the determination of AFDC-related New Jersey Care (including medically needy) eligibility, this communication is to advise you of the revised figures.

The standard work expense deduction increases from \$75.00 to \$90.00. Additionally, the child care deductions are increased and a payment differential is established based on the age of the child receiving the care. The new child care deductions from earned income are as follows:

	<u>Full-Time</u>	<u>Part-Time</u>
Children under age 2	\$200.00	\$150.00
Other children or dependents	\$175.00	\$135.00

This communication should be brought to the attention of all staff involved in making eligibility determinations for AFDC-related cases. Questions should be referred to the field service staff assigned to your county.
