**RESIDENTS, ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES
AUGUST 1996**

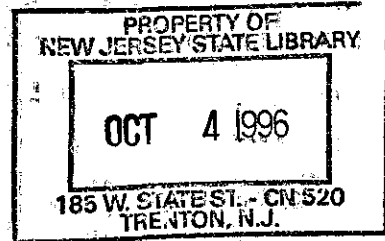
Comparing counts for August 31, 1996 with those on August 31, 1995, the following changes are noted:

RESIDENTS

- 5% increase from 26,564 to 27,887 for all institutions;
- 5% increase from 25,905 to 27,118 for the adult jurisdictional population; (county waiting, county contract, county assistance, prison and youth complexes);
- 11% increase from 4,121 to 4,561 for county waiting;
- 1% increase from 1028 to 1036 for county contract and county assistance;
- 4% increase from 15,331 to 15,968 for the prison complex;
- 2% increase from 5,425 to 5,553 for the youth facilities; and
- 17% increase from 659 to 769 for the juveniles (juvenile facilities and juvenile waiting).

ADMISSIONS

- -34% decrease from 1,534 to 1,012 for total admissions;
- -34% decrease from 1,423 to 940 for adults; and
- -35% decrease from 111 to 72 for juveniles.



RELEASES

- 32% increase from 1,010 to 1,336 for total releases;
- 36% increase from 653 to 888 for adult male parole releases;
- 26% increase from 53 to 67 for adult female parole releases;
- 35% increase from 706 to 955 for total adult parole releases;
- 18% increase from 228 to 270 for offenders discharged at max; and
- 46% increase from 76 to 111 for juvenile releases.

NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I—community, SL II—minimum, SL III—medium, SL IV—maximum and SL V—close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.
