The Office of Business Advocacy's objective is to cut red tape and get solutions to permit problems. OBA will designate a Permit Expediter to your project. The Permit Expediter will:

- A. Advise you of the state permits required for your project, upon completing "MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION FORM"
- B. Coordinate contacts with relevant local and state regulatory agencies upon request.
- C. Monitor the progress of your permit application.
- D. Act to ensure processing of most permits within 90 days of application.
- E. Process "Over The Counter" certain permits meeting appropriate criteria.

OVER-THE-COUNTER PERMITS

I. STREAM ENCROACHMENT (609) - 292 - 4869

DEP now has a one-day processing service for certain minor stream encroachment permits. This "over-the-counter" service is limited to minor projects which do not adversely change the water carrying capacity of the floodway, do not increase erosion or sedimentation in the stream, and do not require substantial channel modification or relocation. For further information contact the Bureau of Flood Plain Management, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NJ 08625.

II. WATERFRONT DEVELOPMENT (609) - 292 - 0060

DEP has a one-day processing service for minor waterfront development projects. This over-the-counter service applies to waterfront construction activity in man-made lagoons and minor maintenance and/or repair or replacement of lawful existing structures. For further information contact: Waterfront Development, P.O. Box 1889, Trenton, NJ 08625.

III. SEWER EXTENSIONS (609) - 292 - 3846

DEP has a one-day processing service for "minor" sewer extension projects. Eligible projects must meet certain criteria, such as, length of 1000 linear feet or less, cost of \$25,000 or less, sewage flow per day of 12,000 gallons or less. No projects with pump stations, force mains, siphons, gallonage transfers or holding tanks will be processed over-the-counter. Projects can not be located in areas under sewer ban, administrative orders, or litigation.

Projects must be in-house by 9:30 a.m., and all administrative documents must be in proper order. Pre-application conferences are strongly recommended. For further information contact Division of Water Resources, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NJ 08625.

MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION

DEP has developed a Master Permit Information Application which, upon completion, will indicate all the DEP permits required for the project. Forms may be obtained by contacting the Office of Business Advocacy (See inside cover for details).

All DEP Public Hearings, Administrative Hearings, and DEP
Events of Public Interest are open to the public.

DEP Events of Public Interest include: public hearings, council meetings, workshops, public information meetings, and exams.

Public Hearings (Quasi - Legislative) - are held for the purpose of obtaining input and reaction to a proposed rule, regulation, or new program. Some hearings may be mandated by law. Generally their scope of impact is statewide, or of broad general interest.

Administrative Hearings (Quasi - Judicial) - are held between the state and a particular party involving an application, enforcement - violation or an appeal. Interest in these hearings is generally limited to those directly involved.

HIGHWAY PERMITS PROGRAM

On or about the 15th of each month, the Weekly Bulletin will include information concerning the current disposition of all permit applications submitted to the Department of Transportation. The interim status column reflects the status of each application as of the last business day of the preceeding month.

In order to be more responsive to the needs of applicants and to facilitate processing applications in a timely manner, the State has been divided into four (4) Regions. DEP RECAP

(Recent press releases in capsule form)

December 3--POLLUTION PENALTY FOR JERSEY CITY TRUCK FIRM--DEP imposed a \$1,250 administrative penalty against Midwest Emery Freight Corporation of Jersey City for discharge of wastewaters from washing of trucks into the Hackensack River.

December 3--BATSTO MANSION CLOSED FOR RENOVATION--Batsto Mansion at Batsto Village Historic Site, Wharton State Forest near Hammonton, was closed December 1 for renovation. It will reopen April 1, 1980, after modernization of its electrical system and interior redecoration. Batsto Village will remain open to the public during regular visiting hours.

December 3--WETLANDS PERMIT FOR ACCESS ROAD DENIED--DEP denied a Wetlands Permit sought by Winter's Yacht Basin, Mantoloking, for construction of a service road which would have permanently altered portions of State regulated wetlands adjacent to Barnegat Bay. David Kinsey, Acting Director of the Division of Coastal Resources, noted that upland alternatives for the road are available which would avoid wetlands disturbance.

December 3--PESTICIDE CONTAMINATION RESULTS IN PENALTIES--DEP assessed penalties totaling \$1,500 against Bliss Exterminating Company of New York City, and \$500 against a certified applicator, in connection with contamination of a home water pumping system in Randolph Township, Morris County, with chlordane, a toxic pesticide.

