"Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Regional passenger growth slows some to about 6%, inline with the industry.
Transcontinental markets took the biggest hit, having been a low cost battle ground for much of the year. Freight is up 6.7% reflecting recent corrections for Continental and Lufthansa.
