

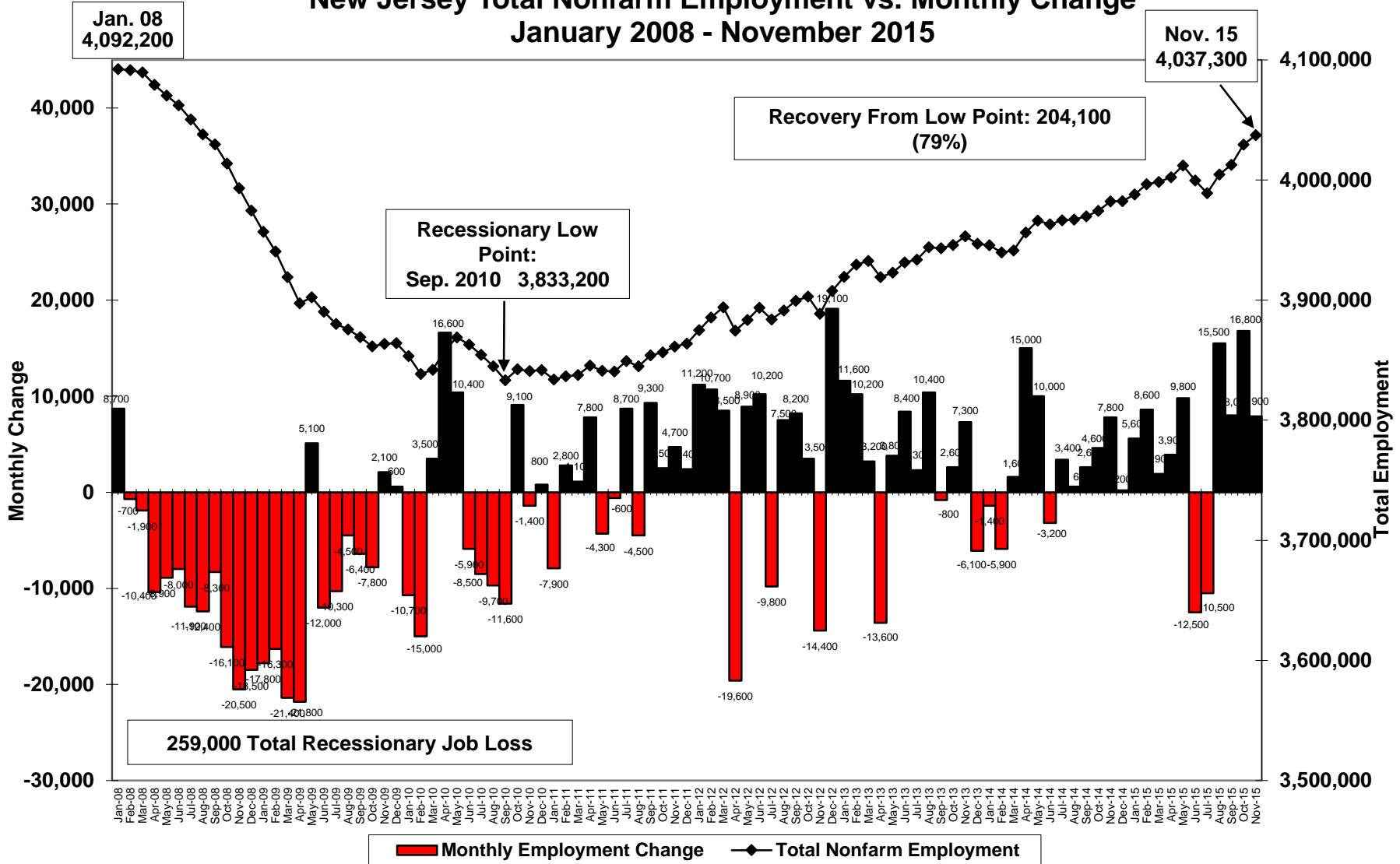

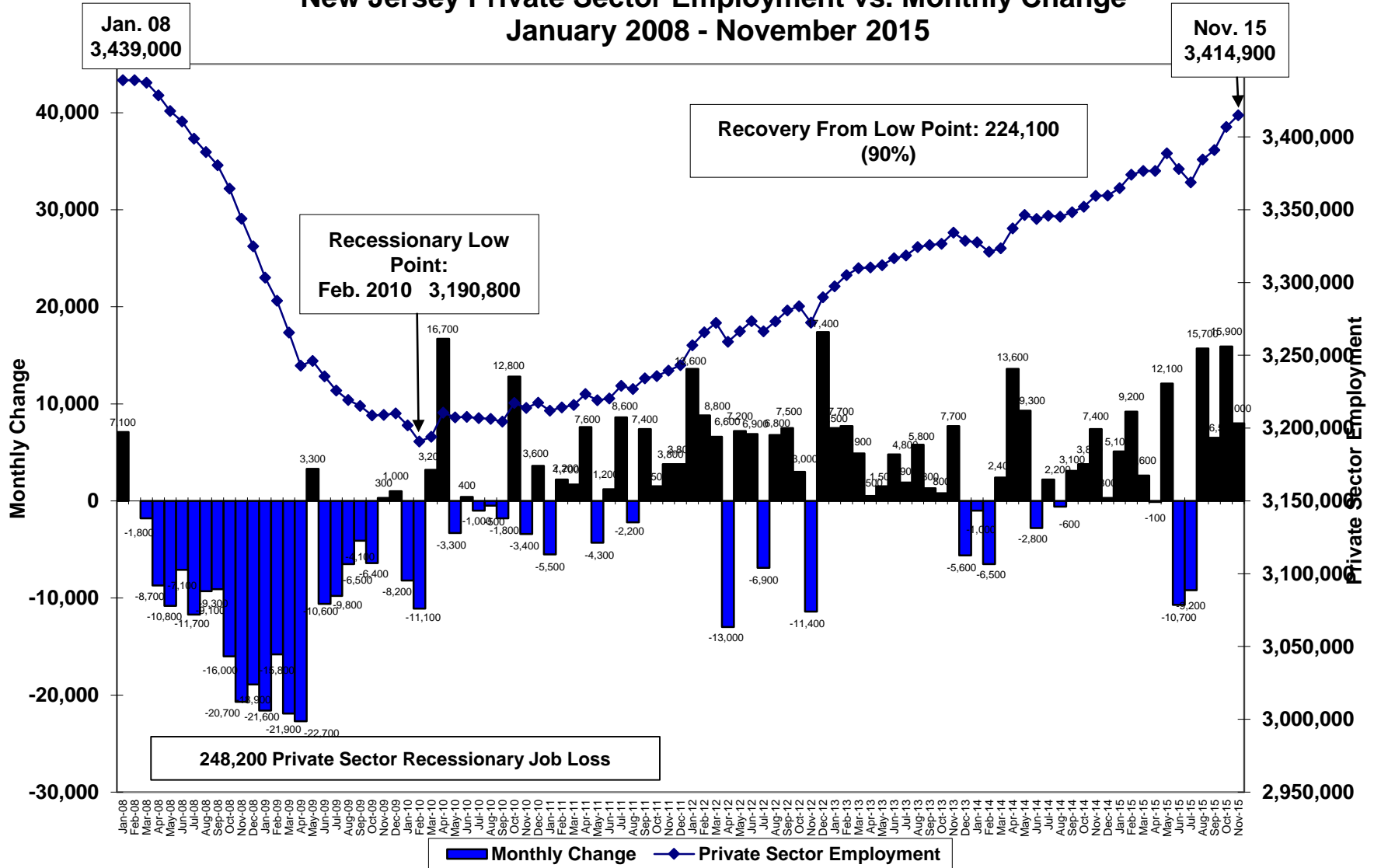

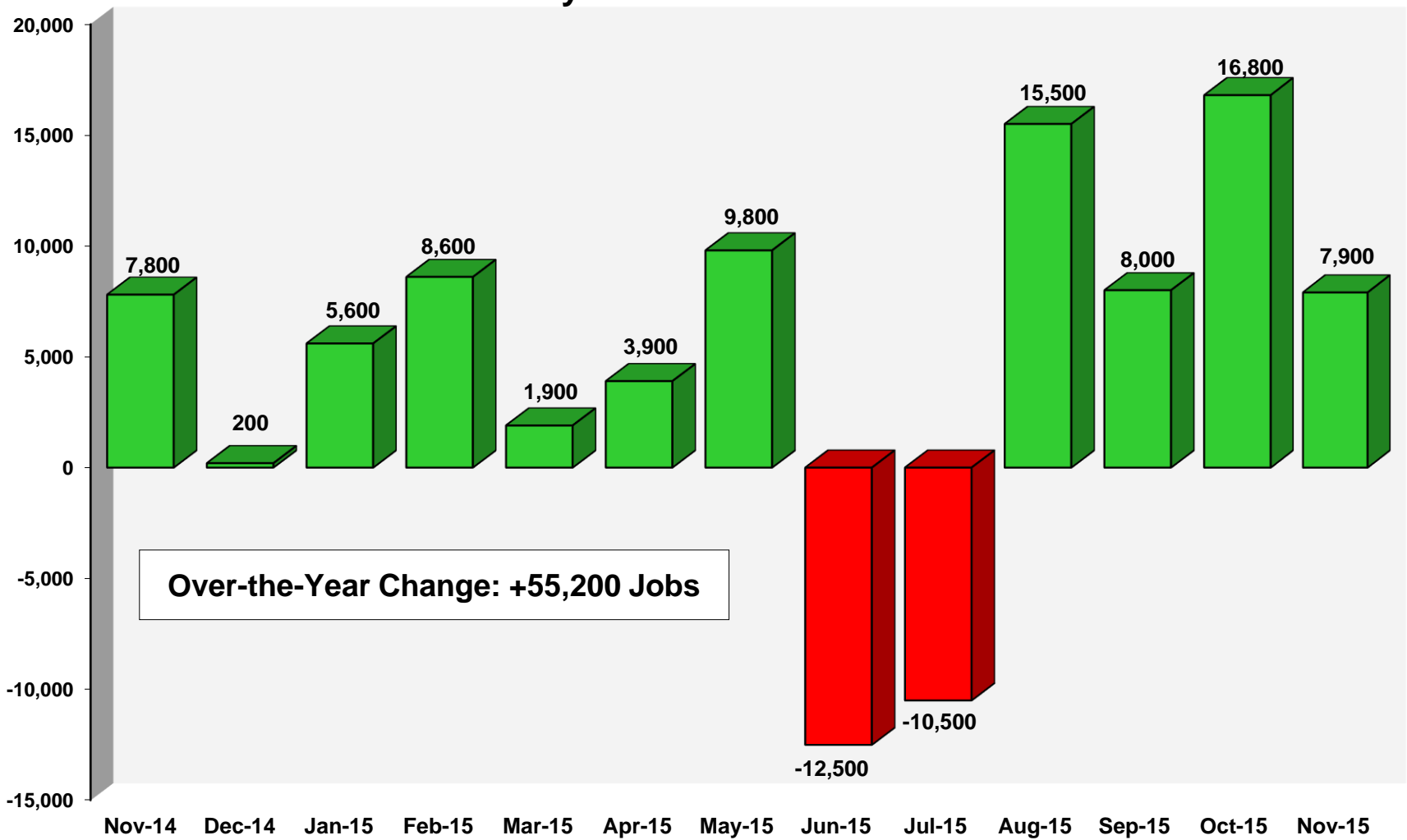
New Jersey Total Nonfarm Employment vs. Monthly Change January 2008 - November 2015



