Academic Achievement

Additionally, this school is meeting 100% of its performance targets in the area of Academic Achievement.



Academic Achievement measures the content knowledge students have in language arts literacy and math. For high schools, this includes measures of the school's proficiency rate on both the Language Arts Literacy and Math sections of the New Jersey High School Proficiency Assessment (HSPA). A proficiency rate is calculated by summing the count of students who scored either proficient or advanced proficient on the assessment and dividing by the count of valid test scores.

College and Career Readiness

This school outperforms 28% of schools statewide as noted by its statewide percentile and 35% of schools educating students with similar demographic characteristics as noted in its peer school percentile in the performance area of College and Career Readiness. Additionally, this school is meeting 0% of its performance targets in the area of College and Career Readiness.



College and Career Readiness measures the degree to which students are demonstrating behaviors that are indicative of future attendance and/or success in college and careers. 

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Enrollment by Grade






Enrollment by Ethnic/Racial Subgroup






Proficiency Trends - Math






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Graduation Pathway Rates








Enrollment by Ethnic/Racial Subgroup



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








NJASK Proficiency Trends - Math - Grade Level - 03

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








Chronic Absenteeism Trend








Enrollment by Ethnic/Racial Subgroup






















Chronic Absenteeism Trend






Total School Enrollment Trends




Enrollment by Ethnic/Racial Subgroup



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




















Chronic Absenteeism Trend








Total School Enrollment Trends

Enrollment Trends by Program Participation




































Chronic Absenteeism Trend
