

## NJ Division of Motor Vehicles issues Administrative Order regarding automatic extension of license, registration and inspection dates for eligible members of the National Guard.

Administrative Order No. 2003-01 provides eligible National Guard and Reserve members with automatic extension of drivers license, registration, and inspection expiration dates in accordance with the Governor's Executive Order #54. This order was signed by Governor James E. McGreevey on 1 April 2003 to ease the burdens on those military personnel mobilized in the current conflict. Eligible members include those "active duty National Guard personnel and Reservists serving in Operation Iraqi Freedom and the war on terrorism," including Operations Noble Eagle and Enduring Freedom.
