**RESIDENTS, ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES
JULY 1995**

Comparing counts for July 31, 1995 with those on July 31, 1994, the following changes are noted:

RESIDENTS

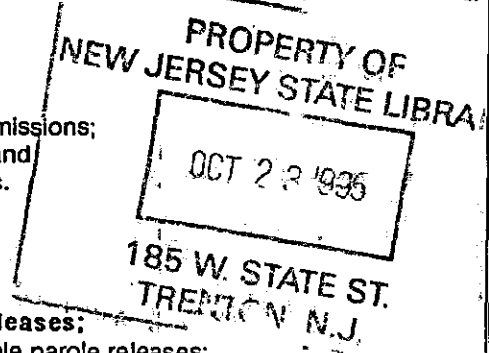
- 5% increase from 24,849 to 26,090 for all institutions;
- 5% increase from 24,199 to 25,452 for the adult jurisdictional population; (county waiting, county contract, county assistance, prison and youth complexes);
- 20% increase from 3,445 to 4,150 for county waiting;
- 14% increase from 886 to 1013 for county contract and county assistance;
- 2% increase from 14,705 to 15,027 for the prison complex;
- 2% increase from 5,163 to 5,262 for the youth facilities; and
- -2% decrease from 650 to 638 for the juveniles (juvenile facilities and juvenile waiting).

ADMISSIONS

- 13% increase from 1,237 to 1,394 for total admissions;
- 12% increase from 1,108 to 1,246 for adults; and
- 15% increase from 129 to 148 for juveniles.

RELEASES

- -8% decrease from 1,011 to 929 for total releases;
- -10% decrease from 642 to 577 for adult male parole releases;
- 19% increase from 63 to 75 for adult female parole releases;
- -8% decrease from 705 to 652 for total adult parole releases;
- -18% decrease from 245 to 202 for offenders discharged at max; and
- 23% increase from 61 to 75 for juvenile releases.



NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I—community, SL II—minimum, SL III—medium, SL IV—maximum and SL V—close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.