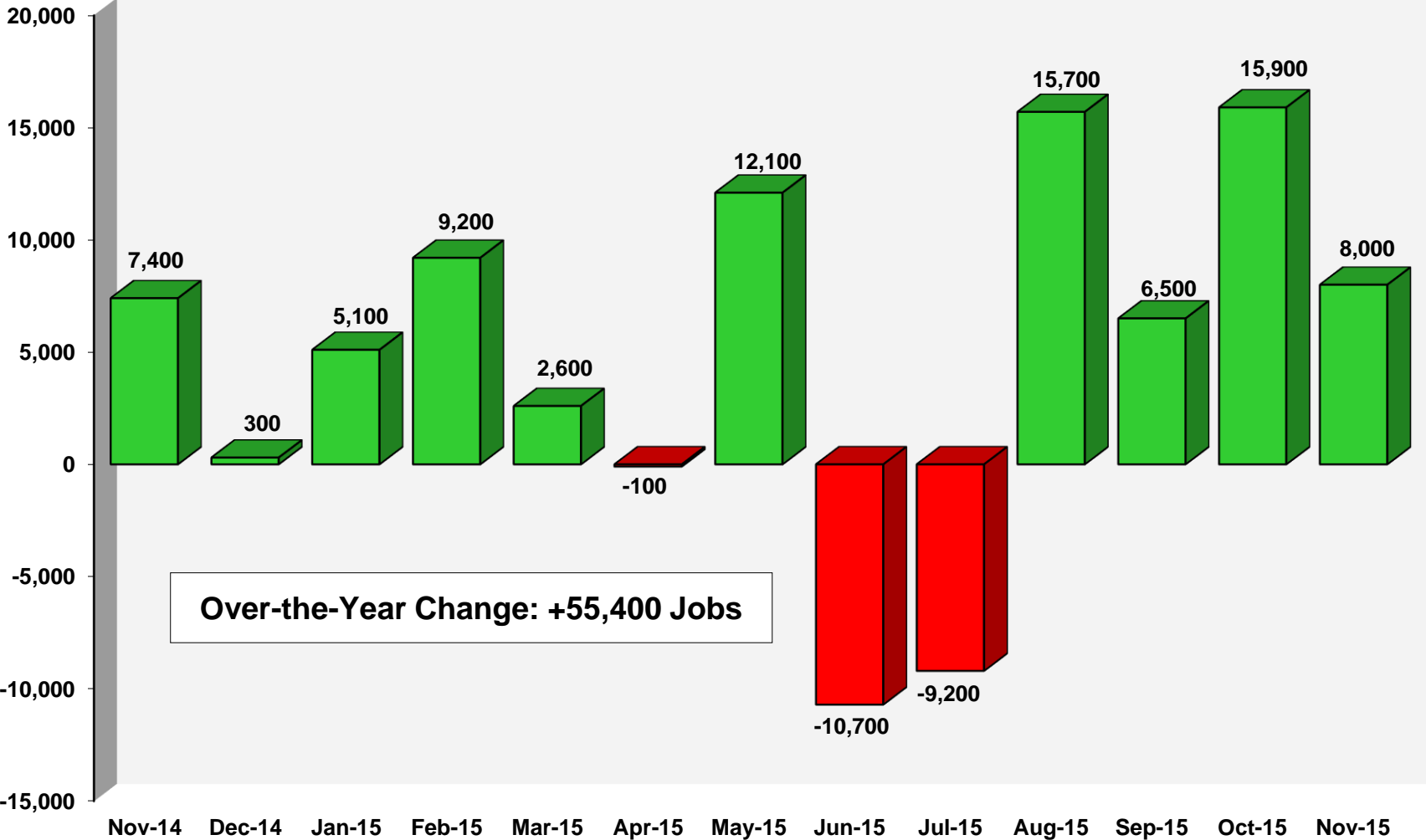
New Jersey Private Sector Employment vs. Monthly Change January 2008 - November 2015



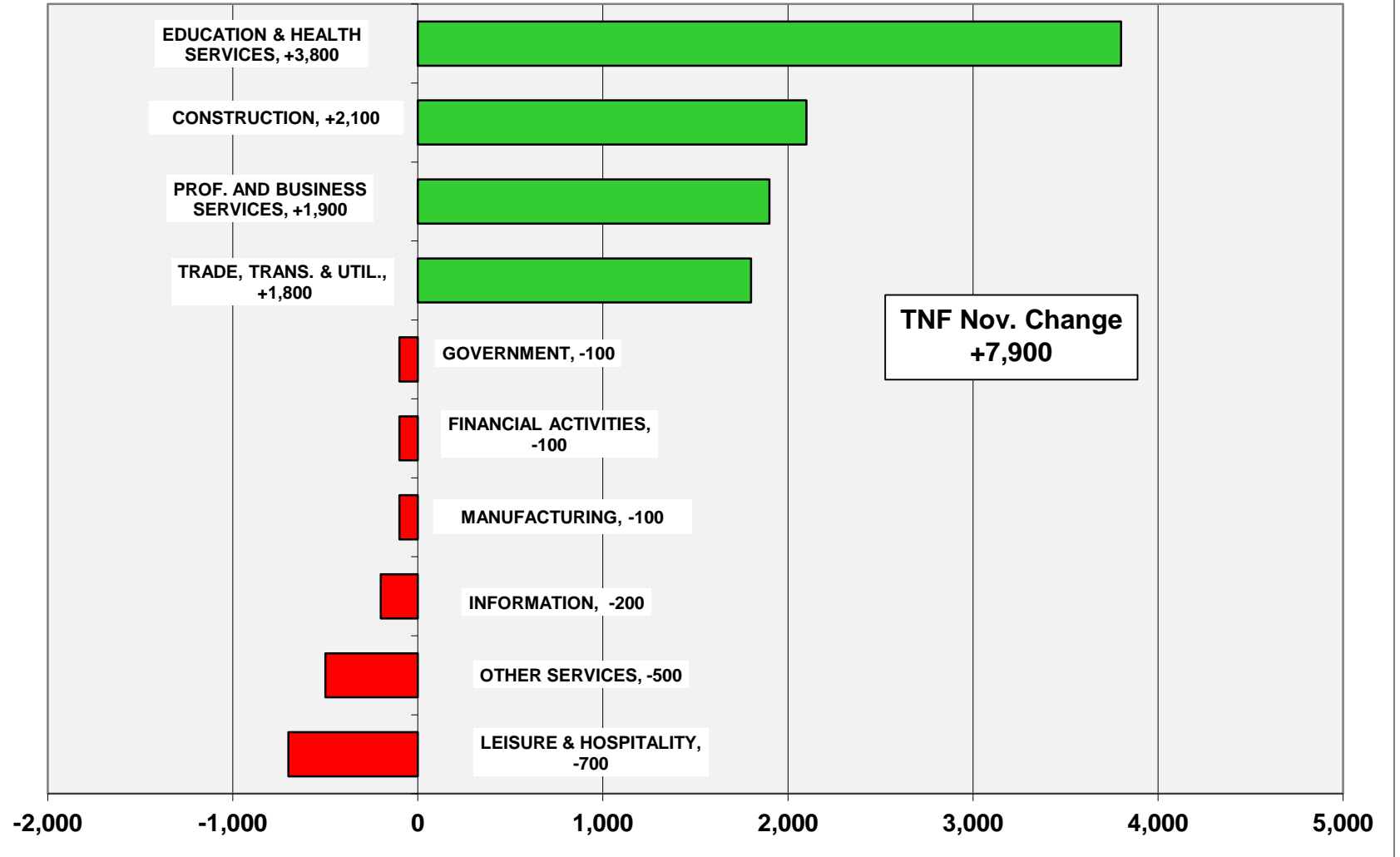
Monthly Total Employment Change New Jersey: November 2014 - November 2015



