

Modeling Impact to NJ Medicaid of Congressional Budget Proposals

February 2025

Background

The Department has modeled the impact of proposals put forward by Congressional leadership. These potential changes to Medicaid have significant potential effect on provider pay, eligibility and benefits.



Covers 1.8 million New Jerseyans:

- Low and moderate-income children and parents
- Other low-income adults
- Aged blind and disabled – including those with serious mental illness and developmental disabilities
- Elderly and disabled who require long-term care

Services covered include:

- Hospital Care
- Physician (Primary Care, Specialty, Dental)
- Prescription Drugs
- Maternal Health (Covers **>30%** of New Jersey births)
- Long-term nursing care, in nursing facilities and community (NJ FamilyCare is primary payer - **not** covered by Medicare)
- Behavioral health, including services for those with **serious mental illness** and **treatment of substance use disorders**
- **Community-based services** for individuals with developmental disabilities

Annual budget: \$24 billion

- Cost shared between state and federal government: approximately \$14 billion federal, \$10 billion state.

1. Reductions in Federal Matching Funds for Medicaid

Today, Medicaid Costs are shared by the Federal and State Governments.

The rate at which the federal government matches state Medicaid funds varies by state, and (for most covered populations) is determined by a formula based on a state's per capita income. By law, the match rate has a ceiling of 83 percent and a floor of 50 percent. New Jersey is one of 10 states which benefits from the statutory 50 percent floor on matching funds for most Medicaid services. In the absence of this floor, the per capita income formula would set a matching rate for New Jersey of around 38 percent.

Some reimbursements categories, such as Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) and the Medicaid expansion population, are matched at a different rate. This leads to a "blended share" which leads to a more accurate picture of federal match.

In New Jersey, the federal government assumes ~60 percent ("blended share") of cost of NJ FamilyCare.

- 90% of cost for low-income adults covered under Affordable Care Act
- 65% of cost for moderate to low-income children under CHIP
- 50% of the cost for most other NJ FamilyCare members

New Jersey Impact: ~~-\$2.2 to -\$5.2 BILLION~~

Scenario 1 – Eliminate the 50% “floor” for Medicaid & CHIP

- New Blended Federal Share: **51%** (90% for ACA Expansion Adults, 56% for CHIP, 38% for Other Medicaid)
- NJ impact in annual loss of federal funds: **~~-\$2.2 billion~~**

Scenario 2 – Eliminate the 90% federal share for ACA Expansion Adults

- New Blended Federal Share: **51%** (50% for ACA Expansion Adults, 66% for CHIP, 50% for Other Medicaid)
- NJ impact in annual loss of federal funds: **~~-\$2.3 billion~~**

Scenario 3 – Eliminate the 50% floor for Medicaid & CHIP *and* the 90% federal share for ACA Expansion Adults

- New Blended Federal Share: **39%** (38% for ACA Expansion Adults, 56% for CHIP, 38% for Other Medicaid)
- NJ impact in annual loss of federal funds: **~~-\$5.2 billion~~**

Scenario 4 – Set “per capita caps” on federal Medicaid funding

- Set numerical dollar limits on federal Medicaid funding
- State bears full risk for unexpected events (e.g. pandemic or recession)
- NJ impact in annual loss of federal funds: **Unknown**

2. Restrictions on Existing Health Care Funding Streams

Provider Taxes:

- Targeted taxes on health care providers and health plans
- **Revenue from these taxes are eligible for federal match and are reinvested in the healthcare system.**
- Current federal rules allow such taxes to total **up to 6%** of provider / health plan revenue.
- **Congressional Option:** Lower 6% cap or forbid such taxes altogether.

Directed Payments:

- Most states require **managed care plans** to make certain add-on payments to health care providers, known as "directed payments."
- Directed payments may incentivize **high quality care**, support **training** of new providers, or support **safety net providers**.
- **Congressional Option:** Restrict or forbid directed payments.

New Jersey Programs at Risk: - \$4.2 BILLION

3. Changes in Medicaid Eligibility Rules

Today NJ FamilyCare eligibility is assessed based on various factors:

- Household size
- Income
- Residency
- Immigration Status
- Age
- Disability Status
- Financial Assets

Eligibility is checked by the State or County at the time of initial application. Eligibility workers reach out to applicants with any follow up questions, or to request additional information.

Eligibility is re-verified every 12 months. Members are legally required to inform NJ FamilyCare of any changes in status in between eligibility verifications

New Jersey Impact: ~700,000 at risk of losing healthcare

Methodology

Topline numbers reflect potential loss of federal share to projected SFY26 Medicaid payments.

Numbers in the Appendix specific to hospitals and healthcare systems represent the projected loss of federal funds paid by Medicaid to each hospital. Actual loss of revenue could be more or less. The numbers reflect projected SFY26 Medicaid FFS and Managed Care ordinary payments for services delivered plus SFY26 directed and supplemental payments as calculated by the agency and its consultants.

The hospital/health system County Option estimate in the Appendix does not include hospitals in Hudson or Union because their plans are still being finalized. In SFY25, interim net payments to hospitals in Hudson County totaled roughly \$65 million and this amount could nearly double due to SFY26 program updates. SFY26 will be Union County's first year participating in the program.
