Comparing counts for June 30, 1999 with those on June 30, 1998, the following changes are noted:

RESIDENTS

- 8% increase from 28,949 to 31,286 for the jurisdictional population; (state inmates in county facilities, prison and youth complexes);
- 58% increase from 3,167 to 5,015 for state inmates in county facilities;
- 2% increase from 21,106 to 21,592 for the prison complex;
- 0% increase from 4,676 to 4,679 for the youth facilities.

ADMISSIONS

- 6% decrease from 1,434 to 1,351 for total admissions.

RELEASES

- 14% increase from 1,123 to 1,278 for total releases;
- 7% increase from 698 to 745 for male parole releases;
- 28% decrease from 88 to 63 for female parole releases;
- 3% increase from 786 to 808 for total parole releases;
- 13% increase from 337 to 381 for offenders discharged at max.

NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I-community, SL II-minimum, SL III-medium, SL IV-maximum and SL V-close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.

REPORTING OF JUVENILE RESIDENTS ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES DATA has been discontinued. All juvenile offenders became the responsibility of the Juvenile Justice Commission, Department of Law and Public Safety as of July 1, 1996:
