Gov. Whitman To View Demonstration of Hi-Tech Juvenile Offender Tracking System

Gov. Christie Whitman will be joined by Attorney General Peter Verniero and Juvenile Justice Commission (JJC) Executive Director Paul Donnelly on Tues., Feb. 17 for a demonstration of the state-of-the-art tracking system used by the JJC to monitoring juvenile offenders who are on parole. The system uses voice verification to track the movements of the juveniles. The demonstration will take place at 10:30 a.m. at the Liberty Park Hudson Day Program in Jersey City.

Directions to Liberty Park Hudson Day Program: Take exit 14C off the NJ Turnpike. After toll plaza, bear right, follow signs for Grand Street, Jersey City. At the bottom of the ramp, proceed to Montgomery Street (at the traffic light) and turn left onto Montgomery. Proceed to third traffic light and make a right turn onto Baldwin Avenue. Proceed to eighth traffic light and turn left onto the State Highway. Proceed to second traffic light and turn right onto Central Avenue, then quick right onto Fleet Street. Use parking lot next to the Ukrainian Church at the next corner.