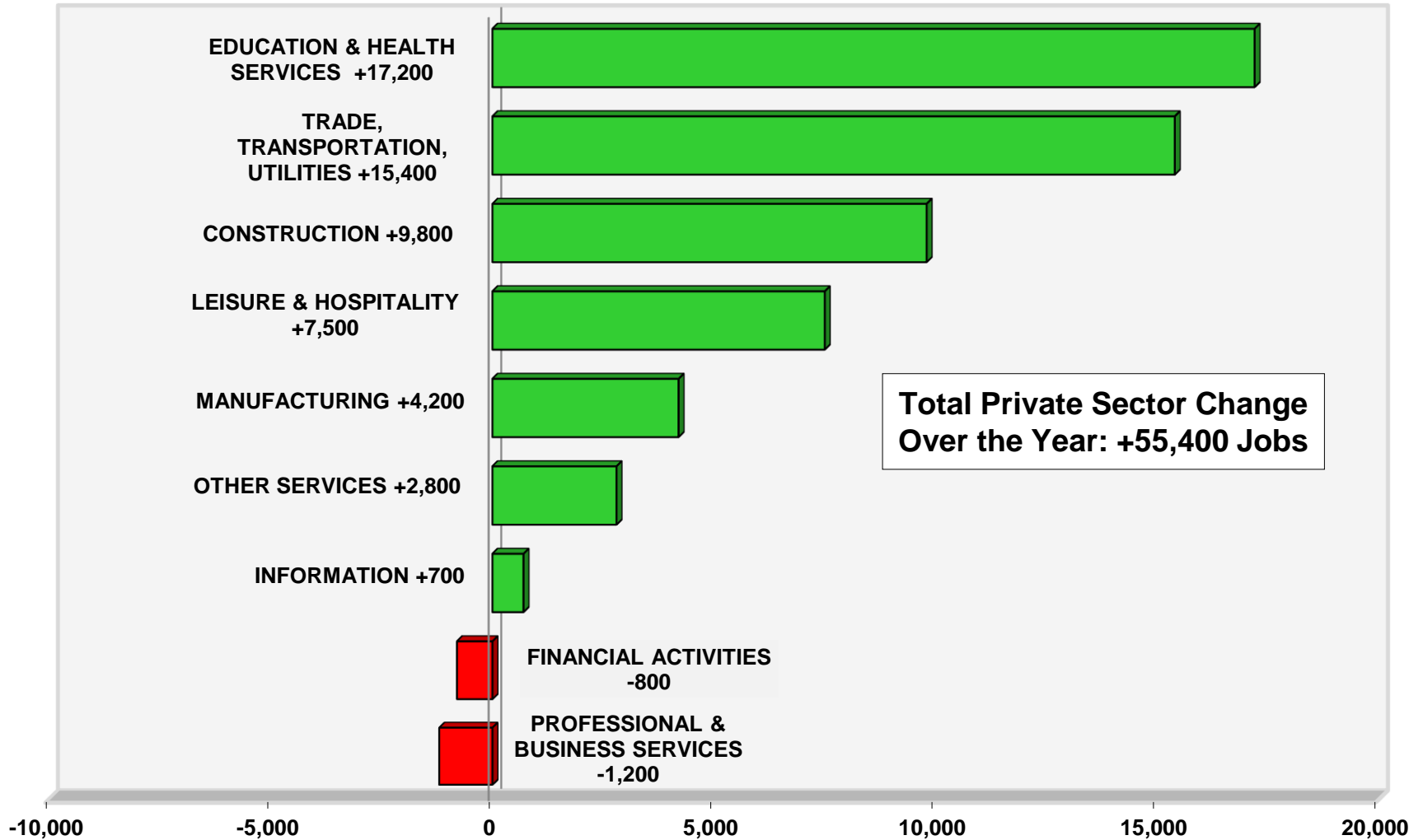
Monthly Private Sector Employment Change November 2014 - November 2015



