Atlantic City casino revenue up 7.9 percent in September

The resort's seven remaining casinos saw gambling revenue, including internet gaming, increased by nearly 8 percent in September compared with last year, according to state gambling figures released Thursday.

Overall casino gambling revenue totaled more than \$235.8 million in September, compared with more than \$218.4 million in September 2016, according to the figures.

September capped off a solid first nine months of the years for the industry. For the year-to-date, casino revenue for the remaining casinos totaled \$2 billion through September, compared with \$1.8 billion in the prior period, an increase of more than 9 percent.

"This isn't just luck. Business is building,"said Matthew B. Levinson, chairman and chief executive officer of the Casino Control Commission. "Revenue at one operator was flat, but every other casino and every internet operation was up for the first nine months of this year."

Internet gambling grew by 27.1 percent. Its revenues totaled about \$183.6 million in September compared with more than \$144.5 million a year ago.
