As Staff to Commissioner John J. Horn of the Department of Labor and Industry, the Office of Business Advocacy provides personalized assistance in resolving problems encountered when doing business in New Jersey. OBA's technical personnel function as industry ombudsmen in all areas of governmental activity.

The Office of Business Advocacy's objective is to cut red tape and get solutions to permit problems. OBA will designate a Permit Expediter to your project. The Permit Expediter will:

- A. Advise you of the state permits required for your project, upon completing "MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION FORM"
- B. Coordinate contacts with relevant local and state regulatory agencies upon request.
- C. Monitor the progress of your permit applications.
- D. Act to ensure processing of most permits within 90 days of application.
- E. Schedule "OVER THE COUNTER" processing for permits meeting appropriate criteria.

OVER-THE-COUNTER PERMITS

STREAM ENCROACHMENT (609) - 292 - 4869

DEP now has a one-day processing service for certain minor stream encroachment permits. This "over-the-counter" service is limited to minor projects which do not adversely enange the water carrying capacity of the floodway, do not increase erosion or sedimentation in the stream, and do not require substantial channel modification or relocation. For further information contact the Bureau of Flood Plain Management, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NJ 08625.

MATERFRONT DEVELOPMENT (609) - 292 - 0060

DEP has a one-day processing service for minor waterfront development projects. This over-the-counter service applies to waterfront construction activity in man-made lagoons and minor maintenance and/or repair or replacement of lawful existing structures. For further information contact: Waterfront Development, P.O. Box 1889, Trenton, NJ 08625.

III. SEWER EXTENSIONS (609) - 292 - 3846

DEP has a one-day processing service for "minor" sewer extension projects. Eligible projects must meet certain criteria, such as, length of 1000 linear feet or less, cost of \$25,000 or less, sewage flow per day of 12,000 gallons or less. No projects with pump stations, force mains, siphons, gallonage transfers or holding tanks will be processed over-the-counter. Projects can not be located in areas under sewer ban, administrative orders, or litigation.

Projects must be in-house by 9:30 a.m., and all administrative documents must be in proper order. Pre-application conferences are strongly recommended. For further information contact Division of Water Resources, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NI 08625.

DEP has developed a Master Permit Information Application which, upon completion, will indicate all the DEP permits required for the project. Forms may be obtained by contacting the Office of Business Advocacy (See inside cover for details).

DEP Events of Public Interest include: public hearings, council meetings, workshops, public information meetings, and exams.

Public Hearings (Quasi - Legislative) - are held for the purpose of obtaining input and reaction to a proposed rule, regulation, or new program. Some hearings may be mandated by law. Generally their scope of impact is statewide, or of broad general interest.

Administrative Hearings (Quasi - Judicial) - are held between the state and a particular party involving an application, enforcement - violation or an appeal.

Interest in these hearings is generally limited to those directly involved.

DEP RECAP

(Recent press releases in capsule form)

June -- DEP CERTIFIES SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLANS -- DEP certified the following solid waste management plans during June:

June 9: Hunterdon County & Morris County June 11: Bergen County & Cumberland County

June 13: Cape May County

Certification of these plans included certain mandated modifications. These modifications must be achieved by Bergen County by July 1, 1980 and by Hunterdon and Cumberland Counties by December 31, 1980. As part of its required modification, Hunterdon County must enter into interdistrict agreements with Morris and Warren Counties regarding various specific solid waste management activities.

June 10 -- PUBLIC HEARINGS THIS WEEK -- During the week of June 8, DEP's Division of Coastal Resources and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, Office of Coastal Zone Management, held public hearings in Trenton, Jersey City, Camden and Toms River on the Proposed New Jersey Coastal Management Program & Draft Environmental Impact Statement. The program, which would coordinate DEP management action in a coastal zone along the Atlantic Ocean plus a narrow land strip along the Hudson and Delaware rivers and their tidal tributaries, could (if federally approved) mean \$1.5 million annually in DEP coastal management funds, of which at least \$150,000 would pass to municipalities for local coastal projects.

June 12 -- FEES FOR WASTE REGISTRATION & INSPECTION RAISED -- Commissioner English announced the adoption of regulatory amendments to Chapter 26 of Title 7, New Jersey Administrative Code. These amendments will increase the registration and inspection fees charged to collectors and haulers of solid and hazardous waste. These fee increases are essential to meet the rising costs of the registration process.

June 12 -- PUBLIC MEETING ON NUCLEAR COOLING TOWERS HELD -- Commissioner English announced that DEP would hold its second public meeting to discuss Public Service Gas & Electric Company's permit application to construct two salt water cooling towers at the site of the Hope Creek Nuclear Generating Station, Units I and II, Salem County.

June 17 -- REGULATIONS BEING READIED FOR POLLUTANT DISCHARGES -- In a further effort to regulate and control toxic and hazardous material discharges, Commissioner English said, DEP has begun the adoption process for a New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NJPDES), to help implement the State Water Pollution Control Act of 1977. Public meetings on the regulations were set for June 24 at Rutgers Law School, Camden, and Cook College, New Brunswick, June 26.

May 28--COMMENT PERIOD EXTENDED--The Division of Water Resources of the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) announced extension of the deadline for submitting comments on the DEP proposed Water Quality Standards, from May 29 to June 13.

May 29--AQUATIC VEGETATION SURVEY--Commissioner Jerry Fitzgerald English of DEP announced completion of "The New Jersey Submerged Aquatic Vegetation Distribution Atlas," the first such comprehensive inventory of this coastal resource. May 29--PESTICIDE LAB GROUNDBREAKING--Ground was to be broken May 30 for the new DEP Pesticides and Toxic Substances Complex at the Sierra Office Park, 380 Scotch Road, West Trenton.

