A UNIQUE SERVICE FOR NEW JERSEY INDUSTRY

Pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order # 57 the Office of Business Advocacy as staff to the Commissioner of Labor & Industry is charged with the responsibility of implementing a program of Permit Coordination on a state and local level. OBA provides assistance in guiding the applicant through the permit maze. OBA's technical staff function as expeditors in resolving the unexpected problems encountered when constructing a project.

The Office of Business Advocacy will designate a Permit Expediter to your project. The Permit Expediter will:

- A. Advise you of what DEP permits are required for your project, upon completing "MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION FORM"
- B. Coordinate contacts with relevant local and state regulatory agencies upon request.
- C. Monitor the progress of your permit application.
- D. Act to ensure processing of most permits within 90 days of application.
- E. Process "Over The Counter" certain permits meeting appropriate criteria.

OVER-THE-COUNTER PERMITS

I. STREAM ENCROACHMENT (609) - 292 - 4869

DEP now has a one-day processing service for certain minor stream encroachment permits. This "over-the-counter" service is limited to minor projects which do not adversely change the water carrying capacity of the floodway, do not increase erosion or sedimentation in the stream, and do not require substantial channel modification or relocation. For further information contact the Bureau of Flood Plain Management, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NJ 08625.

II. WATERFRONT DEVELOPMENT (609) - 292 - 0060

DEP has a one-day processing service for minor waterfront development projects. This over-the-counter service applies to waterfront construction activity in man-made lagoons and minor maintenance and/or repair or replacement of lawful existing structures. For further information contact: Waterfront Development, P.O. Box 1839, Trenton, NJ 08625.

III. SEWER EXTENSIONS (609) - 292 - 3846

DEP has a one-day processing service for "minor" sewer extension projects. Eligible projects must meet certain criteria, such as, length of 1000 linear feet or less, cost of \$25,000 or less, sewage flow per day of 12,000 gallons or less. No projects with pump stations, force mains, siphons, gallorage transfers or holding tanks will be processed over-the-counter. Projects can not be located in areas under sewer ban, administrative orders, or litigation.

Projects must be in-house by 9:30 a.m., and all administrative documents must be in proper order. Pre-application conferences are strongly recommended. For further information contact Division of Water Resources, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NJ 08625.

MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION

DEP has developed a Master Permit Information Application which, upon completion, will indicate all the DEP permits required for the project. Forms may be obtained by contacting the Office of Business Advocacy (See inside cover for details).

STANDARD APPLICATION FORM (CP #1)

Effective July 1, 1979

The Department of Environmental Protection has been implementing a new "standard application form" for permits on construction related projects. The new application form replaces more than twenty different forms previously used, and should enable DEP to provide the public with more efficient and timely service.

The Standard Application Form has been designed, in the spirit of "Executive Order #57," through the efforts of the "Governor's Cabinet Committee on Permit Coordination" to simplify permit application forms and processing procedures. Eventually DEP plans to use one application form and one permit form for all of its Divisions.

In order to assist applicants through the permit maze, DEP began implementing the CP #1 application on July 1 for the Division of Water Resources and the Division of Coastal Resources.

The CP #1 form is available in a booklet which includes for specific permits the following information: legal citations, contact phone numbers, lists of requirements for "complete applications", endorsements, and general background information on permitting.

Applicants will use this one form for the general information of their projects, but some highly technical permits will require technical addenda forms.

Public Hearings (Quasi - Legislative) - are held for the purpose of obtaining input and reaction to a proposed rule, regulation, or new program. Some hearings may be mandated by law. Generally their scope of impact is statewide, or of broad general interest.

Administrative Hearings (Quasi - Judicial) - are held between the state and a particular party involving an application, enforcement - violation or an appeal. Interest in these hearings is generally limited to those directly involved.

DEP RECAP

(Recent press releases in capsule form)

September 10--HEARING ON EXTENDING NAVAL BASE--DEP Commissioner Jerry Fitzgerald English announced a public hearing September 12 in Middletown Township High School regarding proposed expansion of Earle Naval Weapons Station, Colts Neck. Acquisition of 309 acres is proposed, with construction of new piers on Sandy Hook Bay for relocation of oil transport ships, plus building 10 oil storage tanks and required pipelines.

