Governor's Council on Substance Use Disorder

February 20, 2024

Call to Order

The three hundred and seventy ninth regular meeting of the Governor's Council on Substance Use Disorder was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by 2nd Vice Chair Gregg Benson.

Open Public Meetings Act Statement

Presentation: Municipal Alliance Grant System (MAGS)

Deputy Director Rebecca Alfaro and Director of Prevention and Planning Sara Thode gave an overview and demonstration of the Municipal Alliance Grant System (MAGS) to the Council

members. County and Municipal staff have participated in training webinars on how to use the grant system and these trainings are available for review online as well. MAGS will be implemented for the FY25 County Plan process.

Executive Director's Report

Executive Director Celina Levy informed the Council that our name was changed to the Governor's Council on Substance Use Disorder (GCSUD). Staff is currently working on items regarding the name change (email, website, etc.) and the Council will be updated accordingly. She thanked the advocates who worked to push forward the legislation to address stigmatizing language as related to substance abuse as well as Governor Murphy for signing it into law.

The Master Plan subcommittee meeting will be scheduled soon and GCSUD staff will be reaching out to Council members regarding input to the document. She took a moment to thank subcommittee members, Gisele Pemberton, Moira Nelson and John Armato for their work on the Master Plan draft.

Ms. Levy thanked the Council members for their input and support, the County Coordinators and Alliances for their good work despite challenges faced and GCSUD staff for their strong work ethic, and to Neil Van Ess for his ongoing leadership.