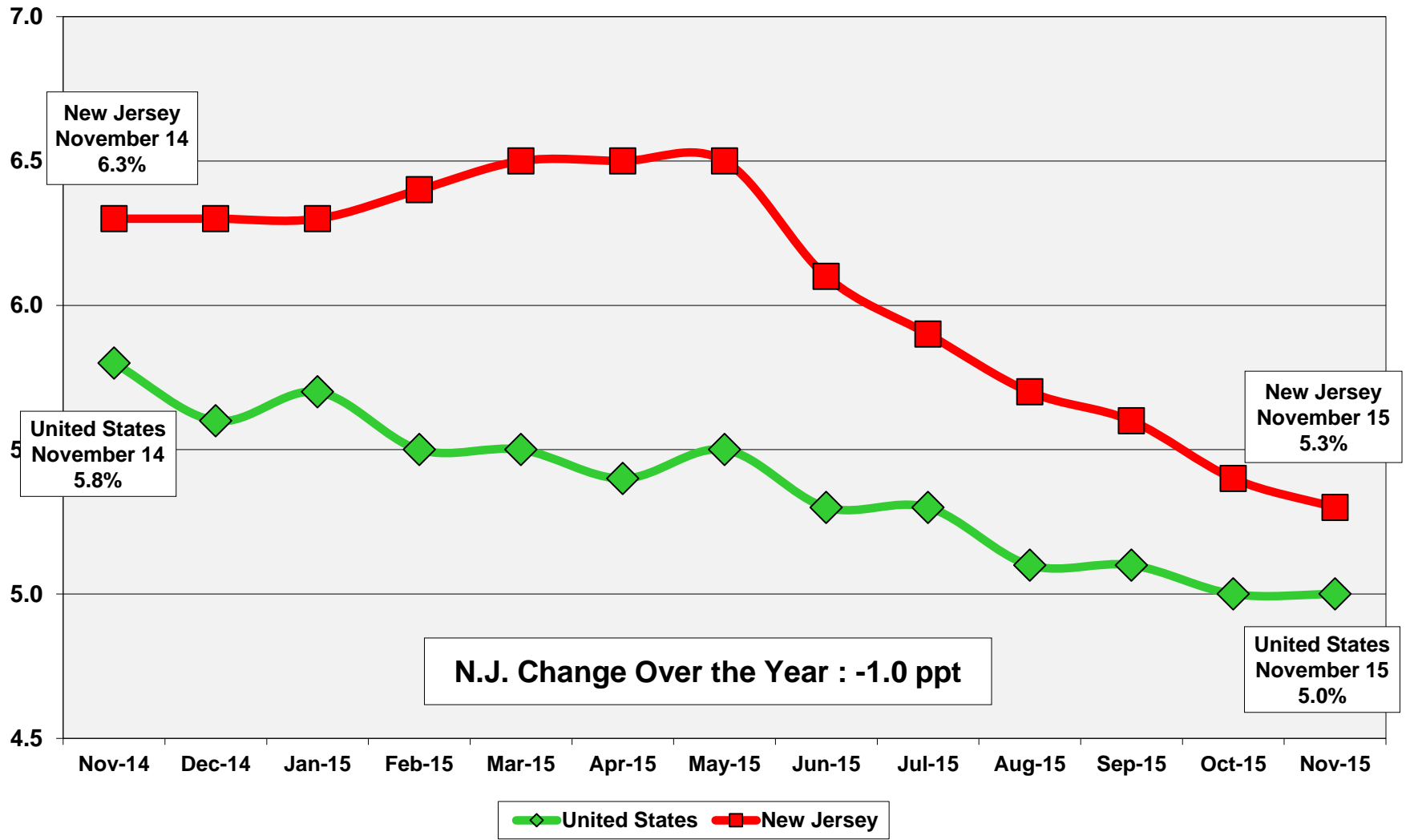

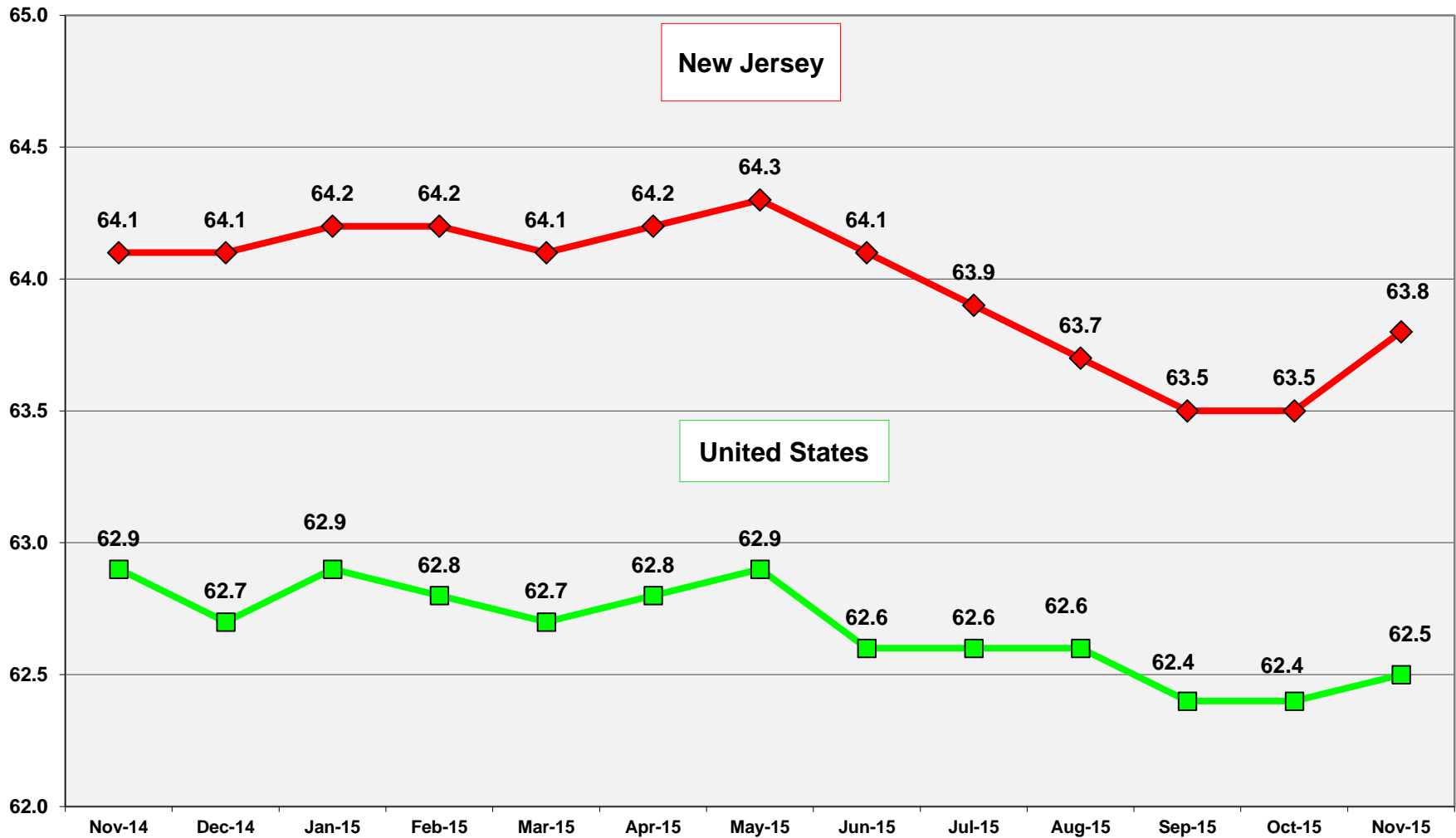
New Jersey Private Sector Employment Change by Industry November 2014 - November 2015



