Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Regional passenger traffic rose 4.5 percent in October on a 5.0 percent capacity gain. Domestic traffic gained 3.6 percent on a 3.5 percent seat increase. International markets grew 6.3 percent on an 8.7 percent seat increase. There are finally some signs that the domestic capacity restraint that has been observed for the past two-plus years with uncommon discipline is starting to moderate. Regional freight increased 15.7 percent. Domestic freight rose 4.3 percent, while international traffic grew 23.3 percent.
