JUNE 1 VIRTUAL PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED COURT RULE AMENDMENTS AND COMMITTEE REPORTS

The hearing will begin at **10:00 a.m.** and will cover the following 2019-2021 reports previously published and posted for comment by notices to the bar dated February 9, 2021 and February 17, 2021:


- (1) **Committee on Complementary Dispute Resolution**
- (2) **Criminal Practice Committee**
- (3) **Committee on Diversity, Inclusion, and Community Engagement**
- (4) **Committee on the Rules of Evidence**
- (5) **Family Practice Committee (including Suppl. Report)**
- (6) **Municipal Court Practice Committee.**

The hearing also will cover **(7) the report of the Special Committee on Landlord Tenant**, which was published for comment by notice dated April 21, 2021.

Anyone who wishes to speak at the June 1 virtual hearing should so indicate via email sent to Comments.Mailbox@njcourts.gov by Wednesday, May 26, 2021. The request must specify the report and recommendations on which the individual seeks to speak and whether the speaker will be representing an organization. Please note that the time limit on each speaker's presentation will be **five minutes**. In advance of the hearing, those individuals will be provided instructions regarding the process and the technology that will be used.
