Comparing counts for May 31, 1999 with those on May 31, 1998, the following changes are noted:

RESIDENTS

9% increase from 28,728 to 31,213 for the jurisdictional population;
(state inmates in county facilities, prison and youth complexes);
45% increase from 3,151 to 4,577 for state inmates in county facilities;
6% increase from 20,774 to 21,923 for the prison complex;
-2% decrease from 4,803 to 4,713 for the youth facilities.

ADMISSIONS

-23% decrease from 1,436 to 1,110 for total admissions.

RELEASES

0% decrease from 1,152 to 1,148 for total releases;
-21% decrease from 741 to 583 for male parole releases;
-18% decrease from 78 to 64 for female parole releases;
-21% decrease from 819 to 647 for total parole releases;
27% increase from 333 to 423 for offenders discharged at max.

NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I-community, SL II-minimum, SL III-medium, SL IV-maximum and SL V-close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.

REPORTING OF JUVENILE RESIDENTS ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES DATA has been discontinued. All juvenile offenders became the responsibility of the Juvenile Justice Commission, Department of Law and Public Safety as of July 1, 1996.

NOTE: Commencing April 1998 County Contract/Assistance and County Waiting figures are merged and reported as State Inmates in County Facilities.
