LEGAL BASIS FOR PUBLIC LIBRARY SERVICE IN NEW JERSEY

ASSOCIATION LIBRARY: One established, governed and supported by an association of citizens. Such an association is incorporated, forms its own constitution, appoints or elects its own board and is responsible for operation of the library. It may receive tax support from the local governing body. There are 151 association libraries. Only those association libraries whose services are free to the use of the public are included in this publication.

COUNTY LIBRARY: One established by law following a county-wide referendum passed by a majority of voters. It is supported by taxes and governed by a board known as the county library commission composed of 5 members appointed by the Freeholders. There are 13 county libraries.

FEDERATION: Any number of independently established libraries voluntarily united to develop cooperative free public library services. Each member library retains complete institutional independence but enters into contracts or service agreements with other members to achieve the joint services agreed upon by the governing bodies of the respective libraries. There is one federation of libraries.

JOINT LIBRARY: One established by law following a referendum in two or more municipalities in which the majority of voters vote to establish such a library. It is governed by a board appointed by the mayors of the participating municipalities. There are two joint libraries.

MUNICIPAL LIBRARY: One established by law following a referendum in which the majority of voters vote to establish such a library. It is supported by taxes and is governed by a 7 member board appointed by the mayor which must include the mayor and superintendent of schools. There are 176 municipal libraries.

REGIONAL LIBRARY: One established by law following resolution adopted by the boards of chosen freeholders of 2 or more counties. It is governed by a board of trustees appointed by the boards of freeholders of the participating counties. There are no regional libraries to date.
