



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


Enrollment by Ethnic/Racial Subgroup




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Proficiency Trends - Math



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



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
NJASK Proficiency Trends - Math - Grade Level - 03






Chronic Absenteeism Trend






Enrollment by Grade




Enrollment by Ethnic/Racial Subgroup






















Chronic Absenteeism Trend