May 29--HUDSON WATERFRONT COMMISSION TO MEET--The Governor's Hudson River Water-fromt Study, Planning and Development Commission will hold a full public meeting June 19 at 10 a.m., in the 4th floor seminar room at Stevens Institute, Hoboken. Members will vote on recommendations they will send to Governor Byrne. Information is available from John Weingart at (609) 292-0762.

May 29--WILSON TESTIFIES--Deputy DEP Commissioner Betty Wilson testified on DEP's perspective on the Pinelands Commission's planning program, and implementation of the proposed plan, before the combined Assembly Energy and Natural Resources and Agriculture and Environment Committees.

June 2--ILLEGAL DISCHARGE PENALTY--DEP's Division of Water Resources levied a civil penalty of \$1,562 against Monitor Devices, Inc., a metal plating facility in Wall Township, Monmouth County, for discharging untreated metal plating wastewater in the state's groundwaters.

June 3--OCEAN COUNTY CAFRA PERMIT--DEP has conditionally approved a Coastal Area Facility Review Act (CAFRA) permit for the Lionshead South retirement Community of 660 single-family homes proposed for Brick Township by the Lionshead Corporation. Plans must be revised to eliminate any adverse impact on the white cedars and bog area of the site before the permit can be issued, according to David N. Kinsey, Director of the Division of Coastal Resources.

June 17 -- MEETING TO EVALUATE COASTAL PROGRAM -- The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's Office of Coastal Zone Management (NOAA-OCZM) was to hold a public meeting June 18 in Trenton on the State's management of its coastal management program.

June 19 -- NEW DATE FOR HUDSON WATERFRONT MEETING -- The Governor's Hudson River Waterfront Study, Planning and Development Commission will meet July 2 at 10 a.m. at Stevens Institute, Hoboken. The meeting was first set for June 19.

June 19 -- "CLEAN AIR RUN" JULY 4 IN PINELANDS --Commissioner English announced that DEP has endorsed the 10,000-meter (6.2 mile) "Clean Air Run" sponsored by the Pineland Striders Club of Medford, as one of the events marking DEP's 10th Anniversary. The run will begin at 10:30 a.m. at Shawnee High School, Tabernacle Road, Medford. All runners must pre-register by Friday, June 27.

June 19 -- COURT DECISION MARKS DEP STEP AGAINST WASTE ABUSES -- Commissioner English lauded the State Supreme Court's decision to cease all hazardous waste disposal operations at three state corporations, stating, "This is only the beginning of our war against the mishandling of hazardous wastes." Companies involved are Scientific Chemical Processing, Inc.; Presto Inc. and Engerall, Inc. All have facilities in Newark and Carlstadt.

'June 20 -- DEP SEEKS SEPTIC DISPOSAL REGULATIONS -- Commissioner English said DEP is acting to regulate statewide disposal of septic tank wastes while also phasing out their disposal in landfills all over the state. Regulations signed by the Commissioner establish a Statewide Septage Management Plan (SWSMP) requiring sewage treatment agencies to accept septage wastes collected from homes and other waste generators in their own service areas.

June 4--CAFRA APPROVAL IN CAPE MAY--DEP has conditionally approved a CAFRA permit for the proposed Cape May Greene residential development on a 47.8-acre site bounded by Texas, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania and Indiana Avenues in Cape May City. Cape May Greene, Inc., plans a total of 244 units. Because of past inadequate wastewater treatment, the City of Cape May Municipal Sewerage Treatment Plant has been under a DEP sewer connection allocation limiting new hookups. Construction must be limited to those units which can be included with the sewerage allocation limit.

June 4--ABSECON CAFRA APPROVAL--A CAFRA permit was approved for the 45-unit subdivision proposed by Canuso Corporation on 33.3 acres on Fourth Avenue and Hay Road in Absecon, Atlantic County.

June 5--DEP "CIRCUIT" MEETING AT STOCKTON STATE COLLEGE--Commissioner English announced that DEP's second "Circuit Meeting" will be June 10 at Stockton State College, Pomona. Interested persons may submit written comments on the state certification and administrative record to the Assistant Director, Water Quality Management at the above address cited. A copy of the comments should be sent to the Chief, Permits Administration Branch, Region II, U.S.E.P.A., 26 Federal Plaza, New York, New York 10007. All comments shall be submitted within 30 days of the date, of this public notice.

In lieu of, or in addition to, the submission of comments as above provided, any interested person may request that the Commissioner of NJDEP hold a hearing regarding the certification of the proposed discharge. Such request shall indicate the proposed issues to be considered at the hearing.

Any request for a public hearing regarding NJDEP's certification of the proposed discharge should be in writing and submitted to the Assistant Director, Water Quality Management, at the above address with a copy of the request to the Chief, Permits Administration Branch, EPA, Region II. Such request shall be submitted within 30-days of the date of this public hearing.

If NJDEP orders that a public hearing be held regarding its certification, and the Enforcement Division Director of EPA, Region II, has also decided to hold an informal public hearing, the hearings will be held jointly by NJDEP and EPA. If the Enforcement Division Director of EPA, Region II, has decided not to hold an informal public hearing, NJDEP may itself hold a public hearing regarding its certification.

If NJDEP does not hold an informal public hearing or reopen the comment period, NJDEP will consider the issuance of the certification to be final within 30 days of the date of this public notice. All comments timely submitted by interested persons in response to this notice, and statements and other evidence properly submitted at any public hearing held by NJDEP will be considered with respect to this certification for a permit.

NJDEP's decision on the issue of whether to hold any hearing, the administration of any hearing and the rights and obligations of participants are governed by NPDES regulations (40 CFR 124) and the "Administrative Procedures Act" N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 et seq.
