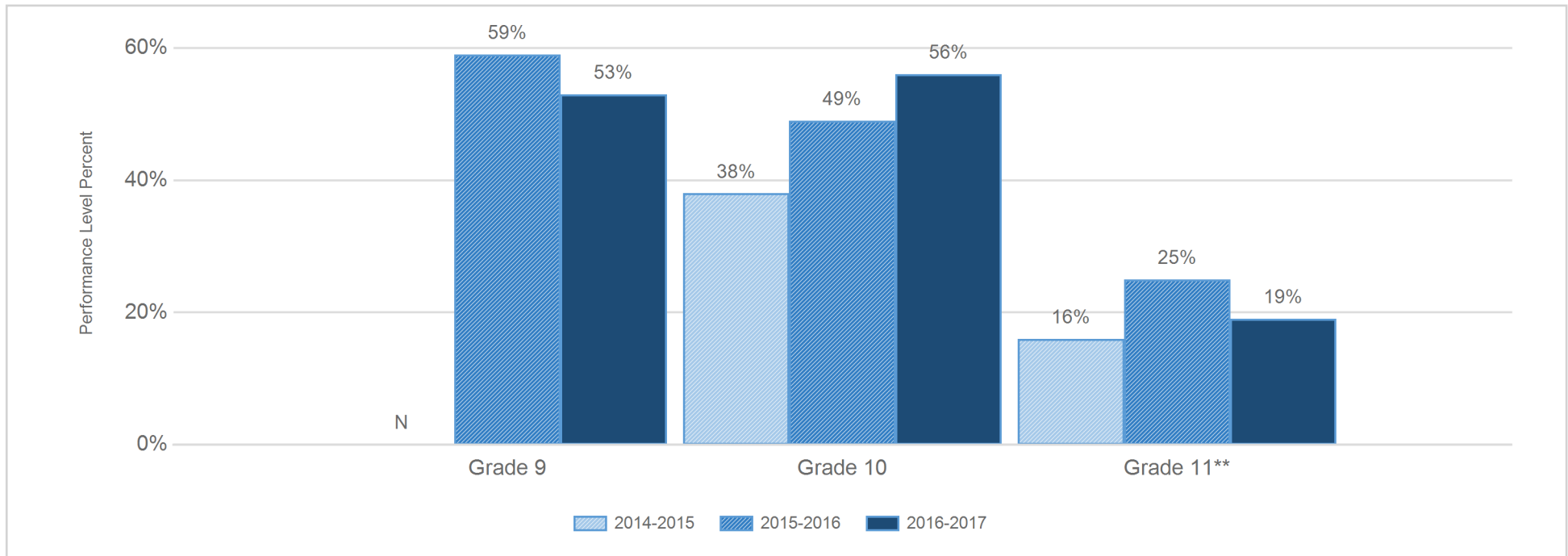

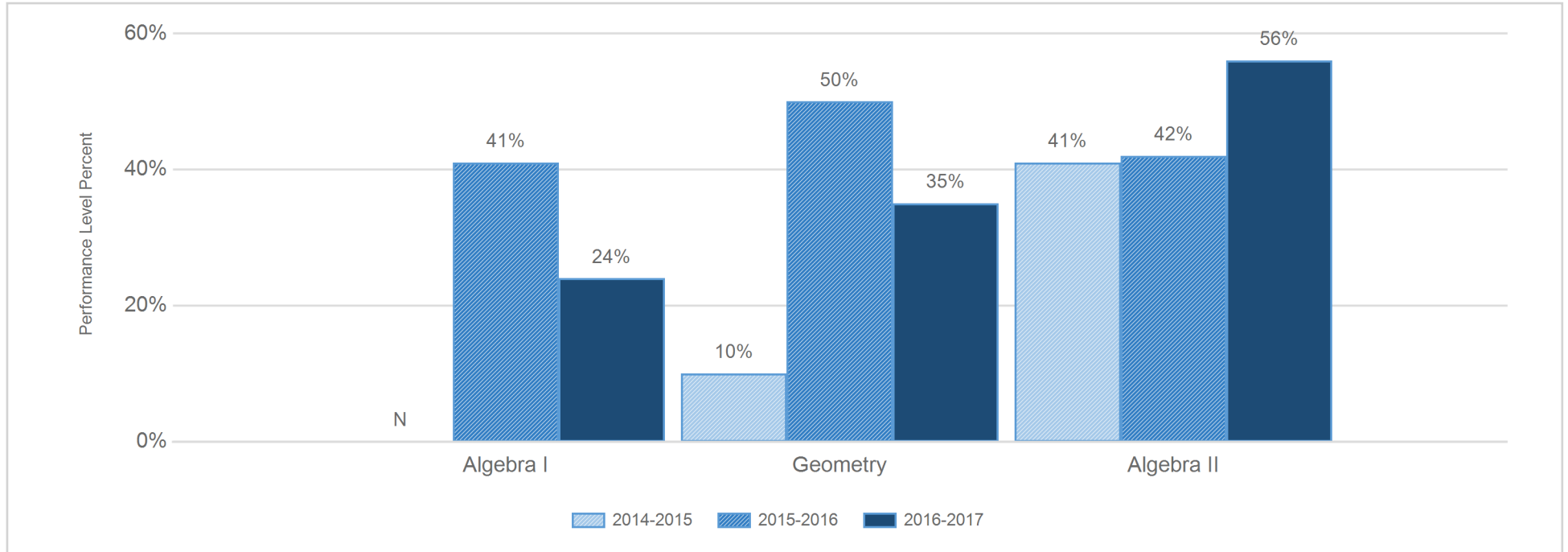

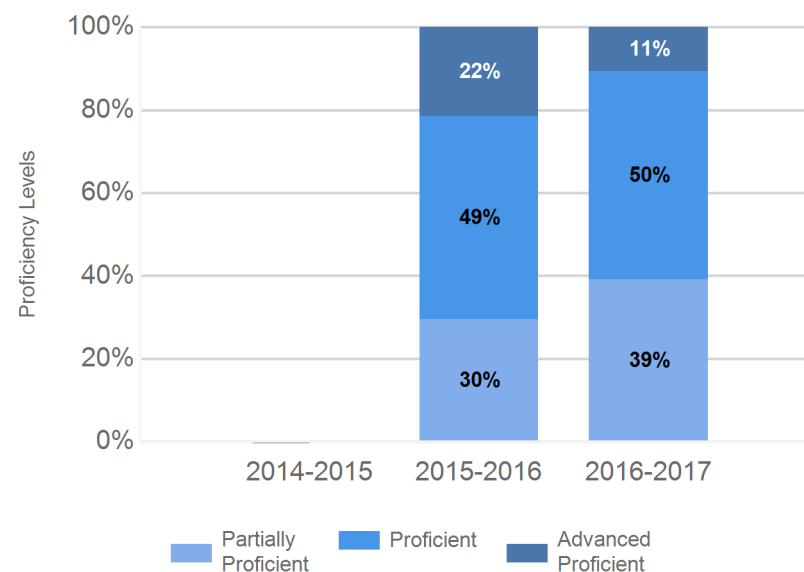

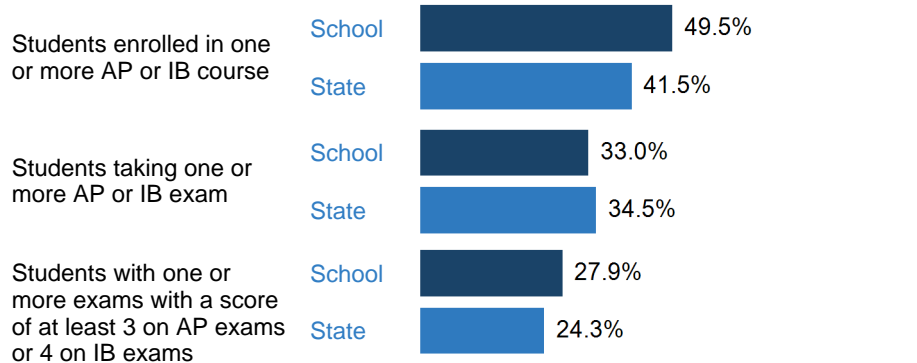

