Aviation Department

The Region's total passenger traffic grew at a double-digit pace, boosted by an early Easter. Domestic and international passenger activity posted double-digit gains, too. Freight continues to be negatively impacted by forwarder's shift to modes whose costs are not tightly bound to the price of petroleum.
