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This report presents 1970 and 1980 census counts of the number of persons in households and in group quarters, and the average number of persons per household for the state of New Jersey, its 21 counties and 567 municipalities.

The U.S. Bureau of the Census released the 1980 data for New Jersey in the fall of 1981 as a supplement to 1980 census data products. Since that time and as of November 30, 1981 the total populations of the state, Essex County, and several municipalities have been revised. Additionally, the 1970 total, populations of the state, several counties and several municipalities were revised since the tabulations in the 1970s of the other 1970 data items presented in this report. These revisions are incorporated in this report in the "Total Population" columns; however, the data in the other columns have not been revised to reflect these changes.

Although the Census Bureau regards the total population figures as final, the population counts for Essex County and each jurisdiction within the county are not final. "The Census Bureau attests that Essex County tabulations are those which would have been reported and transmitted as final but for the injunction of the court in the case of Shapiro vs. Klutznick." In general, however,

all the 1980 census figures are subject to change, pending the outcome of other lawsuits dealing with the census counts.

#### THE NEW JERSEY STATE DATA CENTER

This publication is a product of the New Jersey State Data Center ( NJSDC ), which is a cooperative project of the State of New Jersey and the U. S. Bureau of the Census. Serving data users in the public, private, and academic sectors, the NJSDC has among its objectives the expansion of access to and use of census statistics, the provision of

technical assistance and analytical support in the use of these statistics, and the provision of user training on timely, census-related topics.

The NJSDC consists of many agencies, thereby extending its services to data users throughout the state. The project coordinator is the Office of Demographic and Economic Analysis in the New Jersey Department of Labor and Industry. Primary participants are the State Library, Rutgers-The State University and Princeton University. These are four major resource centers.

Each agency of state government has a satellite office of the NJSDC which maintains basic census and agency statistics.

To provide local access to and technical assistance in the use of census data, a network of county affiliates has been established. The federal depository libraries of the state also maintain collections of census products.

In addition, regional planning commissions cooperate in the NJSDC project.

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## HOUSEHOLD CONCEPT DEFINITIONS

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**COUNTIES.** In most states, the primary political and administrative divisions are termed counties.

**MUNICIPALITIES.** Minor civil divisions are the primary political and administrative subdivisions of counties. MCDS are most frequently known as townships, but can also include towns, boroughs and cities.

**HOUSEHOLD.** A household includes all persons who occupy a group of rooms or a single room which constitutes a housing unit. A group of rooms or a single room

