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## Christie Administration Announces Over \$4 Million in FEMA Grants to Piscataway and Brigantine for Sandy-Related Debris Removal Costs

**Trenton, NJ** – The Christie Administration announced today that the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has awarded over \$4 million in federal grants to the towns of Piscataway and Brigantine for the use of force account personnel and equipment and contractors for the loading and hauling of debris as a result of Superstorm Sandy.

The recipient local governments, total project costs and FEMA grant totals are as follows:

**TOWNSHIP OF PISCATAWAY (Middlesex).** The total project cost is \$2.4 million. FEMA's share of the cost is \$1.8 million.

**BRIGANTINE (Atlantic).** The total project cost is \$2.1 million. FEMA's share of the cost is \$1.6 million.

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
