Trenton, NJ – Today, Governor Chris Christie signed the following Executive Order:

Executive Order No. 196 - Ordering all State buildings to fly flags at half-staff on Tuesday, December 8, 2015, in recognition of the lives and in mourning of the victims of the terrorist attack in San Bernardino, California. On December 2, 2015, terrorists attacked a center for people with disabilities in San Bernardino, California, killing at least 14 people, and injuring many others.

"This coordinated attack constitutes the deadliest act of terrorism committed on American soil since September 11, 2001," said Governor Christie. "It is with profound sadness that we mourn the loss of those killed in this attack and we pause to offer our deepest sympathies to their families, friends, and loved ones."