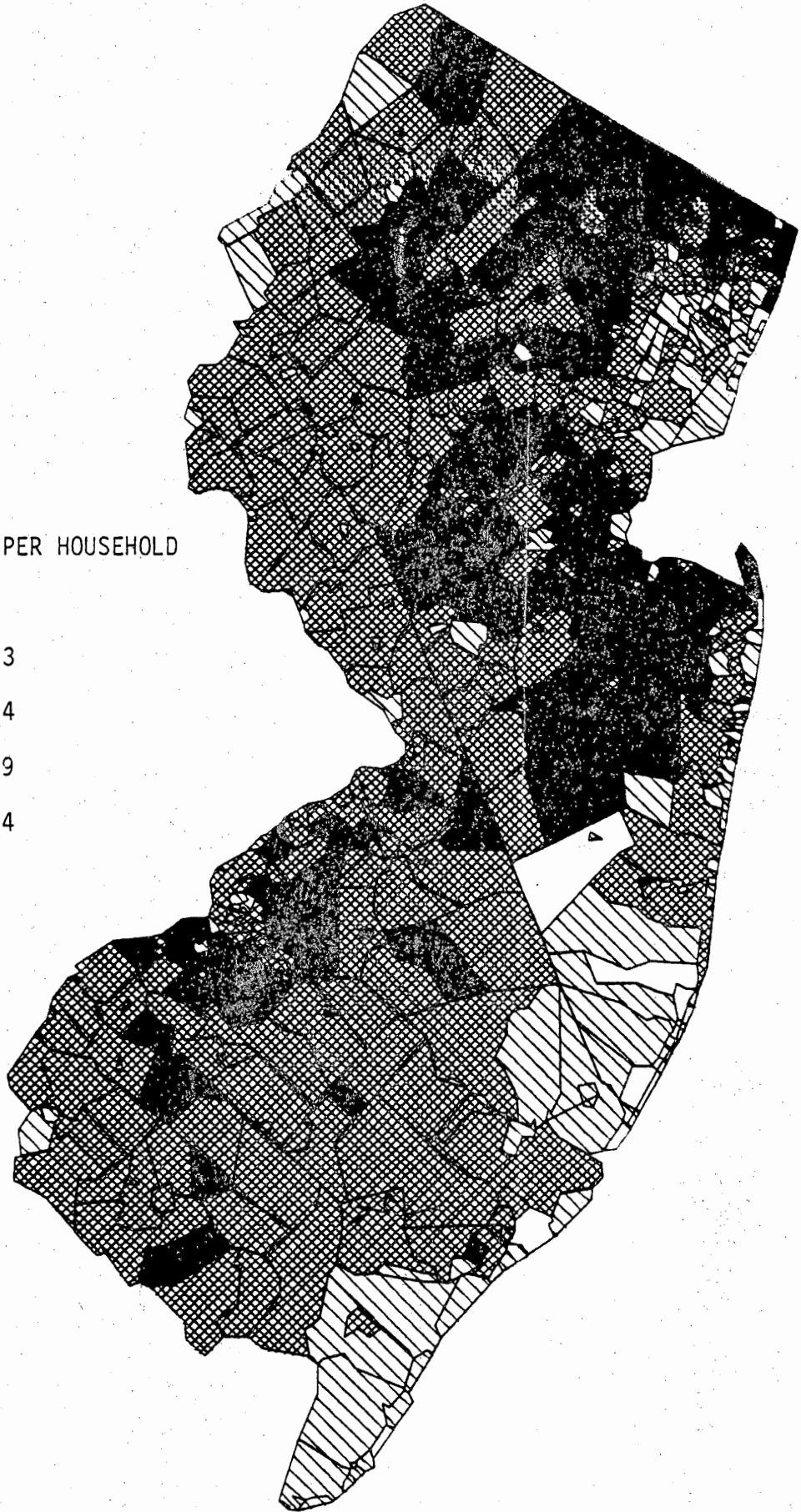
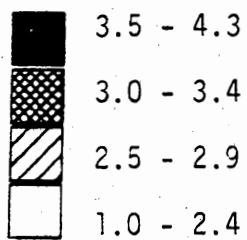
is regarded as a housing unit when it is occupied as separate living quarters, that is, when the occupants live and eat separately from other persons in the building and have direct access from the outside of the building or through a common hall. The measure "Population per Household" is obtained by dividing the number of persons in households by the number of households ( Occupied Housing Units ) .