Unemployment Rates, New Jersey vs. United States: November 2014 - November 2015



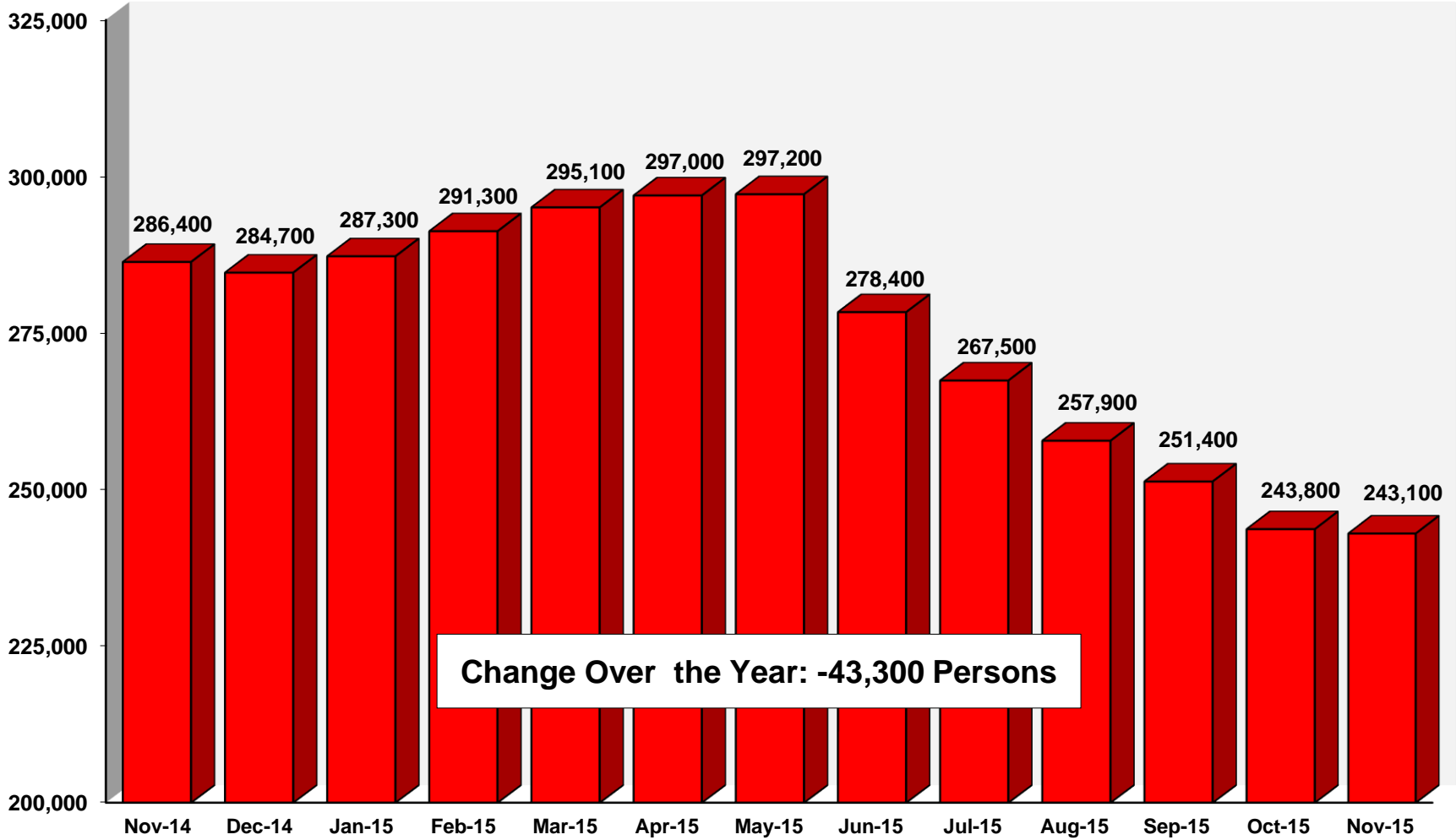
New Jersey vs. United States, Labor Force Participation Rate: November 2014 - November 2015



