Gov. Christie Whitman today submitted to the State Senate the nomination of Superior Court Judge **Virginia M. Long**, of Pennington, for Associate Justice of the Supreme Court.

Judge Long was named to the Superior Court in 1978 and re-nominated in 1985. She was named to the Appellate Division in 1984 and became a presiding judge in 1995. She served as Commissioner of the Department of Banking in 1977 and Director of the Division of Consumer Affairs in 1975. She was in private practice with Pitney, Hardin & Kipp in the firm's litigation department.
