A UNIQUE SERVICE FOR NEW JERSEY INDUSTRY

Pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order # 57 the Office of Business Advocacy as staff to the Commissioner of Labor & Industry is charged with the responsibility of implementing a program of Permit Coordination on a state and local level. OBA provides assistance in guiding the applicant through the permit maze. OBA's technical staff function as expeditors in resolving the unexpected problems encountered when constructing a project.

The Office of Business Advocacy will designate a Permit Expediter to your project. The Permit Expediter will:

- A. Advise you of what DEP permits are required for your project, upon completing "MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION FORM".
- B. Coordinate contacts with relevant local and state regulatory agencies upon request.
- C. Monitor the progress of your permit application.
- D. Act to ensure processing of most permits within 90 days of application.
- E. Process "Over The Counter" certain permits meeting appropriate criteria.

OVER-THE-COUNTER PERMITS

STREAM ENCROACHMENT (609) - 292 - 4869

DEP now has a one-day processing service for certain minor stream encroachment permits. This "over-the-counter" service is limited to minor projects which do not adversely change the water carrying capacity of the floodway, do not increase erosion or sedimentation in the stream, and do not require substantial channel modification or relocation. RIPARIAN (609) - 292 - 2613

DEP has a one-day processing service for minor Riparian projects. This over-the-counter service applies to water-front construction activity in man-made lagoons and minor maintenance and/or repair or replacement of lawful existing structures. For further information contact Riparian Lands Management, P.O. Box 1889, Trenton, NJ 08625.

SEWER EXTENSIONS (609) 292 - 0700, or (609) - 292 - 4869

DEP has a one-day processing service for "minor" sewer extension projects. Eligible projects must meet certain criteria, such as, length of 1000 linear feet or less, cost of \$25,000 or less, sewage flow per day of 12,000 gallons or less. No projects with pump stations, force mains, syphons, gallorage transfers or holding tanks will be processed over-the-counter. Projects can not be located in areas under sewer ban, administrative orders, or litigation.

Projects must be in-house by 9:30 a.m., and all administrative documents must be in proper order. Pre-application conferences are strongly recommended. Appointments for over-the-counter processing should be arranged through the Office of Business Advocacy (below). For further information contact:

DEP RECAP

(Recent press releases in capsule form)

Dec. 1--SEWER GRANT TO ROXBURY TOWNSHIP--DEP approved a \$214,241 grant to Roxbury Township, Morris County, for preparation of sewerage disposal facility plans. With approval of the U.S. EPA, the grant will be 75 percent federally funded.

Dec. 2--OCEAN DUMPING NOT OPPOSED--DEP Commissioner Daniel J. O'Hern said ocean dumping six miles off Sea Bright of dredged materials from New York's East River will not be opposed by DEP. He said that, although DEP remains alert to dangers of ocean dumping, the proposal by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers would not result in substantial harm to marine life or threaten New Jersey beaches. Protests had arisen that the material, destined for an established dump site, might contain dangerous materials. O'Hern said the material meets new EPA ocean dumping standards.

Dec. 4--HISTORIC PRESERVATION WORKSHOP ANNOUNCED--DEP's Office of Historic Preservation sponsored a regional workshop on preservation of historic sites December 9, at the Bridgeton City Library.

Dec. 6--PUBLIC HEARING ON CHEMICAL WASTE FACILITIES--DEP will hold a public hearing January 12 at 10 a.m. in the State Museum Auditorium, 205 West State Street, Trenton, on its proposed regulations for operation and registration of chemical and hazardous waste facilities. Proposed December 6, in accordance with the Solid Waste Management Act, the regulations would require analyzing chemical or hazardous wastes prior to treatment, storage or disposal; adequate training for disposal personnel, monitoring of underground storage tanks for leakage, establishment of a system to monitor surface and groundwater, with results submitted to DEP, and protection against atmospheric emissions. Dec. 6--SEVEN NEW HISTORIC SITES--DEP has added seven sites to the State Register of Historic Places. They are the Reaction Motors Rocket Test Facility, Franklin Lakes, Bergen County; the Tenafly Railroad Station, Bergen County; the Williams/Harrison House, Roseland, Essex County; the Van Reyper/Bond House, Montclair, Essex County; the Pennsylvania Railroad Bridge, Trenton; the Raritan Cooper Works, Perth Amboy, and Cat Tail Brook Bridge, Hillsborough, Somerset County. DEP Deputy Commissioner Betty Wilson has nominated all for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places.

