In consultation with NOAA Fisheries, the lead federal agency responsible for evaluating potential impacts to marine life and habitats from human activities in federal waters, DEP has been monitoring an unusual humpback whale mortality event that has been affecting Atlantic coast states.

DEP continues to partner with NJDOH and the affected local health departments to investigate factors that may be promoting the growth of *Legionella* bacteria.

The free registry aims to help better account for the contributions and impacts of saltwater anglers on ocean ecosystems and coastal economies.