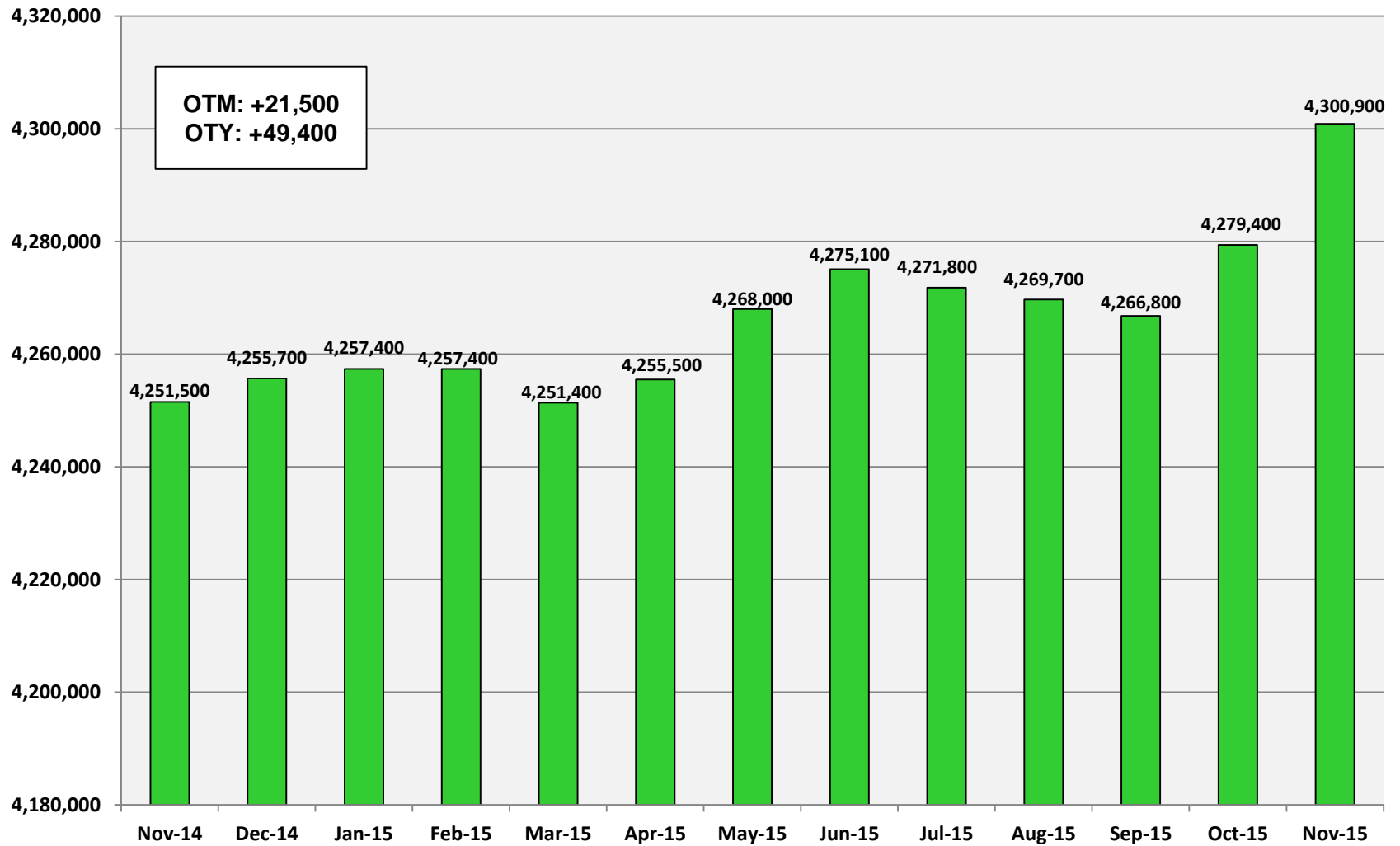

Unemployed New Jersey Residents November 2014 - November 2015

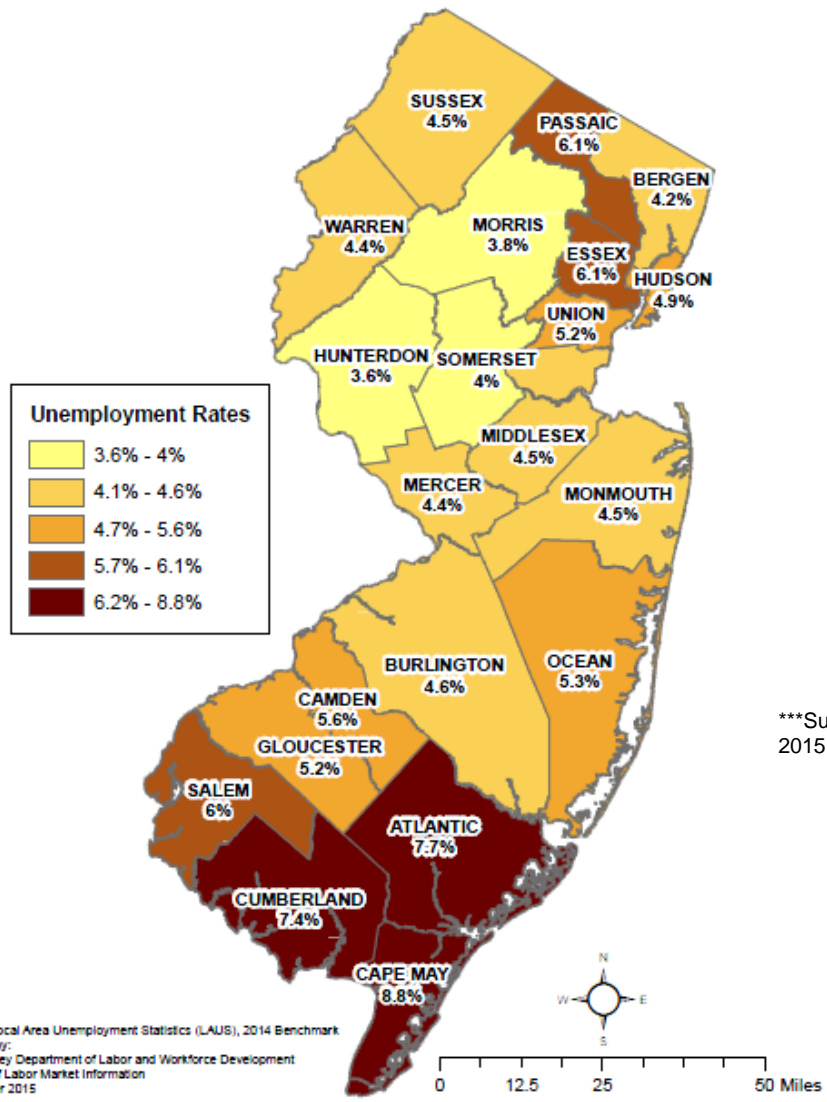


