SUBCHAPTER 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

8:5-1.1 Definition of Board

The following word, when used in this Chapter, shall have the following meaning, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

“Board” means Board of Barber Examiners, Department of Health, State of New Jersey.

8:5-1.2 Conditions under which apprentice barbers practice barbering

(a) Prior to the employment of an apprentice pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:4-29 it shall be incumbent upon the apprentice barber to submit to the proprietor, manager or supervisor his certificate as a registered apprentice. No proprietor, manager or supervisor of any barber shop shall engage or hire an apprentice barber unless he first makes demand for and sees the apprentice certificate.

(b) No registered apprentice shall practice barbering except under the immediate supervision of a registered barber who has held such registration for at least a two-year period of time in a barber shop licensed and operated as required by law.

(c) An apprentice barber shall practice barbering in a licensed barber shop under the personal supervision and employment of a registered barber of this State for a total of not less than 40 hours each week, not more than eight hours per day, five days per week for a period of 18 months excepting therefrom such reasonable periods for time for sickness or vacation. Apprentice barbers who fail to meet this requirement during the term of their initial apprentice certificate may apply for another such certificate. Such apprentice barbers shall be eligible and called for examination before the Board as soon as they have completed the practice barbering time prescribed above and submitted proof of employment by affidavit from the employer and the apprentice certifying that he or she has practiced under the immediate supervision and employment for eight hours a day, five days a week. Apprentice barbers shall immediately notify the Board of any change in employment and the hours they are to be employed per week.

(d) An apprentice who has not fulfilled the required number of hours during the term of his apprentice certificate, shall first apply to the Board for an interview. It shall be incumbent upon such person to prove to the satisfaction of the Board why he should be permitted an extension of time in order to fulfill the requirement for a valid apprenticeship. In no event shall a person be entitled to more than two apprentice certificates valid for an 18 month period each.

(e) All applications for a certificate to practice as a registered apprentice shall be on a form provided by the Board. The candidate for apprenticeship may secure such a form by writing to the Board. All statements made in the application shall be sworn to before a Notary Public of New Jersey or any other person authorized by law to take such action.

(f) All applications for an apprentice certificate shall be countersigned by the master barber employing such apprentice and shall confirm the fact that said apprentice is to be employed by him upon receipt of his certificate as a registered apprentice. A master barber shall notify the Board when and if an apprentice barber leaves his employ or he has elected not to engage the services of such apprentice barber.
