Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Aviation Department

The region's passenger traffic posted a modest 0.1 percent decrease. Our airports handled 10.629 million passengers, or 5,6670 fewer passengers than in March 2016. The domestic sector grew 1.3 percent – up 90,213 passengers - and achieved a record level for the month of March. On the other hand, international traffic posted a 2.7 percent fall – down 95,883 passengers. Airlines increased total seats by 3.9 percent, with domestic seats up 5.3 and international seats up 1.3 percent. Cargo movement continued to perform solidly, registering a 5.9 percent gain. International freight, which accounts for approximately 64 percent of the region's total cargo activity, grew a strong 7.8 percent. Meanwhile, domestic cargo posted a 2.6 percent gain.
