RESIDENTS, ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES
AUGUST 1999

Comparing counts for August 31, 1999 with those on August 31, 1998, the following changes are noted:

RESIDENTS

- " 6% increase from 29,470 to 31,158 for the jurisdictional population;
(state inmates in county facilities, prison and youth complexes);
- " 52% increase from 3,336 to 5,057 for state inmates in county facilities;
- " 1% increase from 21,405 to 21,520 for the prison complex;
- " -3% decrease from 4,729 to 4,581 for the youth facilities.

ADMISSIONS

- " -18% decrease from 1,254 to 1,032 for total admissions.

RELEASES

- " 17% increase from 1,004 to 1,173 for total releases;
- " 2% increase from 603 to 615 for male parole releases;
- " -6% decrease from 68 to 64 for female parole releases;
- " 1% increase from 671 to 679 for total parole releases;
- " 30% increase from 333 to 434 for offenders discharged at max.

NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I-community, SL II-minimum, SL III-medium, SL IV-maximum and SL V-close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.

REPORTING OF JUVENILE RESIDENTS ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES DATA has been discontinued. All juvenile offenders became the responsibility of the Juvenile Justice Commission, Department of Law and Public Safety as of July 1, 1996.

NOTE: Commencing April 1998 County Contract/Assistance and County Waiting figures are merged and reported as State Inmates in County Facilities.