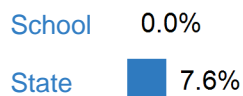

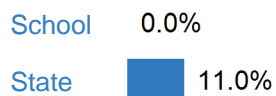

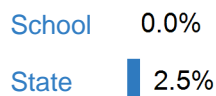

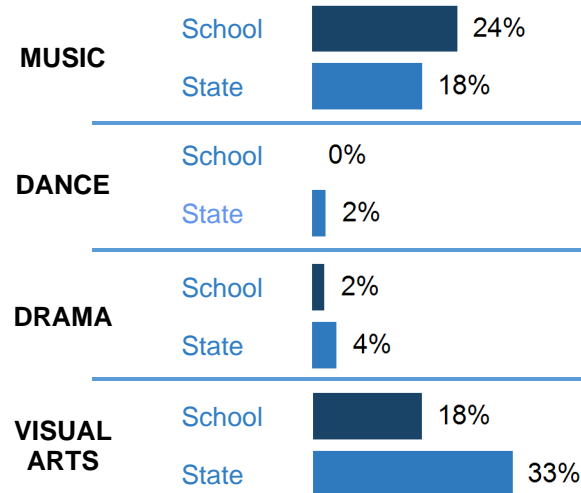

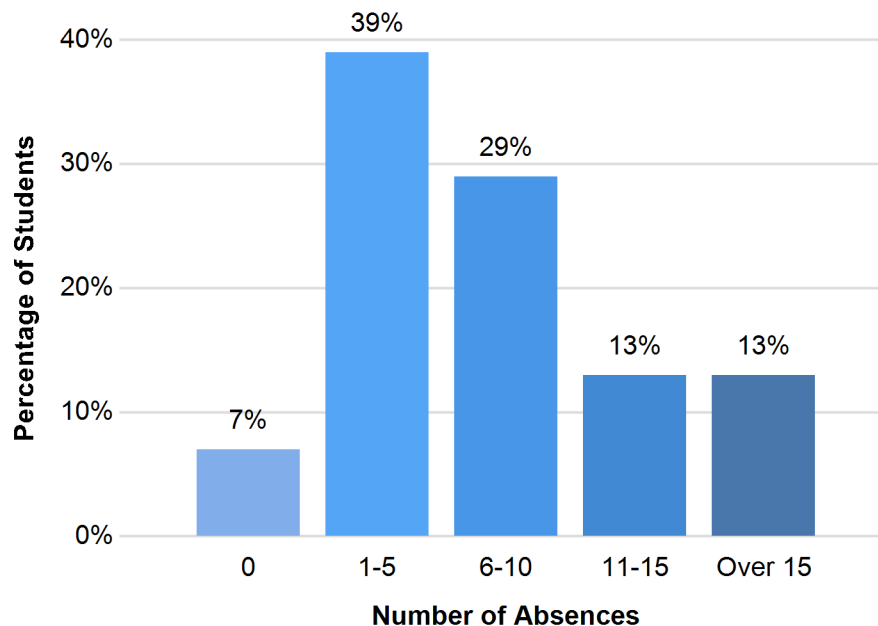

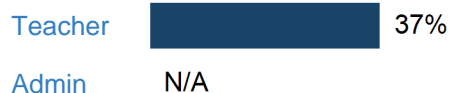

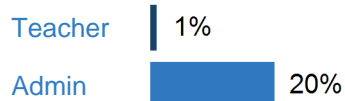
Bachelor's Degree
