Chapter Historical Note

Chapter 26, originally Electrical Bureau, was filed and became effective prior to September 1, 1969. Pursuant to Executive Order No. 66(1978), Chapter 26 was readopted as R.1984 d.316, filed July 11, 1984. See: 16 N.J.R. 1321(b), 16 N.J.R. 2151(b). Chapter 26 was retitled "Bureau of Maintenance Engineering" from "Electrical Bureau" by R.1989 d.230, effective May 1, 1989. See: 21 N.J.R. 628(a), 21 N.J.R. 1151(a). Pursuant to Executive Order No. 66(1978), Chapter

26 expired on August 6, 1989. Subchapter 1, Release of Traffic Signal Information, was adopted as new rules on August 7, 1989 by R.1989 d.458, effective September 5, 1989. See: 21 N.J.R. 1653(b), 21 N.J.R. 2804(a). Subchapter 2, Drawbridge Operations, and Subchapter 3, Reimbursed Highway Safety Lighting, were repealed by R.1989 d.458, effective September 5, 1989. See: 21 N.J.R. 1653(b), 21 N.J.R. 2804(a). Chapter 26, Bureau of Electrical Engineering, retitled from Bureau of Maintenance Engineering was readopted by R.1994 d.401, effective July 8, 1994.
