The foregoing 189 cases involved 234 separate violations, as set forth below, comparing with a total of 219 cases involving 281 separate violations for the fiscal year 1938-39. Of the total number, 55 were Fair Trade cases in municipalities scattered throughout the State; 67 involved other charges against Newark licensees; and the balance involved licensees of various other municipalities throughout the State, the proceedings being conducted at the Department because the complaint had been made by a coordinate law enforcement agency (e.g., the Federal Alcohol Tax Unit), or the license had been issued directly by the Commissioner because a member of the municipal issuing authority was interested therein, or because of Departmental policy to conduct all cases of a particular class, e.g., (fraud and front cases) at the Department. Penalties preceded by an asterisk were imposed in cases where one or more additional charges were involved, and no separate penalty was imposed on the separate charges.
