New Grant Program Announced for Urban Libraries

Grant Program:	Urban Public Libraries Collection Development Grant
Amount Available:	Up to \$600,000
Purpose:	To augment the resources of public libraries serving urban areas with a high concentration of low income families.
Eligible Projects:	Applications may be submitted in any or all of the following priorities: Priority I Reference Collections Priority II Children's Collections Priority III Circulation Adult Collections
Eligible Applicants:	Any public library located in an urban environment serving a population over 10,000 people and able to meet the five characteristics listed in the guidelines.
Priority for Award:	Applicants must achieve a total average score of 65 points or more. Applications above the cut-off score will be funded in rank order, from highest to lowest, to the extent of available funds.
Guidelines and Application Available on:	<u>March 15, 1990</u>
Deadline for Submission:	<u>May 15, 1990</u>