September 10--UPPER RARITAN WATER PLAN HEARING--DEP announced a public hearing September 13 in Bridgewater on a draft water quality management plan for the upper Raritan River basin in parts of Somerset, Morris, Hunterdon and Union counties. With federal and state approval, the plan would set guidelines for sewage treatment and pollution discharge permits.

September 11--LANDFILL OWNER MUST ELIMINATE FLOODING--Burlington Environmental Management Services, owners of Big Hill landfill in Southampton Township, Burlington County, were ordered by DEP to immediately build a remedial water containment and diversion system to stop flooding of adjacent properties.

September 11--CAFRA CONDITIONAL APPROVAL FOR HOUSING PROJECT--A conditional Coastal Area Facility Review Act (CAFRA) permit for construction of 43 single-family residences on 28 wooded acres on Route 631 in Upper Township, Cape May County, was granted by DEP, provided final landscaping and storm drainage plans are approved.

September 12--\$2 MILLION GREEN ACRES APPROVAL FOR LAKEWOOD TOWNSHIP--Governor Brendan Byrne announced approval of a \$2 million Green Acres project for Ocean County development of Rockefeller/Lake Shenandoah Park in Lakewood Township. Commissioner Jerry Fitzgerald English of DEP said the project will be 40-percent funded by the 1974 Green Acres Program, 50 percent by the federal Land and Water Conservation Fund and 10 percent by the county.

September 12--HACKENSACK WATER COMPLEX ON STATE REGISTER--The 19th-century plant of the Hackensack Water Company, Weehawken, Hudson County, has been added to the State Register of Historic Places. Deputy DEP Commissioner Betty Wilson, deputy state historic preservation officer, said the complex is being nominated for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places.

September 12--POLL SHOWS PUBLIC SUPPORT FOR AIR POLLUTION CONTROL--DEP Commissioner Jerry Fitzgerald English cited results of an Eagleton Institute poll which evidenced public support in New Jersey for even stronger air pollution control efforts.

September 13--HEARING OFFICER UPHOLDS OCEAN SEWER LINES--Commissioner English will make the final determination on construction of the Ridgeway and Davenport interceptor regional sewer lines in Ocean County, following upholding of DEP's 1976 conditional approval by a hearing officer. The Public Advocate's office represented environmental groups opposing the alignment.

September 13--MONMOUTH WATER PLAN HEARING SEPTEMBER 17--DEP will hold a public hearing September 17 at 7 p.m. in Freehold on a draft Water Quality Management Plan for Monmouth County.

###

September 14--DEP APPROVES CAFRA PERMIT IN MIDDLESEX COUNTY--Conditional DEP approval for a CAFRA permit for the Old Bridge Municipal Utilities Authority to upgrade treatment facilities at Laurence Harbor, Middlesex County. Approval is conditional on placement of the force main adjacent to Raritan Bay so as to be free of tidal erosion threats.

September 14--POLLUTION FINES LEVIED; TOTAL \$19,500--DEP levied civil administrative penalties totaling \$19,500 for pollution sources in five counties. They are: NL Industries, Inc., Pedricktown, Salem County, \$10,000 for lead contamination in soils and groundwater; Burlington Township, Burlington County, \$5,000 for illegal operation of a sanitary Sewer extension and diversion of flow into the Burlington City collection system; Valley Road Sewerage Company, Hillsborough Township, Somerset County, \$2,000 for polluting Royce Brook with excess intake flows; Aberdeen Township Municipal Utilities Authority, Monmouth County, \$1,250 for polluting Raritan Bay with raw sewage from a ruptured force main; and the J. Josephson Corporation, South Hackensack, Bergen County, \$1,250 for polluting discharges into the Hackensack River; Voorhees Township, Camden County, was ordered to install rapid sand filters for better treatment at its Osage sewage treatment plant, and Greenwich Township, Gloucester County, was ordered to improve operation and maintenance of its sewage treatment facility at Gibbstown.

September 15--CONFERENCE ON FUTURE OF THE SHORE--DEP Commissioner English announced that Governor Byrne will convene a Governor's Conference on the Future of the New Jersey Shore September 19.
