**Minimum Wage Advisory Commission**

Pursuant to P.L. 2005, c. 70, the New Jersey Minimum Wage Advisory Commission ("Commission") is charged with reporting annually to the Governor and the Legislature on its findings regarding the adequacy of the State's minimum wage and its recommendations as to whether the minimum wage should be raised and, if so, to what level.

The Commission has published two previous annual reports, on December 21, 2007 and December 23, 2008. For 2009, the Commission has conferred and unanimously decided that the contents of its two prior reports should stand as written, and do not require further amplification.