New Jersey Employed Residents: November 2014 - November 2015

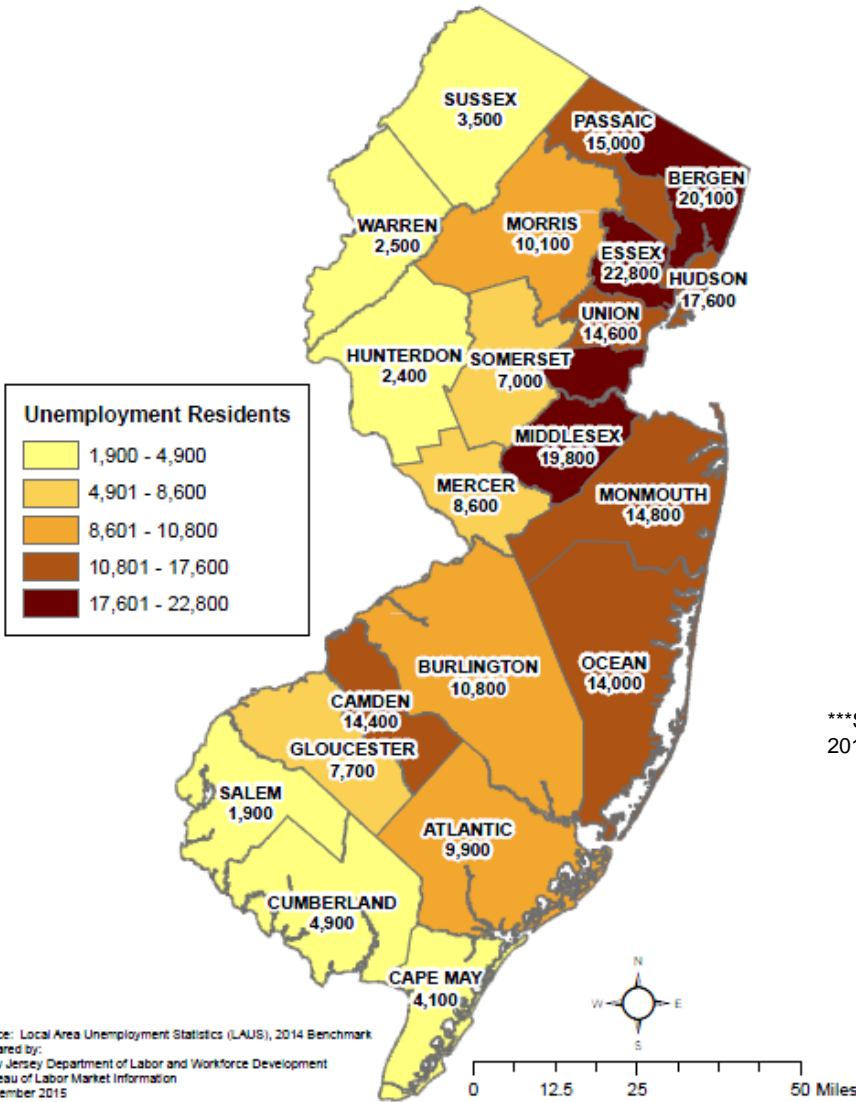

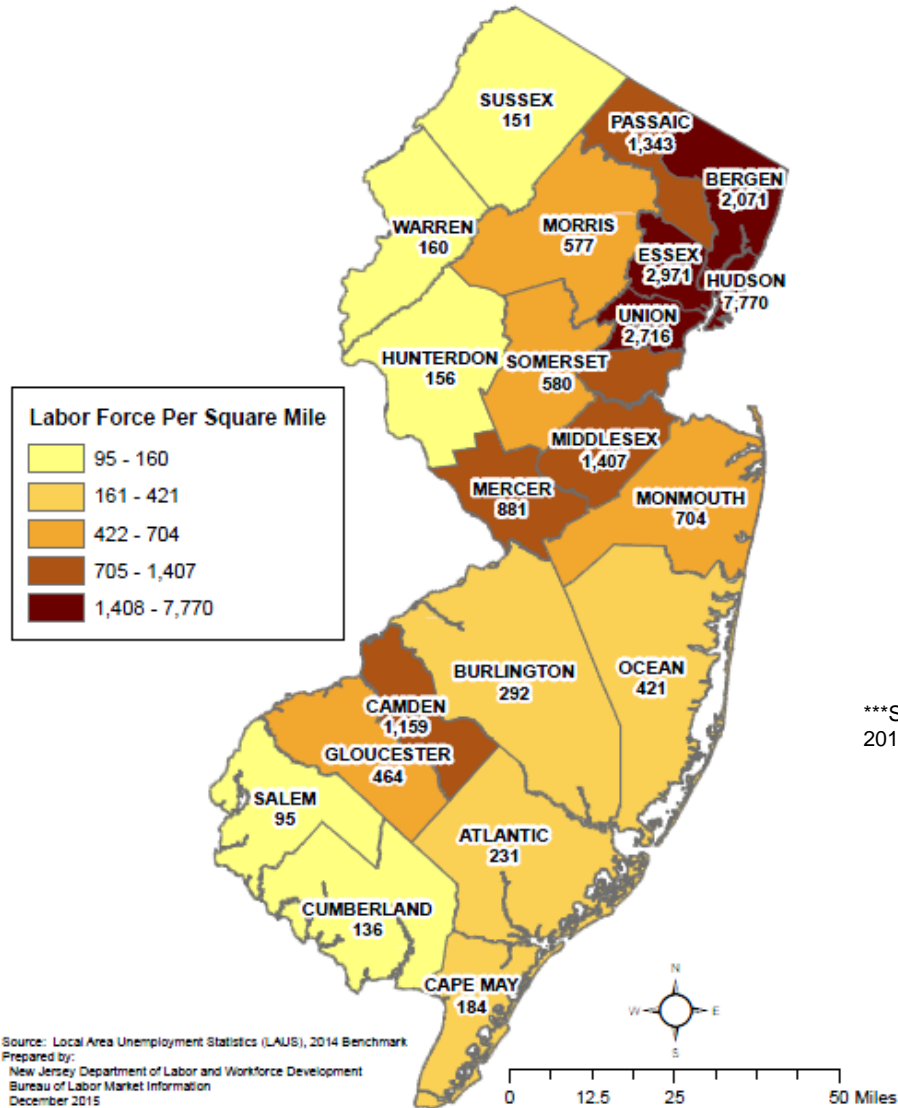