**GROUP QUARTERS.** All persons not living in households are classified by the Bureau of the Census as living in group

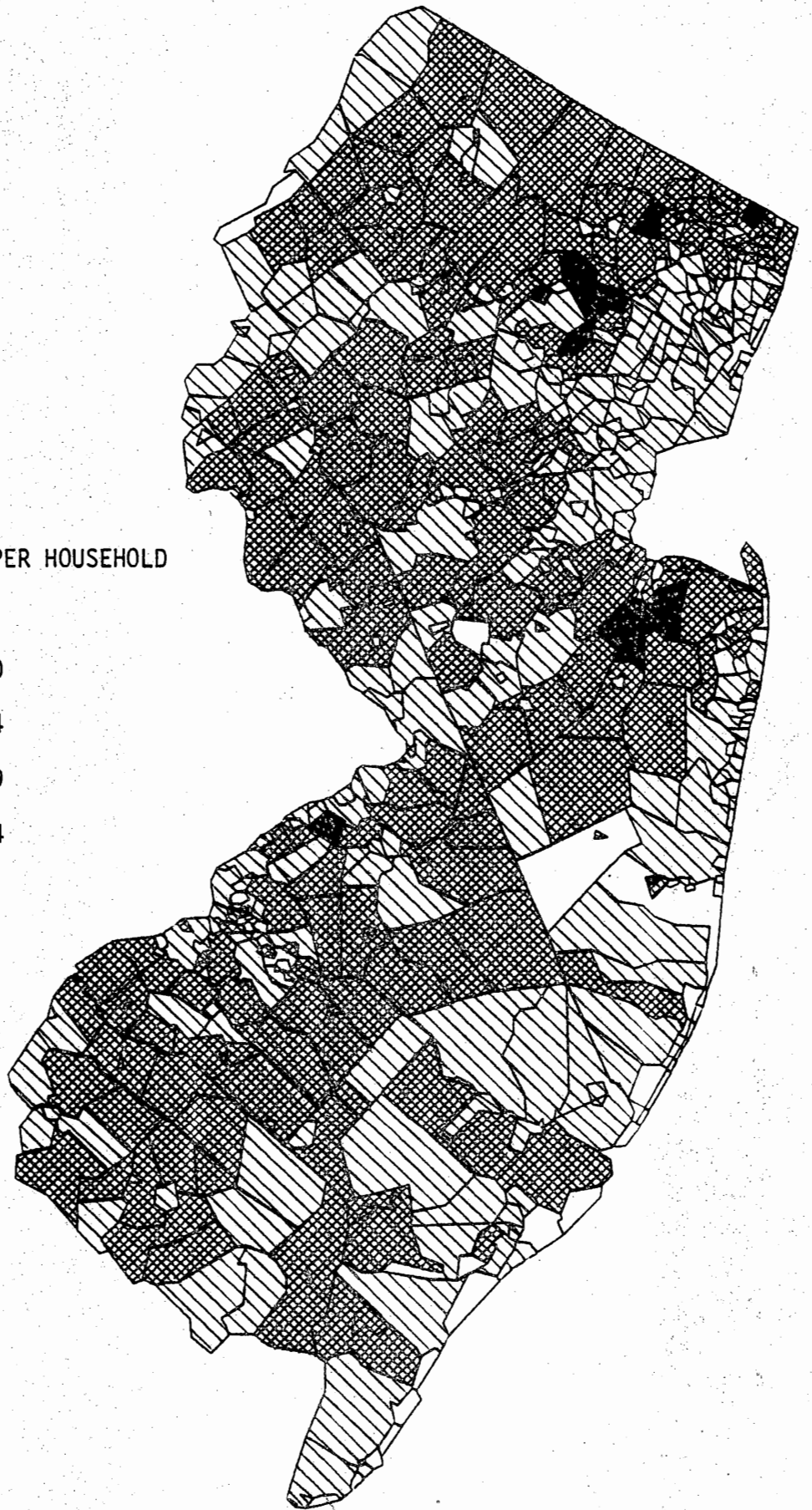
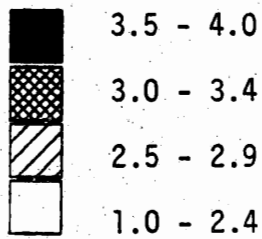
quarters. Persons in group quarters include persons under care or custody in institutions and persons in noninstitutional group quarters such as missions, college dormitories, military barracks, monasteries and dormitories for workers. In addition, noninstitutional group quarters include any living quarters which is occupied by nine or more persons in 1980 and five or more persons in 1970 who are unrelated to the resident who owns or rents ( maintains ) the living quarters ( for example, a large rooming or boarding house, or a large commune ) .