December 3--GOVERNOR BYRNE ANNOUNCES \$2.3 MILLION IN GREEN ACRES GRANTS--Governor Brendan Byrne announced approval of 11 Green Acres grants totaling more than \$2.3 million in nine counties. All are matching grants administered by DEP. They are: Mercer County Park Commission, \$500,000 to develop a boating facility on proposed Lake Mercer in Central Park in the Townships of West Windsor, Hamilton and Lawrence; Riverdale, Morris County, \$125,000 to develop a municipal recreation area on a former gravel mine; Dover, Morris County, \$190,000 for the proposed Dover Cultural Center; Montgomery Township, Somerset County, \$275,000 to buy 100-acre Harlingen Road Park; Somerville, Somerset County, \$98,000 to develop Vanderveer Recreation Area; Phillipsburg, Warren County, \$760,000 from a combined Green Acres/Land and Water Conservation grant to develop Delaware Riverfront Park. Funding is 40 percent Green Acres, 50 percent federal and 10 percent town. Middletown Township, Monmouth County, \$283,500 to buy 52 acres of additions to Tall Oaks Park; Piscataway Township, Middlesex County, \$180,650 to buy 13-acre Columbus Park II, including New Market Lake; Hunterdon County, \$153,700 to buy 109-acre Teetertown Ravine in Lebanon Township, and Livingston Township, Essex County, \$8,250 conservation and flood control project for a 2.9-acre tract which will remain a natural area.

December 4--PROPOSED RULES TO SHIFT NORTHEAST SOLID WASTE FLOWS--DEP Commissioner Jerry Fitzgerald English announced proposed changes in rules to change solid waste

collection and disposal patterns in northeastern New Jersey. They would eliminate dumping by several municipalities in the Hackensack Meadowlands and would shift most waste to disposal in Middlesex County, where resource recovery plants are planned. Counties involved in the changes would be Union, Middlesex, Bergen, Burlington, Essex, Hudson, Mercer, Morris, Passaic and Somerset. Copies of the proposed new rules are available from DEP's Solid Waste Administration, 32 E. Hanover Street, Trenton, NJ 08625. The comment period extends until December 26, 1979.

December 4--STEVEN PICCO APPOINTED ASSISTANT COMMISSIONER--Commissioner English named Steven J. Picco Assistant Commissioner for Regulatory and Governmental Affairs. He will be responsible for Departmental legislative, regulatory and enforcement activities and the public participation program. Picco is former Assistant Commissioner of the State Department of Energy.

December 5--FLOOD GRANT FOR CRANFORD TOWNSHIP--Commissioner English announced that Cranford Township, Union County, is eligible for a \$1 million flood control matching grant through the Emergency Flood Control Bond Act of 1978. The project involves channeling and detention work for Gallows Hill Branch of the Rahway River.

December 6--COMMISSIONER ENGLISH EXAMINES HAZARDOUS WASTE SITES--Commissioner English personally inspected five hazardous waste disposal sites. They are: Bridgeport Oil & Rental site, Logan Township, and Lipari landfill in Pitman, both Gloucester County; King of Prussia landfill in Winslow Township, Camden County; Bog Creek Farm in Howell Township, and Long Pine landfill in Freehold, both Monmouth County.

December 6--MERCER SOLID WASTE PLAN CERTIFIED--Commissioner English announced DEP certification of the Mercer County Solid Waste Management Plan, with the requirement that the County must identify and analyze solid waste collection and disposal patterns, and develop locations and timetables for resource recovery actions.

December 6--ATLANTIC CITY WETLANDS STUDY AVAILABLE--Deputy DEP Commissioner Donald T. Graham announced publication of a 24-page study on quality of coastal wetlands in Atlantic City. It is available from the Coastal Information Center, Box 1389, Trenton, NJ 08625, telephone (609) 292-9760.

December 7--DEP GRANTS APPROVAL FOR TAX-EXEMPT SITES--Commissioner English announced approval of eight applications for tax exemption under the Green Acres Tax Exemption Program, which benefits non-profit organizations opening their land to public use. Exemptions were approved for the New Jersey Conservation Foundation, Upper Raritan Watershed Association, World Wildlife Fund, Weis Ecology Center, New Jersey Audubon Society, Boy Scouts of America, Stoney Brook-Millstone Watershed Association and Wildlife Preserves, Inc.
