NEW JERSEY POPULATION TRENDS 1790 TO 1970

Growth and change have characterized the development of the United States since its birth in 1776. At the time of the first Census in 1790, the nation's 3.9 million people were settled near the Atlantic Coast, with 4.7 percent in New Jersey and about 5 percent west of the Appalachians. Its 4.5 people per square mile approximated the density of present-day Montana. By 1970, the United States had over 203 million people spread across 50 states and the District of Columbia. There were now on average 58 people per square mile, with New Jersey leading all states at 957.

National Overview

Although national increases varied greatly during the past two hundred years, they did follow certain patterns. For each of the six decades from 1790 to 1850, growth rates exceeded 32 percent. Then heavy losses from the Civil War, reduced immigration during war years, and underenumeration in the 1870 Census cut the 1860-1870 growth rate to 22.6 percent. Increases never again reached pre-war proportions.

By the 1920's growth was slowed by a declining birth rate and by limits placed on immigration. In the 1930's the effects of depression which contributed to low birth rates and negligible immigration dipped the rate of change to 7.3 percent, its lowest figure.

Beginning with the post-war "baby boom" and continuing through the Fifties, increases in the birth rate and immigration resulted in an up-swing. The 1950-1960 rate of 18.5 percent translated into an increase of 27.8 million people, which was greater than the total 1850 population. With the birth rate once again declining in the Sixties, national growth slowed somewhat to 13.3 percent or an added 24 million Americans by 1970.

Regional Patterns

In 1790, population was nearly equally divided between the Northeast and South. After almost 200 years, only about half the population now lives in the Northeast and South, as America has spread out "from sea to shining sea." Interestingly, the most densely populated states in 1970 were seaboard states of colonial origin: New Jersey, Rhode Island, Massachusetts, and Connecticut.

Regional distribution in 1970 showed: 31 percent of the population in the South; 28 percent in the North Central; 24 percent in the Northeast; and 17 percent in the West. However, these distributions do not identify specific areas of rapid growth such as California, Florida, Alaska and the Mountain States. For example, Nevada's 71.3 percent increase from 1960 to 1970 led the nation.

New Jersey Trends

Despite the soaring growth of newer states, New Jersey wrested the title of "Most Densely Populated State" from Rhode Island in 1970 with 957 people per square mile. Its high density as well as its patterns of growth and population distribution are heavily influenced by its geographical position. This strategic location between New York and Philadelphia accelerated New Jersey's early entry into industrialization and urbanization.

During the 1800's the total state population mushroomed from 211 thousand to 1.9 million. However, early in the century, population growth was slow but steady in predominantly agricultural New Jersey. Agricultural and dairy areas continued slow increases throughout the 1800's. For example, Hunterdon, Sussex, and Gloucester were the only counties which failed to double their population from 1800 to 1900. Their growth rates were almost nine times less than those registered by the rest of New Jersey's counties.

In some areas of the state industrialization began early. In the 1830's, Hoboken utilized the first steam ferries and floating dry docks, Newark manufactured patent leather, and Paterson produced Colt revolvers. Also, the Camden-Amboy rail system was operational. By the 1850's metropolitan job centers swelled the populations of Hudson, Camden, Passaic, and Essex Counties. Largely because of industrialization, New Jersey maintained a high growth rate throughout the 1850's and the ensuing Civil War period. Essential war-related industries such as the manufacture of munitions helped support New Jersey's 1860-1870 population increase of 34.8 percent, highest growth rate for the Northeast.

From 1900 to 1970, the state's population rose substantially from 1.9 million to 7.2 million, which by 1970 ranked New Jersey eighth among all states in total population. During the Twentieth Century, population growth and distribution in New Jersey and in the nation were greatly affected by the status of the economy, war, and immigration. Even though as the century progressed, there was a slow decrease in city totals, industrial counties in New Jersey as well as in the rest of the Northeast continued to hold the greatest numbers of people.

Large percentage gains occurred in the two decades from 1900 to 1920. Massive immigration helped to swell New Jersey's population, especially in or near industrial areas. Access improvements such as the linkage of Jersey City to New York by the first Hudson River tunnel in 1908 spurred further growth. Bergen, with its proximity to growing job centers, had the state's fastest rate of increase from 1900 to 1920. During the Twenties, New Jersey led the Northeast with a gain of 28.1 percent. Top-ranked in density were its industrial counties of Hudson, Union and Essex.

With the Thirties and the Depression came a shift in population trends. New Jersey experienced great outmigration and the smallest increase in growth in its entire history, only 2.9 percent. Also, with the Depression, there began a movement out of some urban areas. For example, Hudson County decreased steadily after 1930, while only three of its municipalities showed gains from 1930 to 1970. Likewise, the cities of Camden, Newark, Jersey City, and Hoboken recorded losses after 1930.

Nationally, higher growth rates in the 1940's and into the Fifties were largely the result of the post-war "baby boom" and increased immigration from abroad. Additionally in New Jersey, heavy in-migration from other states pushed New Jersey's 1950-1960 rate to 25.5 percent and its 1960-1970 rate to 18.2%; the increase of 1.2 million during the Sixties was the highest numerical gain by the state in any decade. Once again, much of the in-migration flow was directed into areas surrounding the major job centers of New York and Philadelphia. Between 1950-1960, numerical gains of over 10,000 were recorded by Paramus (Bergen), Fort Lee (Bergen), New Milford (Bergen), Wayne Township (Passaic), Cherry Hill (Camden), Willingboro (Burlington). New Milford and Cherry Hill more than doubled in population from 1950 to 1960, while Willingboro was a little town of less than 900 in 1950 which rose to over 43,000 in 1970. Largely because of in-migration from neighboring states to New Jersey's suburbs, the state grew at a rate 7 percentage points faster than the nation during the Fifties and 5 percentage points faster during the Sixties.

Improved access, greater automobile ownership, availability of moderately-priced land, and the amenities of life also attracted numbers of people to the state's nonmetropolitan counties. Ocean County's rapid growth reflected all of these factors including the opening of the Garden State Parkway in 1955. In county density rank, Ocean rose four slots from the Fifties to the Seventies. This represents an increase of 51,000 from 1950 to 1960 and of 100,000 from 1960 to 1970. While Ocean was by far the leader, other nonmetropolitan counties such as Monmouth and Sussex also experienced large gains.

Census figures for 1970 set New Jersey's population at 7.2 million with most of its people still concentrated in the "corridor" between New York and Philadelphia. Ranking one through six in density were the counties of Hudson, Essex, Union, Bergen, Passaic, and Camden. Hudson had a density of over 13,000; its municipality of West New York had over 45,000 people per square mile. Conversely, most thinly-populated areas tended to be farthest from the "corridor": Sussex, Warren, Hunterdon, Cumberland, and Cape May Counties. Each recorded a density of less than 250.

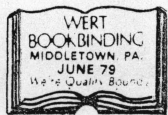
New Jersey in 1970 hardly resembled its 1790 profile. Developing from small and predominately rural settlements into the most densely populated state, New Jersey experienced the growth of sprawling metropolitan areas, including significant outward expansion along the path of the "corridor" and rapid development of resort counties such as Ocean. In the future, a new economic factor, the effects of legalized casino gambling in Atlantic City, will further influence coastal growth. Whether past or future, New Jersey's population trends continue to be affected by the uniqueness of its location, a major determinant of its growth.