Dec. 7 --NEW SEA CLAM RULES--DEP adopted regulations for the 1978-1979 sea clam season, opening all approved waters until April 30, 1979. Major changes from last year are establishment of a closed conservation zone from Little Egg Inlet to Great Egg Harbor Inlet, and opening of a sea clam sanctuary at Cold Spring Harbor, also closed to clamming. Harvest limits are 500 bushels per week by each licensed vessel. The total season harvest limit is 250,000 bushels. Fishing will be from sunrise to 4 p.m., Monday through Saturday. Dec. 7--\$1.2 MILLION IN GREEN ACRES MATCHING GRANTS--Governor Brendan Byrne announced three 50 percent Green Acres grants. They are to Hamilton Township, Mercer County, \$1 million for development of Hamilton Park; Franklin Lakes, Bergen County, \$153,400 for acquisition of 22-acre Franklin Lake Park, with partial development, and Vernon Township, Sussex County, \$25,000 to develop the Vernon Recreation Area on Vernon Crossing Road. All will be matched by local funds.

Dec. 7--FIVE SEWERAGE GRANTS--Governor Brendan Byrne announced awards of sewerage grants, made available through Clean Water Bond Act funds administered by DEP. They total \$540,000. They are Ewing-Lawrence Sewerage Authority, Mercer County, \$94,500 for wastewater treatment plant expansion and to study future needs; Hopewell, Mercer County, \$117,112 toward construction of a \$2 million wastewater collection system; Hudson County Sewerage Authority, \$177,100 to prepare plans for secondary treatment of wastewaters from 10 Hudson County municipalities; Neptune Township, Monmouth County, \$139,500 for a Shark River Hills area wastewater collection system, and Rockaway Township, Morris County, \$12,000 to extend sewer service in White Meadow Lake area.

Dec. 11--BALLY OF N.J., INC., MAY DESTROY BLENHEIM ROTUNDA BUT MUST RECONSTRUCT DENNIS HOTEL--DEP has approved a Coastal Area Facility Review Act (CAFRA) permit application by Bally of New Jersey, Inc., to build a 510-room hotel-casino at Park Place and the Boardwalk in Atlantic City. Destruction of the Blenheim Hotel rotunda, deemed structurally unsound was approved. Reconstruction of the historic Dennis Hotel is required.

Dec. 12--DEP APPROVES AIR POLLUTION CONTROL PROJECT--A \$25 million air pollution control project of Atlantic Electric Company for its generating station at Beesley's Point, Cape May County was approved. Two electrostatic precipitators will make it possible for continued burning of coal, rather than oil. A relaxed sulfur-in-coal standard, adopted by DEP in July, makes this possible.

Dec. 14--BERGEN POLLUTION ORDER--Biocraft Laboratories of Waldwick, Bergen County, has been ordered by DEP to end pollution of Allendale Brook, a tributary of the Saddle River. The pharmaceutical manufacturer was first directed to cease discharges of chemical wastes in June, 1976. The company must report on abatement plans within three weeks.

Dec. 15--FEDERAL GRANT FOR NEWARK, JERSEY CITY PARKS--Governor Brendan Byrne announced that \$750,000 in Federal grant money will go toward rehabilitation of parks and recreation facilities in Newark and Jersey City. Newark will receive \$500,000 and Jersey City, \$250,000. Allocation of the money from the Land and Water Conservation Fund was approved by Secretary of the Interior Cecil Andrus. Lafayette Park in Jersey City and Hayes West Park in Newark's Central Ward will be renovated and expanded.
