RESIDENTS, ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES  
JULY 1997

Comparing counts for July 31, 1997 with those on June 30, 1996, the following changes are noted:

RESIDENTS

0% decrease from 27,403 to 27,375 for the jurisdictional population;  
(county waiting, county contract, county assistance, prison and youth complexes);  
-25% decrease from 4,838 to 3,415 for county waiting;  
-4% decrease from 1,011 to 1007 for county contract & county assistance;  
11% increase from 15,989 to 18,090 for the prison complex;  
-12% decrease from 5,565 to 4,863 for the youth facilities.

ADMISSIONS

2% increase from 1,422 to 1,445 for total admissions.

RELEASES

3% increase from 1,287 to 1,329 for total releases;  
0% (no chg) from 954 to 954 for male parole releases;  
45% increase from 56 to 81 for female parole releases;  
2% increase from 1,010 to 1,035 for total parole releases;  
6% increase from 277 to 294 for offenders discharged at max.

NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I-community, SL II-minimum, SL III-medium, SL IV-maximum and SL V-close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.

REPORTING OF JUVENILE RESIDENTS ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES DATA has been discontinued. All juvenile offenders became the responsibility of the Juvenile Justice Commission, Department of Law and Public Safety as of July 1, 1996.
