# 102ND CAV VIRTUAL TRAINING

Soldiers from the New Jersey Army National Guard's 2-102nd Cavalry conducted pre-deployment training at the Joint Training and Training Development Center-JT2DC at Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst, Jan. 21, 2017. The Soldiers from the wheeled assault platoon performed collective crew and unit tactical maneuvers in the virtual environment of the the Mobile TOW ITAS CST (Tube Launched, Optically Tracked, Wire Guided - Improved Target Acquisition System - Collective Skills Trainer). The Mobile CST provides on-site pre-deployment and sustainment training for crews and leaders in a virtual environment. The exercises begin with a warning order from the instructor to the platoon leader, and proceed through Mission Planning Procedures Operations Order, to the platoon moving out and conducting the mission in virtual reality. **CYBER PROTECTION TEAM 173 WILL BE A JOINT PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN THE NEW JERSEY AND NEW YORK. FOURTEEN TEAM MEMBERS WILL BE FROM NEW JERSEY AND THE UNIT WILL PERFORM FEDERAL AND STATE MISSIONS. ALL OF THE SOLDIERS ON THE TEAM WILL TRAIN AND OPERATE ON A TRADITIONAL PART-TIME BASIS. THE NEW JERSEY-NEW YORK TEAM WILL BE ONE OF 10 NATIONAL GUARD CYBER PROTECTION TEAMS BEING STOOD UP.**

**DION SAID THAT SUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS MAY COME FROM A VARIETY OF BACKGROUNDS AND OCCUPATIONAL SPECIALTIES, BUT MUST SHARE A PASSION AND APTITUDE FOR THE CYBER/INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY FIELD.**

- Ability to obtain a Top Secret Security Clearance.
- U.S. Citizen.
- Physically and mentally fit.
