**RESIDENTS, ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES
SEPTEMBER 1996**

Comparing counts for September 30, 1996 with those on September 30, 1995, the following changes are noted

RESIDENTS

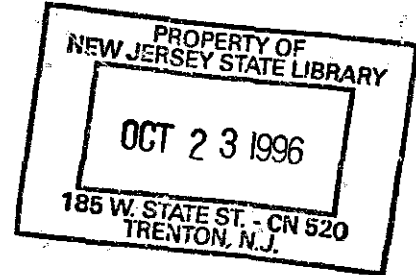
- 4% increase from 26,773 to 27,832 for all institutions;
- 4% increase from 26,092 to 27,037 for the adult jurisdictional population; (county waiting, county contract, county assistance, prison and youth complexes);
- 4% increase from 4,243 to 4,433 for county waiting;
- -0% decrease from 1038 to 1037 for county contract and county assistance;
- 6% increase from 15,377 to 16,290 for the prison complex;
- -3% decrease from 5,434 to 5,277 for the youth facilities; and
- 17% increase from 681 to 795 for the juveniles (juvenile facilities and juvenile waiting).

ADMISSIONS

- -7% decrease from 1,203 to 1,124 for total admissions;
- -7% decrease from 1,094 to 1,015 for adults; and
- 0% (no chg) from 109 to 109 for juveniles.

RELEASES

- 30% increase from 996 to 1,296 for total releases;
- 34% increase from 602 to 804 for adult male parole releases;
- 78% increase from 54 to 96 for adult female parole releases;
- 37% increase from 656 to 900 for total adult parole releases;
- 17% increase from 252 to 296 for offenders discharged at max; and
- 14% increase from 88 to 100 for juvenile releases.



NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I—community, SL II—minimum, SL III—medium, SL IV—maximum and SL V—close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.
